Afternoon

Roman Forum

The Roman Forum is a rectangular forum surrounded by the ruins of several important ancient government buildings at the center of Rome. It is also a location of important religious, political, and social activities.

Colosseum

The Colosseum is the iconic symbol of Imperial Rome and one of Rome's most popular tourist attractions! It is an oval amphitheater located in the center of the city of Rome and east of the Roman Forum. It is the largest ancient amphitheater ever built and is still the largest standing amphitheater in the world today.

Arch of Constantine

The Arch of Constantine, located on the west side of the Colosseum, is 25.7 meters long, 7.4 meters wide, and 21

meters high. It has three arches with exquisite sculptures and is magnificent. It was built to commemorate Constantine the Great's victory over Emperor Maxentius and the unification of the Roman Empire. There were 21 triumphal arches in ancient Rome, but only three remain in Rome today. The Arch of Constantine is one of them, and the other two are located in the Roman Forum.

Hotel → **Trevi Fountain** (30 mins) → **Pantheon** (inside visit, 30 mins) → **Mouth of Truth** (30 mins) → **Piazza Venezia** (30 mins) → **Venice Palace** (inside visit, 30 mins) → **St. Peter's Basilica Church** (30 mins) → **Vatican free time** (2 Hours, you can participate in the Vatican Museums at your own expense) → **Italian stewed oxtail meal** (optional) → **Hotel**

Trevi Fountain

The Trevi Fountain is another magnificent location to visit on your trip to Italy! It is a fountain in the Trevi district in Rome. The proper throwing of coins into the Trevi fountain for good luck is a habit extremely common. In order to do so, you must place the coin in your right hand and toss it over your left shoulder!

Pantheon

The Roman Pantheon is the most preserved and influential building of ancient Rome. Probably one of the most fascinating features of the Pantheon is the Architecture. The structure of the Pantheon is comprised of a series of intersecting arches. The arches rest on eight piers which support eight round-headed arches which run through

the drum from its inner to its outer face.

Mouth of Truth

Situated in the portico of Santa Maria in Cosmedin Church, the Mouth of Truth (Bocca della Verità) is a worldwide-famous enormous marble mask said to bite the hand of those who lied. The huge legendary sculpture has a diameter of 1.75 meters and is dedicated to the God of the Sea, represented by a male bearded face with holes for the eyes, nose and mouth.

Palazzo Venezia

The Palazzo Venezia is a palace in Rome that is located between Piazza Venezia and Via del Plebiscito. It is a sober Renaissance building where works of art produced between the early years of Christianity and the Renaissance are exhibited. In the corridors of the palace, you will be able to appreciate different elements, such as Renaissance paintings, polychrome wooden sculptures, rugs, weapons, armor, and terracotta sculptures.

Piazza Venezia

Piazza Venezia or Venice Square is a square in Rome located where four major roads meet. Piazza Venezia is located at the foot of the Capitoline Hill. It owes its name to Palazzo Venezia.

St. Peter's Basilica Church

Take a look at the greatest church in the world at St. Peter's Basilica Church! This is the center and home of the Catholic Church! It was designed by Donato Bramante, Michelangelo, Carlo Maderno, Gian Lorenzo Bernini and many more talented artists. St. Peter's is the most renowned work of Renaissance architecture and the largest church in the world by interior measure. St. Peter's is regarded as one of the holiest Catholic places and has been described as "holding a unique position in the Christian world."

Vatican Museums

Home to some of Italy's most important artworks are the Vatican Museums. From numerous paintings and sculptures to tapestries and classical antiquities, the Vatican Museums (Musei Vaticani) is one of the country's top attractions! Explore the Pinacoteca, Egyptian Museum, Gallery of Tapestries, Pius-Clementine Museum, and Gallery of Maps, before admiring the crown jewels in the Sistine Chapel, famed for Michelangelo's ceiling and The Last Judgment.

Florence Cathedral

It is the symbol of Florence and the tallest building in the city. The church complex consists of the cathedral, bell tower and baptistery. It is not only large in scale, but also a representative building of the early Renaissance. The facade of the church is made of bright red, dark green and white marble, which are arranged into geometric shapes. It is very spectacular and fully interprets the classic, elegant and free spirit advocated by the Renaissance. It looks very solemn and exquisite from any angle. No wonder it is named "Madonna of the Flowers".

Giotto's Campanile

Take a look at the Giotto's Campanile! It is a free-standing campanile that is part of the complex of buildings that make up Florence Cathedral on the Piazza del Duomo. It provides a beautiful panoramic view of the city and of the mountains in the background! It is definitely a must-see location!

The Florence Baptistery

The Florence Baptistery, also known as the Baptistery of Saint John, is a religious building in Florence, Italy, and

has the status of a minor basilica. The Baptistery is renowned for its three sets of artistically important bronze doors with relief sculptures.

