Day 3

Hanoi City Tour

All day

Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam, is the cradle of Vietnamese traditional culture. After breakfast, we will go to Ba Dinh Square, a famous political area in Vietnam, to visit Ho Chi Minh's Stilt House, Presidential Palace Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh Museum. We will also have a look at the One Pillar Pagoda shaped like a blooming lotus. Then, we will go to the West Lake Hanoi to enjoy a picturesque scenery view. You will also see the ancient Tran Quoc Pagoda and the Temple of Literature Hanoi dedicated to Confucius. During the tour, we will pass by another famous lake known as Hoan Kiem Lake. In the north of Hoan Kiem Lake is the oldest commercial district in Hanoi, 36 Streets of Hanoi Old Quarter. You will take a tricycle to visit the bustling lively streets and catch a glimpse of the prosperity of the Thang Long capital in past days. Finally, we will drive through the gothic style St. Joseph's Cathedral. After dinner, we have specially arranged a Water Puppet Show for you.

Morning

Ba Dinh Square

Ba Dinh Square, the largest square in Vietnam, holds significant historical values. Ever since 1945, when President Ho Chi Minh proclaimed the Declaration of Independence of Vietnam, this landmark has witnessed all the ups and downs of the country. Situated on Hung Vuong Street, this square is the center of a large complex of historical and cultural sites (often known as Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum Complex) in Ba Dinh District. Ba Dinh Square is a 320-meter-long and

100-meter-wide area that can hold up to 200,000 people. It consists of 210 grass squares, interspersed with wide pathways. In the middle of the square is a 25-meter-tall flag pole, where the national flag raising ceremony is held every morning. The 4 sides of the square all face important Hanoi landmarks. To the north of the square is the Office of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Vietnam, to the south is the headquarters of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, to the west is Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, and to the east is Ba Dinh Hall.

Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum

Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is an important historical attraction of Hanoi, known for honoring the national hero: President Ho Chi Minh. The building is where visitors can express their admiration and gratitude towards the common father/uncle of Vietnamese who has led the country to independence and reunification. It is popularly known among Vietnamese as Uncles' Mausoleum, for the intimate and familiar atmosphere Ho Chi Minh always created when he was alive. Built over 2 years from 1973 to 1975, the Mausoleum is also a lively illustrator of national unity.

Ho Chi Minh's Stilt House

Ho Chi Minh's Stilt House is situated in the garden of the Presidential Palace on Ngoc Hoi Street, Ba Dinh District, Hanoi, near Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum. As a symbol of Hanoi, this was where the late president of Vietnam used to live and work. Here, you will have a glimpse into the great life of Ho Chi Minh and a part of the heroic history of Vietnam. Uncle Ho's Stilt House is as modest and simple as the president himself. It preserves a lot of memories from the time he lived and worked here, especially in his last 10 years.

One Pillar Pagoda

One Pillar Pagoda (officially known as Dien Huu Pagoda), is named after its extraordinary architecture: The whole construction is built on a single pillar, which is planted in the middle of a lotus pond. The attraction is located in Ba Dinh District, which is a walkable distance to the Ho Chi Minh Complex, which includes the Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, and Ho Chi Minh Museum. The One Pillar Pagoda is believed to exist since the Ly's dynasty, marking a notable development of Buddhism in Vietnam. This monument is not only a famous tourist attraction but also a religious stop for local pilgrims.

Presidential Palace Hanoi

Presidential Palace is a three-storey building which surrounded by an orchard, carp pond and a 91-metre long boulevard of lush gardens. Designed by the French architect Auguste Henri Vildieu, it is of an architectural style called Beaux-Arts, which was quite prevailing back that time. This work of art is painted a bright yellow color, consisting of the massive iron gate, grand staircase and 30 rooms with different décor each. After President Ho Chi Minh passed away in 1969, this place became one of the historical monuments commemorating Uncle Ho and ranked by the State as a special monument. Until now, this place is still used as the workplace of the State President and important activities of the Party and State are still held solemnly here.

West Lake Hanoi

West Lake is the biggest freshwater lake of northwest center of Hanoi, Vietnam. With a shore length of 17 km, this is

the largest lake of the capital and a popular place for recreation with many surrounding gardens, hotels, and villas. The area surrounding West Lake is famous for the density of its historical relics, most of them pagodas exhibiting different Buddhist architectural styles. There are 62 relics, of which 22 are classified as national heritages and 7 municipal heritage sites.

