## Tour introduction

### Day 1

#### Home - Airplane - Honolulu

##### All day

Welcome to paradise on Earth! Shortly upon your arrival, your tour guide will be waiting for you at the airport. He or she will arrange for you to check in at the hotel.

Free pick-up airport: Honolulu International Airport (HNL)

Free pick-up time: 06:30-21:59, This time is the time for the guests to meet with our staff.

It is recommended to book a flight that arrives before 22:00 on the day of pick-up (if there are force majeure factors such as flight delays that cause flights to arrive between 22:00 and 06:00 the next day, free airport pick-up service cannot be provided, thank you for your understanding)

No pick-up service is provided at 22:00-6:29 (All above are local time in Hawaii).

### Day 2

#### Pearl Harbor - Vehicle - Half day city tour

##### All day

At 07:45am we will depart from the hotel to visit Pearl Harbor located in the southwestern part of Oahu, Hawaii. Pearl Harbor overlooks the USS Arizona Memorial, which was sunk by the Japanese army, as well as USS Missouri.

Afterwards, we will pass by the Hawaii State Capitol and the Pacific National Cemetery for Soldiers and Martyrs, which was closed to sightseeing vehicles after the 9/11 incident. We will pass through Chinatown and overlook the bronze statue of Mr. Sun Yat-sen. We will visit the bronze statue of the first king of Hawaii, Kamehameha, the King's Palace, and the city government building. Finally, we will visit the unique emeralds, black pearls, and red coral shops in Hawaii and return to the hotel around 12:00.

##### Itinerary:

**Pearl Harbor** (90 mins, including the USS Arizona Memorial) → **Hawaii State Capitol** (pass by) → **Hawaii Chinatown** (pass by) → **Kamehameha Statue, Kapaau** (outside visit, 15 mins) → **Iolani Palace** (Looking in the distance) → **Emerald, Black Pearl, Red Coral Shop**

**Note:** Pearl Harbor stipulates that tour guides are not allowed to give explanations within the park; tourists are not allowed to bring any bags into the park, with the exception of wallets.

##### Morning

## **Pearl Harbor**

Pearl Harbor is a harbor on the island of Oahu, Hawaii, west of Honolulu. Much of the harbor and surrounding lands are now a United States Navy deep water naval base. It is also the headquarters of the United States Pacific Fleet. The surprise attack by the Japanese Navy on December 7, 1941, led the United States to declare war on Japan. Thus, making the attack on Pearl Harbor the immediate cause of the United States' entry into World War II.

## **Hawaii State Capital**

Let's explore the Hawaii State Capitol! Today we will take you to visit a historical and important building. The Hawaii State's capital holds the executive and legislative branches of the state. It has a very beautiful architectural style that you must see!

## **Kamehameha Statue, Kapaau**

Let's discover the lovely town in North Kohala of Kapaau! There is the original King Kamehameha I Statue that stands near the North Kohala Civic Center. It is also not far from where Hawaii's greatest king was born. Today, this iconic statue honors King Kamehameha's memory and is a site to see.

## **Iolani Palace**

The 'Iolani Palace is located in the capitol district of downtown Honolulu. It is now a National Historic Landmark listed on the National Register of Historic Places. After the monarchy was overthrown in 1893, the building was used as the capitol building for the Provisional Government, Republic, Territory, and State of Hawaii until 1969. The palace was then restored and opened to the public as a museum in 1978. An interesting fact to note is that the 'Iolani Palace is the only royal palace on US soil.

## **Day 3**

### **Little Circle Island Tour**

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#### **All day**

Join us on this beautiful day as we depart from the hotel! We will first pass by the world-famous-beach Waikiki Beach, to see the Diamond Head volcano! This beach is also a hotspot surf center that has spectacular sea views. Following that we will pass through the high-class residential area of Hahaione and stop at the Hanauma Bay. Shortly after, we will visit the natural wonders of the sea spring vents and pass by Sauna Beach. Here, we will overlook Rabbit Island and Turtle Island! Take a look as we pass by the White Beach, the Hawaiian National Reserve, and the Dafengkou Scenic Area. Finally, we will return to the hotel.

### Itinerary:

**Waikiki Beach** (Pass-by) → **Diamond Head Lookout** (15 mins) → **Hala Premium Residential District** (pass by) → **Hanauma Bay Scenic Area** (15 mins) → **Hālonā Blowhole** (15 mins) → **Sauna Beach** (pass by) → **Rabbit Island and Turtle Island** (overlooking) → **White Beach, Hawaiian National Reserve** (pass by) → **Nuuanu Pali Lookout** (15 mins)

Afternoon

### Waikiki Beach

Waikiki is a neighborhood of Honolulu on the south shore of the island of Oʻahu. Waikiki is most famous for Waikiki Beach, which is one of six beaches in the district, along with Queen's Beach, Kuhio Beach, Gray's Beach, Fort DeRussy Beach, and Kahanamoku Beach.

### Hālonā Blowhole

On windy days when the tide is high, the ocean breeze sends the waves rolling onto the shore where the rock formation then shoots sea spray high into the air through the cave acting like a geyser. Today you will look at the Hālonā blowhole. This blowhole is most active when the tide is high, and the winds are strong. It can even shoot sea sprays up to thirty feet high in the air.

### Nuuanu Pali Lookout

Just a five-mile drive northeast of Downtown Honolulu is the Nuuanu Pali Lookout. It offers panoramic views of the sheer Koolau cliffs and lush Windward Coast. The Pali Lookout is also known for its strong and howling winds. You'll understand why the Nuuanu Pali Lookout is one of Oahu's best scenic points when you feel the wind pushing up against you. You can even hear the winds whistle through the mountains and see the breathtaking views of Oahu's lush Windward Coast.