Plazza della Signoria

Plazza della Signoria is the busiest and most influential places in all of Florence. It is located in the square in front of Palazzo Vecchio. Plazza della Signoria has a multitude of sculptures and statues such as the equestrian statue of "Father of the Fatherland" and the imitation statue of Michelangelo "The Statue of David" which has been around since 1873.

The Uffizi Gallery

The Palazzo degli Uffizi is one of the most famous and oldest museums in the world and this beautiful Uffizi Museum can be found in Florence Italy.

In such a large museum as the Uffizi, you can't expect to see everything on just one visit. That is why you will find here a list of the top ten masterpieces that you should definitely visit:

In the past, great poets like Shelley and Byron flocked to the region, basking in the coastal beauty and unleashing their poetic genius.

Bologna

Bologna is an amazing city for you to explore in Italy! It is filled with amazing sites, landscapes, delicious Italian dishes and is home to the oldest university in the western world. Explore this wonderful city with us today!

Saint Mark's Basilica

The works of the present St. Mark's Basilica began in 1063 in Byzantine style to represent the power of the

prosperous Venetian Republic. This basilica was built respecting the model of two basilicas of the ancient imperial city of Byzantium with a central plan in the shape of a Greek cross, with five large domes and a particular mixture of ancient and oriental art.

St. Mark's Square

St. Mark's Square is unique among European city squares. It is located in the city center, but it is not as noisy as other squares, thanks to the quiet water traffic in Venice. As a landmark of Venice, it is favored by tourists, photographers and even pigeons. There is a circle of exquisite Renaissance-style buildings on the edge of the square. St. Mark's Basilica, the Mint, and the Doge's Palace are located on the east side of the square. On the south side are the bell tower and the new and old parliament buildings. Climbing the bell tower, you can overlook the entire square.

Bridge of Sighs

The Bridge of Sighs is a Baroque-style stone bridge located on the side of the Doge's Palace. It is one of the most famous bridges in Venice. It is a sealed arch bridge building, and you can only look out through the small windows on the bridge. The two ends of the bridge connect the court and the prison. Death row prisoners pass through this bridge before execution and sigh about their impending life, hence the name "Bridge of Sighs". The current Bridge of Sighs is the bridge in the movie "Bridge of Sighs" where the exiled hero and heroine promised each other for life at sunset, thus sweeping away its gloomy and ominous atmosphere.

The Lion of Venice

The Lion of Venice is an ancient bronze winged lion sculpture in the Piazza San Marco of Venice, Italy. It symbolizes the city as well as one of its patron saints, St Mark, after its arrival there in the 12th century. The sculpture surmounts one of two large granite columns in the Square.

Gondola Rides

Explore a one-of-a-kind Gondola Ride and see what the transportation from one place to another is like on this ride. It is truly something that you must experience at least once in your life!

Venetian Cuttlefish Noodles (Optional):

Special arrangements are made to taste the special Italian cuttlefish noodles. These are a must-eat special food in Venice. Cuttlefish noodles, as the name suggests, are boiled noodles with cuttlefish sauce! The boiled noodles are dark and elastic, but there is absolutely no fishy smell. The delicious noodles have a faint salty taste of seawater and a faint aroma of olive oil.

Finally, we will head into the fashion capital in Milan.

Verona Arena

Verona Arena (Arena di Verona) is a stunning Roman amphitheater built in the 1st century AD. As with many similar Roman constructions, the arena suffered during the decline and fall of the Empire and was pillaged for masonry during the Middle Ages. Despite this however, and with a certain amount of restoration, Verona Arena stands in an excellent state of preservation today and still hosts a number of events, operas, and open-air performances.

Juliet's House

Juliet's House is supposed to be the house where Juliet (from Shakespeare famous love story Romeo and Juliet) used to live. In fact, the balcony of the house was the place where both lovers declared their love to each other. Today, the house is one of the major attractions in Verona and receives thousands of tourists every year!

Lake Garda

Lake Garda or Benaco is the largest in Italy! This luminous environment, temperate climate, and flourishing vegetation of mainly olives, lemon groves, palms, cypresses, oleanders, and orange trees and along with the majestic landscapes are the background to the remarkable historical and cultural remains that were spread all around to make this lake the most charming in Italy.

Milan Cathedral

The world's largest Gothic cathedral is not only a church or a building, but also the spiritual symbol and landmark of Milan, a miracle in the history of world architecture and world civilization. Architectural Features There are 135 spires in the cathedral, each with a statue. Sculptures and spires are one of the characteristics of Gothic architecture. Milan Cathedral fully demonstrates this feature, so it is also the Gothic cathedral with the most statues in the world.

Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II

The Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II is a covered arcade street named after King Vittorio Emanuele II of the unified Italy. It is considered one of the most beautiful commercial arcades in Europe. The arcade was built by the designer in imitation of the classical commercial arcades in Paris. The two intersecting corridors are in the shape of a cross, 198 meters long from north to south and 105 meters long from east to west. The two glass-vaulted corridors meet in the octagonal space in the middle, with a glass dome above. The sun shines through the glass roof and shines on the exquisite reliefs and murals below, emitting a sacred golden light.
