DAY 1 Home town - Havana (D)

Pick up at the airport, and after dinner go to the famous Morro Castle to watch the Guancheng Gun Salute Ceremony that has been followed for more than 300 years. Check into hotel and rest.
Accommodation : 5-star Grand Aston Havana



DAY 2 Havana (B,L,D)

After breakfast ★Special arrangement: A 1-hour learning course on Salsa, the Cuban national dance, allowing you to experience the passionate dance of the Cubans. Visit New Havana: **Revolution Square, the Jose Martin Monument, the Ten Mile Coastal Boulevard, which is a coastal expressway extending westward from the old Havana port. It is the main place for locals to walk, talk about love, and have entertainment, Dignity Square, Monument to Chinese Travelers in Ancient Times, Century-old Rongshu Square. Old Havana: Plaza de San Francisco de Asis, Plaza de Armas, Plaza Vieja, Hotel Ambos Mundos where Ernest Hemingway lived, Plaza de the Cathedral, La Bodeguita del Medio. Visit the Rum Museum, where you can not only see the production process of the famous rum, but also taste the 7-year-old rum yourself. ★Visit a cigar factory and learn about the world-famous cigar making process. In the evening, take a 1-hour cruise in an open-top classic car. Assist the Cuban people by visiting civilians' homes, nursing homes or schools for disabled children to learn about their living and learning conditions, and donate used clothes, items or school supplies.

DAY 3 Havana / Yuannis Valley (B,L,D)

In the morning, drive to Pinar del Rio Province in the west, a province whose life is fueled by tobacco (Vennis Valley is designated as a World Natural Heritage by UNESCO and produces the world's top tobacco). Immigrants from Spain began growing tobacco here in the 17th century, making it an important producer of tobacco leaves in Cuba. After arriving at **Yuannis Valley [morning attractions]:** Go to visit the **Cigar Plantation** (stay time is about 1 hour and 30 minutes), visit the **Cigar Field, Tobacco Leaf Drying Room, and Tobacco Storage Room** in depth, and learn about the world-renowned Cigar Plantation. The Cuban cigar rolling process provides a rare experience for each person to "roll a cigar by hand".
[Afternoon Attraction]: Go to the appearance of **Prehistoric Stone Mural** (stay for about 30 minutes), which is painted on a special terrain. This huge mural was created by the Cuban painter Gonzalez in 1961. It is 120 meters high and wide. The 160-meter mountain wall is painted to imitate prehistoric murals with bright colors and large-scale murals that stand out from the special karst terrain.
★Special arrangement: At the exit of [Indian Cave], you can take a boat through a completely natural through-mountain cave. On the way, you will stop at the Jasmine Observation Tower, where you can overlook the most beautiful scenery of Yunis Valley. After the tour, drive back to Havana (duration about 2 hours and 30 minutes).

DAY 4 Havana - Varadero (B,L,D)

After breakfast, go to the beautiful fishing village of Coxima, visit the pier where the famous Nobel Prize winner Hemingway often went to sea, and look for the footsteps of a generation of literary giants who became famous, and then go to Varadero Beach, one of the eight most famous beaches in the world. Here you can enjoy the hotel's all-inclusive services, including gym, swimming pool, seaside beach, 24-hour cafe, evening parties, bar drinks, etc. Varadero is one of Cuba's most important tourist destinations. It has 22 kilometers of continuous soft white beaches, clear warm waters, and unparalleled changing blue waters, all of which make it World renowned. The Varadero region has a wide variety of corals at the bottom of the ocean, making diving a favorite underwater activity. Varadero's many piers have a full range of service systems to facilitate tourists to enjoy the beautiful scenery of the ocean and coast.

DAY 5 Varadero (B,L,D)

After breakfast, visit La Marina Chapelin Pier, then go out to sea, go to the uninhabited island for swimming, snorkeling, open wine, and return to the hotel to rest in the afternoon. After the buffet dinner, you can watch the song and dance performance in the hotel at 22:00.

Self-pay option : Watch the captain personally go into the sea to catch lobsters and taste the freshest ecological lobsters. (lobster boat tour open drinks and 1 lobster per person. Valued at USD 100/person included.)



DAY 6 Varadero - Santa Clara - Trinidad (B,L,D)

After breakfast transfer to **Santa Clara** for a panoramic city tour of Santa Clara and visit to the **Mausoleum of Ernesto Che Guevara**. After lunch, we went to **Trinidad**, a cultural and historical city in Cuba. We felt the unique urban architectural style and enjoyed the shock brought by the Spanish Baroque architectural style. Visit the **Plaza Mayor, the Holy Trinity Church, the famous bar La Canchanchara, Isnaga Manor.** Trinidad: A small town in Cuba, one of the 100 disappearing places on earth. Renowned for its well-preserved Spanish colonial-era architecture, it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The town is known for its history and its characteristic Neoclassical and Baroque architecture, its cobbled streets, its long tradition (passed down from generation to generation since its founding), all these attractions make Trinidad a A real city museum.
Accommodation : 4-star Memories Trinidad

DAY 7 Trinidad - Cienfuegos - Havana (B,L,D)

After breakfast, proceed to Cien Forks, a historic city in Cuba known as the "Pearl of the South". We will take photos of the city's coastal scenery, central square, Tomastri Theater, and Palacio Valle. After lunch, we will return to Havana.
Accommodation : 5-star Grand Aston Havana

DAY 8 Havana - Home Town (B)

After breakfast, transfer to Havana International Airport (HAV) and take an international flight back home.



Note :

- The above price includes 6 nights accommodation of 5 star hotel, 1 nights accommodation of 4 star hotel, vehicle, 13 meals (of which 5 meals are in the hotel, Tickets for attractions (gate closing ceremony, Salsa dance class, cigar factory, rum museum, Indian caves, prehistoric murals, hand-rolled cigar experience, Thomas Theater), one-hour classic car cruise, sailing, Chinese tour guide service, every day One bottle of water per day.
- Excluding tips for guide and driver (\$120/pp) ●lobster boat tour open drinks and 1 lobster per person. Valued at USD 100/person included.)
- You need to buy a travel card (equivalent to a visa, valid for 30 days) to enter Cuba. It is generally sold at the departure of direct flights to Cuba. The prices vary from city to city in US, and the reference price is \$100 per card.
- Entering Cuba requires medical insurance, which can be purchased in the country of departure or entrusted to us to purchase in Cuba at a cost of \$5/person/day.