Tran Quoc Pagoda

With a history of 1,500 years, Tran Quoc Pagoda is the oldest pagoda in Hanoi. It was built in 541 in the Early Ly Dynasty, originally named Khai Quoc Pagoda. Famous for sacred sanctuary and stunning scenery, Tran Quoc Pagoda used to be a favorite place for sightseeing of many kings of Vietnam in special festivals such as Tet holiday and full moon days. Thanks to its useful location beside the dazzling West Lake and on an island which is linked by a bridge between the two most romantic lakes of Hanoi, which are Truc Bach Lake and West Lake, the pagoda attracts a lot of tourists each and every day.

Temple of Literature Hanoi

The Temple of Literature Hanoi is a rare example of a well-preserved traditional Vietnamese architecture dedicated to the Confucius and honors Vietnam's finest scholars. The Temple is the first university complex in Vietnam. Not only is it a cultural and historical relic, but it is also where many students come to pray for luck in their upcoming exams and studies.

Hoan Kiem Lake

Hoan Kiem lake, also known as "Sword Lake," is a freshwater lake in the center of Hanoi. The legend about the name of the lake is known by all the Vietnamese people. The lake is not only special in her history but also some characteristics that you might not find anywhere else in Vietnam. The water of the lake has different colors depending on the reflection of the sky, it could be green, dark or light. Hoan Kiem Lake Hanoi is also the home of tortoises. If you are lucky, you will have a chance to see these giant animals rising out of the water, taking a sunbath. There are so many activities happening around Hoan Kiem lake which make it crowded and busy all day, especially during the weekends. Let's rock it like the locals, and find out what to see and where to visit around Hoan Kiem Lake!

36 Streets of Hanoi Old Quarter

The 36 streets of the Old Quarter were named after the 36 trades or craft that were set up in this area north of the lake. Located in Hanoi Old Quarter, this neighborhood is a culturally significant destination in the center of Vietnam's

capital city. The phrase “Hanoi 36 pho phuong” is engraved in the hearts and minds of most Vietnamese people and many tourists worldwide for its traditional architecture and diverse cultural experience. These streets are unique in their own ways but most share one special similarity. They originated from the ancient Hanoi 36 streets. Those streets were named after the products and services they provided, following the word “Hang.” Throughout the years, some of them retain their original names while some have been changed.

St. Joseph Cathedral

St Joseph’s Cathedral, or “The Big Church” familiarly called by locals, is one of the first structures constructed by the French colonists during their expansion in Indochina and still intact in Hanoi after two wars. In spite of fierce fights destroying almost parts of Hanoi, St Joseph’s Cathedral is still standing in good condition. Today, it has become a historical attraction in Hanoi which remains the image of the beauty of the old Hanoi and makes an impression on travelers by its ancient beauty inside the bustling capital.

Water Puppet Show

Water puppetry is a special folk art created by the people living in the Red River Delta in Northern Vietnam. This art form dates back to the 11th century. Puppets are made of wood but said to be waterproof and durable. During the show, the puppets are controlled via a bamboo rod and strings hidden under the water surface by puppeteers standing behind the stage. The performance of the puppets on stage usually comes along with “Cheo” singing – a traditional folk music of the Northern people. Indispensably, the show also involves several instruments, such as drums, monochord, cymbals, flutes, horns, gongs, etc. The puppet shows are usually about the daily life of rural people.

All kinds of freshly caught shrimps and crabs will definitely be worth the visit! On the return trip in the afternoon, you may enjoy the beauty of Halong Bay quietly on the deck.

Halong Bay

Halong Bay is located in the Northeast of Vietnam, 165 km from Hanoi capital, in the territory of Quang Ninh province. This is an island area with an area of 1,553km² including 1,969 islands, of which 90% are limestone islands. Halong Bay includes Lan Ha Bay, Bai Tu Long Bay, and many other nearby bays. For many, the seascape of Ha Long Bay is synonymous with Vietnam. Cruises sail emerald, green waters among thousands of rugged islands and islets, stopping at spectacular caves through which visitors can wander, viewing impressive, centuries-old formations. Ha Long Bay's mystical beauty has made it a bucket list attraction within the country!

Soi Sim Island

Soi Sim Island is a small soil island in the southwest of Halong Bay. It's about 12 kilometers far from Bai Chay tourist wharf and about 700 meters from Ti Top Island. Explaining for the name "Soi Sim", the locals said that in the past, the major plant on the island was *Rhodomyrtus tomentosa* (called "sim" in Vietnamese). Therefore, the island was named after that plant, "Soi Sim". Soi Sim Island has an area of 8.7 ha. On the island, there are two 200-meter hills covered by a green primeval forest. This primeval forest is home to many species of flora, especially endemic plants. This is the result of thousands of years isolated from the mainland. Coming to Soi Sim Island, you will be impressed by peaceful ambiance and natural beauty of green primeval forest and blue sea. There are two charming beaches on the island with white sand and clear seawater. Moreover, from the top of the hills on Soi Sim Island, tourists will have great views to the spectacular scenery of Halong bay.