## Day 4

### Hawaii Island Tour

All day

Today we will fly to Hawaii Island from Honolulu. First, we will go to the rare black sand. At the same time, there will be great, green surprises waiting to be discovered in these black sands. Passing through Banyan Avenue, we came to a biscuit shop famous for its handmade biscuit. Afterwards, we will arrive at Wailua River State Park, where the bronze statue of King Kamehameha of Hawaii is erected. Then we will arrive at Rainbow Falls, one of the most famous waterfalls in Hawaii. It is named after the common rainbow. When the water splashes, you will see the rainbow as if it

was generated in the waterfall. Finally, we will come to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. In the visitor center, you can see the changes caused by volcanic activity on the park and the entire island. Such exhibits include visiting the steam holes formed by the rich rainfall and volcanic geothermal in Hawaii; getting up close at the Halemaumau Lookout to observe the crater and feel the majesty of nature; visit the huge Thurston magma tunnel formed by the flow of magma; and seeing with your own eyes the sight of lava flowing through the land on the Chain Crater Road!

#### **Itinerary:**

**Fly from Honolulu to Hawaii Island → Richardson Black Sand Beach (15-20 mins) → Banyan Avenue (Vehicle View) → Big Island Biscuit Shop (15-20 mins) → Wailua River State Park/King Statue (15-20 mins) → Rainbow Falls (15-20 mins) → Hawaii Volcanoes National Park (15-20 mins)**

#### **Richardson Ocean Park**

Richardson Ocean Park is the black sand beach closest to Hilo. It is known to the locals as 'Richardson's' and is the best choice for snorkeling on the East side of the Big Island. Richardson's is part of a series of beach parks along Kalaniana'ole (south Hilo). If you take a close look at the sand on Richardson beach you will see that it is mostly made out of black lava sand!

#### **Rainbow Falls**

The Rainbow Falls cascades 80 ft over a lava cave! Legend has it that it is home to the ancient Hawaiian goddess Hina, the goddess of the moon.

#### **Hawaii Volcanoes National Park**

Explore the most geological, powerful, and biological landscapes at the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park! This is a national park that will blow your mind away. It is truly a diverse national park that demonstrates the true power of nature. Explore this unique national park with us today!

## **Day 5**

### **Maui 1-day Tour**

All day

Today we will fly to Maui. First, we will visit the Kepaniwai Park & Heritage Gardens to learn about the history and lifestyle of people with different cultural backgrounds in the Hawaiian Islands. Then we will arrive at the Maui Tropical

Plantation. You may stroll through the lush gardens and admire rare plants from the Hawaiian Islands. Then, follow us and head towards the shops at Wailea for a unique shopping experience! Next, we will go visit Makena Beach, known as "Big Beach", to feel the infinite charm of its golden sand and white waves. Next, we will go to Lava Fields – visiting both Ke'one'olo and Ho'okipa Beach Park to enjoy the unique volcanic landform and marine life activities. We will also pass by Mama's Fish House along the way, a popular Hawaiian style restaurant, if you are looking for a bite. Finally, we will arrive at the art town of Paia, where you will be immersed in the artistic atmosphere! Then, we will stay overnight in Honolulu.

### **Itinerary:**

**Fly From Honolulu to Maui → Kepaniwai Park & Heritage Gardens (15-20 mins) → Maui Tropical Plantation (15-20 mins) → The shops at Wailea (15-20 mins) → Makena Beach (15-20 mins) → Lava Fields (15-20 mins) → Ke'one'olo (15-20 mins) → Mama's Fish House (15-20 mins) → Ho'okipa Beach Park (15-20 mins) → Paia Town (15-20 mins) → Honolulu**

### **Kepaniwai Park and Heritage Gardens**

Kepaniwai Park and Heritage Gardens, adjacent to the Wailuku Stream, is a beautiful public park containing displays that honor the cultures that contributed to modern Maui. Among the interesting structures are an early-Hawaiian hale, a New England–style saltbox, a Portuguese-style villa with gardens, and dwellings from such other cultures as China and the Philippines. The park's name harkens back to the infamous Battle of Kepaniwai in 1790 between Kamehameha I and Kahekili, king of Maui.

### **Maui Tropical Plantation**

Maui Tropical Plantation is located in Waikapu, on the road heading from Kihei towards Lahaina. The property covers over 60 acres and is home to a wide variety of tropical plants, including crops being cultivated at the plantation including coffee, macadamia nuts, avocado, and papaya.

### **Makena Beach**

Makena Beach is located south of Wailea and provides a secluded alternative to more crowded beaches in Kaanapali and Lahaina. With its dramatic cliff landscape and brilliant blue/green water, Makena Beach is one of the most popular shorelines in Maui. It's often referred to as Maui's "Big Beach" and is one of the largest beaches on the island, with golden sands extending nearly 1.5 miles long and 100 yards wide. You can swim or snorkel in the water, enjoy a picnic in the shade, or simply sunbathe on the seemingly endless expanse of sand. Whatever you choose, a trip to Makena Beach will be one you'll never forget!

### **Ho'okipa Beach Park**

Hookipa — it means "hospitality" in Hawaiian. Located miles away from the crowds, this pristine beach is nestled on the island's north shore alongside the Road To Hana. Thanks to its consistent winds, large waves, and sprawling reef

system, this is one of the best locations in all of Hawaii for windsurfing. Modern-day surfing on Maui started here, at this beach just outside of the charming artsy town of Paia on Maui's northern coastline.
