Sharjah attaches great importance to cultural protection and inheritance and has the title of "Cultural Capital of the Arab World", which shows its contribution in the field of culture and education. Today we will walk into the museums and traditional markets in Sharjah, learn more about Arabic culture, and wander in the cultural ocean of Sharjah!

#### Cultural Square

The Cultural Square features a 14-meter-high pedestal with a sculpture of the Holy Quran. It is the centerpiece of the roundabout in the square, representing the spiritual heart of the city. The sculpture, which was designed by Spanish sculptor Marinas Rubias, is encircled by a number of stately buildings in typical Islamic architecture. These Sharjah buildings are of prominence in UAE history, particularly the Ruler's Office and the Ahmad Bin Hanbal Mosque. Also in the square is the Cultural Palace, a place for concerts and events.

#### Sharjah Classic Car Museum

Sharjah Classic Car Museum is an ideal destination for classic cars lovers, displaying more than 100 classic cars manufactured in the early 20th century. This museum is divided into five sections, with vehicles ranging from a Model T Ford to a 1974 MG Midget. Don't miss the 1969 Mercedes Pullman Limousine, custom-made for Sharjah's ruler and one of only 2,000 in the world. The cars have been lovingly restored and buffed until you can see your reflection.

#### Central Souk

With a well-known blue tile-trimmed facade - the Central Souk is an iconic landmark on the Sharjah map and is one of the city's most photographed buildings. This souk is also symbolic of the history of UAE, featuring prominently on the five-dirham note. With over 600 shops across two levels, you'll find everything from modern watches and clothing to authentically local trinkets and souvenirs. For decor connoisseurs in particular, the souk is one of the must-do Sharjah tourist places.

#### Souq Al Jubail

Located just beside an array of fishing boats in the water, Souq Al Jubail stands as a landmark with domes and pillars that are traditional to Islamic architecture. Fish are hauled in from nearby boats, making the souk the quintessential

Sharjah fish market. It also serves as the ultimate fruits and vegetables market, featuring local and freshly imported produce at reasonable prices. Souq Al Jubail is, therefore, one of the most ideal places to visit in Sharjah for grocery shopping and a perfect example of shopping in the UAE culture, with many locals talking to the grocers at each stall to find the best produce at the best price. This makes the souk one of the few Sharjah tourist places for an authentic travel and shopping experience.

### **Sharjah Museum of Islamic Civilization**

Housed in building every bit as impressive as its collection, the museum is located on the Corniche, just north of the Heart of Sharjah district. Sharjah Museum of Islamic Civilization features seven galleries spread over two levels. The ground-floor galleries cover aspects of the Islamic faith and the achievements of Arab scientists and astronomers. The upper floors offer a chronological overview of Islamic arts and crafts, including textiles and jewelry. Astrolabes, manuscripts, ceramics and coins all vie for your attention, but don't miss the gold-embroidered curtain for the door of the Holy Ka'ba and the mosaic inside the central dome detailing the zodiac constellations.

### **Sharjah Maritime Museum**

Sharjah Maritime Museum presents marvelous and diverse aspects of the sea-related life that had such a great impact on Sharjah's heritage, and the development of coastal cities for over 6,000 years. Enjoy a day with an extraordinary adventure at Sharjah Maritime Museum, where you can explore Sharjah's interesting marine history and heritage and learn about the customs of Sharjah's inhabitants, whose lives were strongly influenced by the sea.

### **Expo City Dubai**

Expo City Dubai is a future-centric mini-city that builds on the legacy of Expo 2020 Dubai. The first World Expo to be held in the Middle East, Africa, and South Asia regions, it is welcomed in 192 nations and more than 24 million visitors during its run. Opened since October 1st 2022, Expo City brings back many of the entertainment offerings that delighted visitors during the world-class exposition, including the flagship Al Wasl Plaza, the Garden in the Sky observation tower and the famed Surreal water feature.

### **Abu Dhabi's Heritage Village**

Meet Abu Dhabi's Heritage Village, a family-friendly spot to experience the traditional way of life in the desert. The village is an immersive time capsule, with an old-world souk (market), mosque and camp modelled on life in pre-modern UAE.

### **Saadiyat Island**

Saadiyat Island is a natural island and a tourism-cultural project for nature, the Emirati heritage and culture that is located in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates. The project is located in a large island, 500 meters (1,600 ft) off the coast of Abu Dhabi Island. A mixed commercial, residential, and leisure project is currently under construction on the island. Upon its completion, the Saadiyat Island is expected to become Abu Dhabi's cultural center, mostly for the Island's

Cultural District that is expected to include eight museums.

### **Abrahamic Family House**

The Abrahamic Family House is a center for dialogue and knowledge exchange.