Sung Sot Cave (Surprise Cave)

Located on Bo Hon Island, which is known as in the center of the UNESCO-declared World Heritage area, Sung Sot Cave is one of the widest and most striking ones with the area of around 10,000 square meters and the length of more than 200 meters. The widest area inside the cave is about 80 meters. Sung Sot Cave is firstly explored by a group of French tourists. Being surprised by the magnificent beauty of the cave, these French tourists named the cave as "Grotte des surprises" – the cave of surprise. From that time, Sung Sot Cave is known as Surprising Cave or Amazing Cave.

Ti Top Island

Covering a total area of 3.7 hectares, Ti Top Island is one of the smallest islands making up Halong Bay - a natural wonder in Quang Ninh Province. The island's current name was named after the Russian cosmonaut Gherman Titov on his visit to Halong Bay in 1962 by Uncle Ho. The mesmerizing view and its prime location contribute to the highlights of Ti Top Beach, which allures a large number of tourists each year. Coming here, you can know the entire history of the island in detail through the memorial stone in front of the island.

After arriving in Da Nang, you will take a Vietnamese special basket boat to visit Cam Kim Island. Here, you will have the chance to roam the water coconut mangroves and experience the fun of fishing crabs by yourself! Then, we will go to Hoi An Ancient Town. Take a visit to Tan Ky Old House and Japanese Bridge full of national fusion characteristics, as well as Fujian Assembly Hall and Cantonese Assembly Hall, where overseas Chinese used to gather. You can also DIY a Hoi An traditional lantern under the guidance of a professional lantern master! In the evening, we will go to Hoi An Impression Theme Park to watch the largest real-life performance in Vietnam at the Hoi An Memories Show. Travel through time in the dreamlike light and shadow to feel the past, present and future of Hoi An Ancient Town.

Cam Kim Island

Cam Kim Island is situated on the south side of the Thu Bon river. It will take about 15 minutes to get to the island from the city center. Furthermore, Hoi An has a total of four suburban communes and Cam Kim Island Hoi An is one of them. Cam Kim Island is known as one of the must-visit destinations for tourists when traveling to Hoi An Ancient Town. Especially, if you are under depression due to the hustle and bustle of life, this island will be the most effective remedy for you. This small oasis is surrounded by green trees and beautiful nature like an ink-wash painting.

Hoi An Ancient Town

Hoi An Ancient Town is located in Viet Nam's central Quang Nam Province, on the north bank near the mouth of the Thu Bon River. Hoi An Ancient Town is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. The town reflects a fusion of indigenous and foreign cultures (principally Chinese and Japanese with later European influences) that combined to produce this unique survival. The town comprises a well-preserved complex of 1,107 timber frame buildings, with brick or wooden walls. They are arranged side-by-side in tight, unbroken rows along narrow pedestrian streets. There is also the fine wooden Japanese bridge, with a pagoda on it, dating from the 18th century.

Tan Ky Old House

Tan Ky old house is an ancient work of more than 200 years old. With its unique architecture that combines the features of Vietnam, Japan and China, it is the highlight of Hoi An ancient town. Although this construction was built more than two centuries ago, it can still keep the original beauty of ancient Hoi An. Besides, the old house of Tan Ky is also a special place retaining a variety of priceless antiquity.

Japanese Bridge Hoi An

Japanese Bridge Hoi An is an iconic symbol of Hoi An Ancient Town. Being built by the Japanese since the 17th century, until now, the Bridge has been attracting thousands of visitors from all over the world thanks to its unique beauty and special architecture. It has the honor of being printed in Vietnam's 20,000 VND banknote. Coming to Hoi An old town, it would be a waste if you don't stop at least once by the Japanese Covered Bridge.

Fujian Assembly Hall

Fujian Assembly Hall is an unmissable historical and cultural relic in Hoi An. Covered an astonishing 2000 square meters of land, the hall is one of five prestigious and most visited assembly halls in the town. The site not only represents the elaborate ancient architecture of the Old Town, but also has great spiritual significance to the local community.

Cantonese Assembly Hall Hoi An

The Cantonese Assembly Hall Hoi An was erected in the late 18th century by overseas Chinese from Guangdong Guangzhou region. At that time, Hoi An was one of the major trading ports in Vietnam, Hoi An City has become one of the first centers for Chinese people to do business and settle down. Since then, a variety of assembly halls were established for gathering and trading purposes. This hall has an interesting constructing process, because each part of this building was initially made in China, then transferred by boat and assembled completely in Hoi An.

