### Day 1

### **New York - Vehicle - Watkins Glen State Park - Vehicle - Niagara Falls**

All day

We will head north to Watkins Glen State Park in this morning! Later, we are going to see the famous Niagara Falls. Overlooking American Fall, the Horseshoe Fall and the Bridal Veil Fall, you will be astounded by the deafening roar of the falls. It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful.

#### **Itinerary:**

**New York → Watkins Glen State Park + Finger Lake** (Optional, 90 mins, After the park closes, the itinerary will proceed to the Corning Museum of Glass.) → **Niagara Falls Night Tour** (Mandatory, 90mins)

#### **Notes:**

1. Watkins Glen State Park + Finger Lakes is a seasonal summer itinerary. We will visit after the state park officially opens (generally from May to October each year). Please refer to the park's official website for the exact opening date. If Watkins Glen State Park is closed, the attraction will be replaced with the Corning Museum of Glass (Optional, 90 mins).

2. In order to ensure a better experience for guests, it is guaranteed that guests can watch the fireworks show at the waterfall on that day (except that there is no fireworks show on that day).

### **Watkins Glen State Park**

Watkins Glen is located in the Finger Lakes region of New York State, USA. It is a stratified rock geology, which has been eroded by glaciers and streams, forming a unique landform. There are more than a dozen waterfalls along the approximately two-mile canyon trail. There are excellent canyon trails, waterfalls that can be admired up close, and pleasing natural scenery, providing tourists with an excellent photo spot, and it is known as the "Millennium Valley".

### **The Corning Museum of Glass**

The world-renowned Corning Glass Center is located in Corning, a small town with unique style and quaint flavor in upstate New York. Although it is a small city, it is the center of the American glass industry. The status of Corning's glass and porcelain in the United States is just like the status of Jingdezhen porcelain in China, and it is also well-known in the world. Corning Glass Center can be said to be a magical glass world. Corning Glass Center has about 100,000 pieces of glass boutiques and artistic sculptures on display. These exquisite glass products are either colorful or crystal clear, dazzling and overwhelming. The Glass Center is not only a glass museum, but also a factory for the production of glass strengthening, glassware and handicrafts, and a store that sells glass and crystal products such as sunglasses, necklaces, pins, etc.

### **Niagara Falls Night View Tour**

variety of exotic flowers and trees up close; stand on two islands - Ram Island and Moon Island, and appreciate the magnificence of the Water of Thor from multiple angles in the dark; see the three major waterfalls - Horseshoe Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and American Falls, and feel the majestic momentum of nature presented by the different faces of the waterfalls under the illumination of colorful neon lights. ### **IMAX: Niagara (Canada side)**

See everything so close in the IMAX Movie Theatre. Walk back to the past. In 45 minutes you will witness Niagara Falls' incredible stories that would take a lifetime experience! The larger-than-life Niagara Falls IMAX Experience brings reality to life on a screen over six stories high. With 12,000 watts of floor shaking digital surround sound, you'll feel like you're there. Whether it's going over Niagara Falls, scaling the top of Mount Everest or speeding around the Indy track at 230 miles per hour, IMAX films are guaranteed to take you places you've never been before!

### **Voyage to the Falls Boat Tour**

The Niagara Falls boat is always the most famous way to have fun at Niagara Falls. Put on a thin red raincoat, take the white double-decker cruise ship, and the most exciting waterfall trip will begin. The Niagara Falls boat, which looks quite historic but very sturdy, will bravely sail all the way from the river bank to the waterfall and enter the horseshoe-shaped center circle of the waterfall. The abundant river water rushes towards you like a thousand horses galloping. Suddenly, the strangers on the boat seem to become the same boat. In the hazy water, you can personally feel the momentum and power of the waterfall. After leaving the storm circle, the cruise ship is like a small boat that has returned from a disaster, swaying towards the American Falls. When the weather is clear, the sunlight and water vapor interweave to form a long and beautiful rainbow, projected in front of the veritable "Rainbow Bridge".

### **Journey Behind the Falls**

This is one of Niagara's oldest tourist hotspots. Take the elevator down 125 feet and through a short tunnel you will reach two outdoor observation decks and two entrances directly behind the falls. Walk to the upper and lower observation decks to experience the magic of Horseshoe Falls from directly below the falls. You will experience the spectacular sight of one-fifth of the world's fresh water rushing into the basin below. The height at the foot of the observation deck may make you "wet" or amazed, but don't forget that after all this, one-fifth of the world's fresh water, Niagara Falls, a must-see in a lifetime, will appear before your eyes!

### **Skylon Tower**

The Skylon Tower allows visitors to get a better view of Niagara Falls. It is the closest tower to the Horseshoe Falls. It is over 100 meters high. Half of the elevator leading to the observation deck on the top of the tower is inlaid with glass, so you can enjoy the scenery while the elevator is going up and down. There are theaters and game venues in the tower, and the top floor is a revolving restaurant. You will have the opportunity to enjoy a meal in the famous 360-degree revolving restaurant, or enjoy a more family-friendly casual dining in the Summit Suite buffet restaurant in the tower. The beautiful scenery is in full view. Whether it is a romantic meal for two or a

family vacation, you can enjoy the luxurious and superior dining environment and world-class culinary cuisine! During the dining period, Ride-to-the-Top and Indoor/Outdoor Observation Deck Niagara Falls are free to enter.

