Sirmione

Sirmione is one of the most beautiful towns on Lake Garda and one of the most popular. It is perched at the top of a thin strip of land stretching onto the lake and it is almost entirely surrounded by water, a position that makes the town unique and very atmospheric.

Bridge of Sighs

Called the Ponte dei Sospiri by locals, this iconic landmark was built in the year 1600 and connects the Doge's Palace to the historic prison across the canal. Even though it has a dark history where it was once a place to transport prisoners, today it is easily considered one of the most romantic places in Venice.

Saint Mark's Basilica

The works of the present St. Mark's Basilica began in 1063 in Byzantine style to represent the power of the prosperous Venetian Republic. This basilica was built respecting the model of two basilicas of the ancient imperial city of Byzantium with a central plan in the shape of a Greek cross, with five large domes and a particular mixture of ancient and oriental art.

St. Mark's Square

The Basilica of San Marco overlooks one of the most beautiful squares in the world. Next to both the Basilica and the Doge's Palace is where all the most important religious and civil ceremonies have always been held. Piazza San Marco is now considered the city's main symbol and tourist attraction.

Rialto Bridge

Rialto Bridge, Italian Ponte di Rialto, stone arch bridge crossing over the narrowest point of the Grand Canal in the heart of Venice. Built in the closing years of the 16th century, the Rialto Bridge is the oldest bridge across the canal and is renowned as an architectural and engineering achievement of the Renaissance. The Rialto Bridge consists of a single stone-arch span that supports a broad rectangular deck carrying two arcades of shops fronting on three roadways. The lower chord of the bridge is only 25 metres (83 feet) in length, while the width is 20 metres (66 feet). To support the wide stone arch in the soft alluvial soil, 6,000 timber piles were driven under each abutment, and the bed joints of the stones were placed perpendicular to the thrust of the arch.

Venice Canal Grande

The Grand Canal is a channel in Venice, Italy. It forms one of the major water-traffic corridors in the city. One end of the canal leads into the lagoon near the Santa Lucia railway station and the other end leads into the basin at San Marco; in between, it makes a large reverse-S shape through the central districts (sestieri) of Venice. The banks of the Grand Canal are lined with more than 170 buildings, most of which date from the 13th to the 18th century, and demonstrate the welfare and art created by the Republic of Venice.

Venice Gondola Rides

The gondolas plying the busy Grand Canal and the smaller waterways of Venice are one of the most iconic images in the world. They are the symbol of history, tradition, and romance in the city on the lagoon, and a gondola ride in Venice ranks among one of the most dreamed-about experiences for travelers.

Today, we will drive to the Cinque Terre. The Cinque Terre area consists of five fishing villages: Monterosso, Vernacha, Corniglia, Manarola, and Reomaggiore. It is listed by UNESCO as the world's largest fishing village. Take a train and have a relaxing and refreshing tour of this exquisite World Heritage. You will see many colorful houses on the long coastline, cliffs and valleys. Afterwards, we will drive to Florence, the "Emerald" city under Xu Zhimo's pen.

These three buildings are part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site covering the historic center of Florence and are a major tourist attraction of Tuscany. The basilica is one of Italy's largest churches and the perfect place for you to explore.

Basilica di Santa Croce

The Basilica di Santa Croce is one of the richest medieval churches in Florence! There is a famous cross on the square that you must take a look at! The origin of the cross is what gives the name of the church. Also, take a look at the tombs that are present with so many famous names.

Palazzo Vecchio

The Palazzo Vecchio is the town hall of Florence, Italy. It overlooks the Piazza della Signoria, which holds a copy of Michelangelo's David statue, and the gallery of statues in the adjacent Loggia dei Lanzi.

Pitti Palace

The Pitti Palace is a vast, mainly Renaissance, palace in Florence, Italy. It is situated on the south side of the River Arno, a short distance from the Ponte Vecchio. The core of the present palazzo dates from 1458 and was originally the town residence of Luca Pitti, an ambitious Florentine banker. The palace was bought by the Medici family in 1549 and became the chief residence of the ruling families of the Grand Duchy of Tuscany. It grew as a great treasure house as later generations amassed paintings, plates, jewelry and luxurious possessions.

Stroll through the mountain towns and feel the simple folk customs here. Then proceed to Siena, known as one of the most charming cities in Italy. In 1995, Siena's historic center was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This city is centered on a pastoral square and dotted with beautiful churches. It attracts tourists from all over the world with its unique beauty and is known as "Italy's most charming city".

San Gimignano

San Gimignano is a small walled medieval hill town in the province of Siena, Tuscany, north-central Italy. Known as the Town of Fine Towers, San Gimignano is famous for its medieval architecture, unique in the preservation of about a dozen of its tower houses, which, with its hilltop setting and encircling walls, form "an unforgettable skyline". Within the walls, the well-preserved buildings include notable examples of both Romanesque and Gothic architecture, with outstanding examples of secular buildings as well as churches. The Palazzo Comunale, the Collegiate Church and Church of Sant' Agostino contain frescos, including cycles dating from the 14th and 15th centuries. The "Historic Centre of San Gimignano" is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Siena Cathedral

Siena Cathedral is a medieval church in Siena, Italy, dedicated from its earliest days as a Roman Catholic Marian church. The exterior and interior are constructed of white and greenish-black marble in alternating stripes, with the addition of red marble on the façade.

Palazzo Pubblico

The Palazzo Pubblico (town hall) is a palace in Siena, Tuscany, central Italy. Construction began in 1297 to serve as the seat of the Republic of Siena's government. The palace is of medieval and Gothic architecture.

When you step foot in Tuscany, you will feel the unique soul that this land has endowed wine. Visit the local family winery, tour the wine cellar, and listen to the winemaker patiently introduce the grape varieties, picking and winemaking techniques, etc. Taste Italian wine and enjoy lunch in this manor. Pienza

Perched on top of a beautiful hill in scenic Val d'Orcia, Pienza is a small town with incredible history. Originally just a village like many others in the area, Pienza saw its history and fame change in the late 1400s. At that time, the town gave birth to Enea Silvio Piccolomini, aka Pope Pius II, who decided to honor his town by turning it into an 'ideal city'. A follower of Humanist vision and philosophy, he turned Pienza into an urban utopia and we can still see the result of his vision today. Today, Pienza is a beautiful hilltop town in Tuscany with a distinct character, stunning location and interesting history.

Montalcino

To the south of Siena is a classic fairytale hilltop town, set within a full circle of fortified walls and watched over by a mighty castle of medieval perfection. Montalcino, west of Pienza, is a beautiful village immersed in the breathtaking Val d'Orcia Natural Park, renowned all over the world for the production of its precious Brunello red wine.

The Arch of Constantine is a triumphal arch in Rome dedicated to the emperor Constantine the Great. It is a uniquely designed arch and a beauty in its own. The inscription on the arch praises Constantine and says, "avenging the republic from a tyrant."

Walking on the streets of Rome, you are unlikely to find big-name labels on the locals, but you can see their fashion attitude from a pair of delicately patterned and exquisitely crafted pointed-toe shoes on their feet.