Ba Na Hills

Ba Na Hills was formerly a popular vacation spot of the French, completed with villas and a resort. It was developed into the popular theme park it is today. The only way up to Ba Na Hills is via cable cars, and it's won more than one Guinness World Record. You'll be rewarded with a picturesque ride boasting incredible, 360-degree views. On a clear day, you can see as far as Danang and the sea. Catch your breath away from the crowds at the Linh Ung Pagoda. At 1,500 meters above sea level, it offers fantastic views. It also boasts one of the biggest Buddha statues in the land, which sits serenely on a five-meter-wide circular base and is 27 meters tall.

Danang Golden Bridge

Danang Golden Bridge perches on a prime location inside the Ba Na Hills. At the height of 1400m above sea level, the bridge is a masterpiece with golden-hue gilded railing frames and a winding shape (stretching 150m in length). Its unique design is lifted by two giant hands and the golden yellow hue of this pedestrian bridge make it both photo perfect and a great place for sightseeing.

Fantasy Park

Let's explore Fantasy Park in Ba Na Hills! Fantasy Park is located on a mountain peak in Ba Na Hills Mountain Resort, known as "the way to fairyland" or "paradise on earth". As a perfect tourist attraction for an entire family, Fantasy Park was commenced and inspired by two iconic novels "Journey to the Center of the Earth" and "Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea" by French writer Jules Verne. The amusement park reserves countless funs and surprises, which of course involve well-tailored games to keep little kids occupied and delighted all day long.

In addition, this little paradise on the earth is also in the list of Vietnam's 10 most beautiful beaches, Asia's 25 best beaches by TripAdvisor or Asia's 10 best beaches by an Australian magazine.

Danang Dragon Bridge

Dragon Bridge is the world's largest dragon-shaped steel bridge. As its name implies, Dragon Bridge illustrates the image of a dragon flying towards the sea with the architecture inspired by Ly dynasty. This inventive design reflects Vietnamese customs and beliefs, as well as highlights Da Nang's growth and development. Due to its unique design, the bridge has become an iconic image of the city that visitor should not miss while in Danang. This gorgeous one-of-a-kind metal dragon also "breathes" fire and water weekly. The deliberate integration of lighting technology, with more than 2,500 LED lights, exquisitely shows the dragon's body and its vivid fire-breathing head.

APEC Park

APEC Sculpture Park – an extension of the 2017-built APEC Park– is a new architecture check-in spot and public

destination for the tourism hub with a display of several sculptures from APEC member economies. The park features a large steel arch in the shape of a flying kite.

Da Nang Cathedral

Independence Palace

The Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace, was built on the site of the former Norodom Palace. The landmark in Ho Chi Minh City was built on a 12-hectare plot of land and includes a large mansion of 80-meter width. This place has a glamorous design, hundreds of rooms equipped with luxurious furnishings and decorations, and an enormous and gorgeous exterior space. The Independence Palace symbolizes Vietnam's victory, peace, and territorial integrity. It was designated as a historical monument for having witnessed significant changes in Saigon's history and keeping the essence of Eastern culture.

People's Committee Building

The People's Committee Building is one of the 17 landmarks which are over 100 years old in Ho Chi Minh city. The iconic outlook of this building is inspired by French Renaissance Revival architecture, which emphasizes leisure and elegance. The interior of this building is heavenly magnificent with sophisticated pieces of furniture and harmonious paintings, which take up the majority of the vault. However, it is sad that since the building is not open to the public, not many people have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the heavenly atmosphere of the building.

Notre Dame Cathedral of Saigon

Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral is one of the topmost famous French-style churches in Vietnam. The cathedral is designed in Roman style mixed with Gothic art with a capacity of up to 1200 people. Notre Dame Cathedral includes a large central nave, 93m-long cross-shaped plan, a semicircular harem, and 5 small chapels. The construction materials

of Notre Dame Cathedral were mostly transported from France such as bricks, tiles, iron and steel, stained glass.

Saigon Central Post Office

Saigon Central Post Office, built around 1886 – 1891, is both one of the oldest and yet most iconic buildings in the city. Like other architectural works built during the French colonial period in Vietnam, the post office has a stunning facade that feature the spectacular characteristics of French architecture with yellow walls, arched doors and windows, and decorative reliefs. Despite having been in operation for more than 100 years, Saigon Central Post Office's enduring beauty has not faded over time. This is a perfect place for the people who want to enjoy the beautiful design, mail a postcard, write a letter by hand or simply recall the memory of a bygone era.