### **Casa Loma Royal Castle**

Located high above and overlooking the city of Toronto, this century-old castle with 98 rooms is a representative of dreamy architecture, as if taking you back to the Edwardian era. You can quietly pass through the winding secret passages that extend throughout the castle, visit the beautifully decorated rooms engraved with the marks of the times, and explore the legendary memories that have been deposited for a hundred years; you can also go up to the tower to enjoy the charming and unique scenery of Toronto. Many Hollywood movies have been filmed here, and many charity events and high-society parties are often held here. The ceiling of the lobby on the first floor is beautiful plaster and exquisite carvings, inspired by the palace of the Elizabethan era.

### **CN Tower**

The CN Tower is a symbol of Toronto and a must-see attraction for tourists visiting Toronto. From top to bottom, it consists of four parts: the base, the observation deck, the "sky canopy" and the antenna tower. The most unique feature of the CN Tower is the glass floor built on the observation deck. This fan-shaped glass floor is 342 meters high, which makes almost every tourist who tries to step on this floor eager to try and challenge themselves with an "adventurous" mood.

### **Ripley's Aquarium of Canada**

Ripley's Aquarium of Canada is located in downtown Toronto, Canada, just southeast of the famous CN Tower. It is the largest aquarium in Canada. There are more than 16,000 marine creatures here, and it features a 96-meter-long moving passage, located in a transparent sightseeing tunnel. Above you are sharks, large rays and their lagoons. Visitors will be inspired to care for and protect the precious water world while having fun.

## Toronto's Chinatown

Since 1878, Toronto's Chinatown has been gradually formed by overseas Chinese from Singapore, Vietnam and other places. At present, there are many Chinese restaurants, shops, vegetable and fruit markets, massage centers, etc., and the decoration and style are quite Chinese. Every Spring Festival is a very lively time in Chinatown. The characteristic dragon dance parade is carried out with the accompaniment of gongs and drums, which is very lively. The Dragon Boat Race held every June on Lake Ontario has become a summer entertainment event in Toronto.

**Thousand Islands Cruise**

The water of Lake Ontario flows out into the St. Lawrence River. There are 1,865 natural islands of various sizes and one artificial island in the St. Lawrence River Bay. It is called the Thousand Islands Lake, also known as the St. Lawrence Islands National Park. The Thousand Islands Lake cruise allows you to appreciate the infinite scenery. You will see various traces left by history on the edge of the island. You can take a cruise to travel among the islands and appreciate the mansions and islands of different sizes and shapes.

### **Parliament Hill**

Parliament Hill refers to the area centered on the Parliament Building. It is also the symbol of Ottawa and even the whole of Canada. The maple leaf flag fluttering in the wind on the clock tower and a series of stone-built copper-roofed Gothic buildings standing firmly on the banks of the Ottawa River symbolize the indomitable spirit of the Canadian nation. There is also an observation deck on the Peace Tower, from which you can overlook the panoramic view of Ottawa. Oil lamps will be lit on the tower during the Parliament Building meeting.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Ottawa to Montreal

### **Double Decker Montreal**

A double-decker sightseeing bus is one of the best ways to experience Montreal. The bus features two levels, with an open-air upper deck, perfect for exploring the city. The itinerary includes highlights such as Notre-Dame Basilica, allowing you to freely and comfortably appreciate the beauty of Montreal's diverse cultural landscape. Every sight, every sound, and every commentary may hold hidden surprises!

### **Montréal City Hall**

Montreal's City Hall, located north of Place Jacques Cartier in Old Montreal, was built in 1878 in the then-popular French Second Empire style. In 1922, the original building was largely destroyed by fire, prompting architect Louis Parant to rebuild it. The structure employed cutting-edge steel structures of the time. To preserve the original style, the building was modeled after the Tours City Hall in France. The roof design incorporated the then-popular Neo[1]Decorative style, and the original slate roofing was replaced with a copper roof. Bearing the hallmarks of its architectural history, the building was designated a Canadian Landmark in 1984.

## Old Montreal

Old Montreal refers to the Old Port on the north bank of the St. Lawrence River and the surrounding urban area. It is the oldest neighborhood in Montreal. Revealing a strong European flavor, Old Montreal is a must-see attraction for tourists. The churches in the old city and the old stone houses with European characteristics seem to be telling the changes in people and things that it has seen over the past few hundred years through the change of seasons. The air is filled with cultural atmosphere and petty bourgeoisie sentiment!

## Day 4

### Montreal - Vehicle - Quebec

### **Old Quebec**

Quebec is the only city in North America with a fortress wall. The mottled old city wall tells the unknown past. With the Royal Square as the center, there are many narrow streets from the early days of the city and ancient buildings such as the Knights Inn and the Victory Church. At the same time, it is one of the key areas of modern American colonization and development. It was listed as a World Cultural Heritage in 1985.

### **Montmorency Falls**

Montmorency Falls is known as the Crystal Falls. The waterfall is very powerful because it has a drop of 83 meters, which is 1.5 times that of Niagara Falls. A large amount of water pours down from the steep cliff into the St. Lawrence River, making a deafening sound and quite majestic.
