Coral Gables

Coral Gables, a wealthy Miami neighborhood established around the 1820s, boasts a distinctly Spanish character, shaded by trees and surrounded by flowers. Its lush, tree-lined boulevards are lined with luxurious mansions steeped in exotic traditions, making it a popular destination for many American celebrities. The iconic Hotel Baltimore, renowned for its role as a hospital during World War II and its hospitalization of numerous casualties, was a favorite of President and Mrs. Clinton.

Wynwood Walls

Open to the public and free of charge are the amazing Wynwood Walls! It was established in 2009 as an outdoor museum of international street art. Examine an artist dream street here in Wynwood! It is filled with beautiful murals and dedicated artwork on every wall that you walk by!

South Beach

This beach in Miami, Florida, boasts one of the world's most vibrant nightlife, fashion, and entertainment destinations. Furthermore, it boasts numerous cultural institutions, including museums, theaters, and historical sites. For a true glimpse into Miami, South Beach is the perfect choice. It has become Miami's most renowned leisure and entertainment destination, home to hundreds of bars, restaurants, boutiques, and hotels. Its azure waters and silvery sands exude a unique charm.

Freedom Tower at Miami Dade College

Built in 1925, the Freedom Tower is an emblem of the ideal of America as a democratic haven for those seeking freedom and opportunity. From 1962 to 1974, it served as the Cuban Assistance Center. Following several decades of neglect, the Tower was rescued by Cuban American community leaders seeking to honor the Cuban legacy in Miami, who donated it to Miami Dade College in 2005.

FTX Arena

The FTX Arena (formerly known as the American Airlines Arena) is a sports and entertainment arena located in Downtown Miami near Biscayne Bay. It was constructed in the beginning of 1998 as a replacement for the Miami Arena and was designed by the architecture firms Arquitectonica and 360 Architecture. The Arena is home to the Miami Heat of the National Basketball Association.

Miami Bay Cruise

Visit Miami Bay and marvel at the stunning seascape. You can also get up close to Star Island, admire the billionaire mansions of world-famous celebrities, and gaze out over downtown Miami, the second-largest financial center in the United States. No words can truly describe the beauty of Biscayne Bay. The azure waters, gentle breeze, and captivating "Water World" all contribute to the endless allure of Biscayne National Park.

Everglades National Park

Everglades National Park, located in southern Florida, is the largest subtropical wetland park in the United States and the third-largest national park in the country. Covering approximately 1.4 million acres, it is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including birds and alligators. The park has multiple entrances, with the main entrance featuring a visitor center where you can pick up a park map and consult staff for directions. Driving, tour buses, sightseeing boats, hiking, and cycling are the main ways to explore the park. Water activities and jungle adventures require advance reservations.

Everglades Airboat

Here, we will experience an Airboat tour of a lifetime! See for yourself what it is truly like to be part of the swamp and if you are lucky enough you can even capture an up-close picture of a gator too!

Little Havana

This is the famous Cuban Quarter, a must-see for tourists from around the world to visit Cuban cigar workshops, sample specialty Cuban coffee, and experience the exotic charm of Central and South America. Here, there are numerous restaurants, bars, and shops offering unique souvenirs, artwork, books, audiovisual products, and Cuban cigars. Little Havana's rich Cuban ambiance can make you feel like you're in the United States. Little Havana's architecture and streets are full of Cuban influences, and you can even smell the air filled with the scent of Cuban cigars, accompanied by the sounds of meguere and salsa.

Night

Drive 180 miles south from the hotel to the very end of the Florida Keys—Key West, known as the "End of the World." Along the way, the vibrant colors of the sea and the azure sky create a uniquely beautiful scene. During the approximately 4.5-hour drive (in good road conditions), you'll pass through a magnificent "cross-sea bridge" on U.S. Highway 1, known as the "Eighth Wonder of the World," comprised of 42 bridges of varying lengths and 32 islands. Finally, arrive at Key West for a guided tour.

Heading to Key West → Drive on Route 1 → Key West Island Classic Tour (Mandatory, 2 hours) → **Free Time on Key West Island** (1 hours)

Key West Island Classic Tour: Seven-Mile Bridge (30 mins) → United States Route 1 Beginning Mile 0 (10 mins) → Outside Visit Hemingway Home & Southernmost Point Buoy (20 mins)

Recommended activities for free time: After finishing the tour of the above attractions, you will have 2 hours of free time to explore the charming attractions on the island. After a leisurely lunch, you may visit popular sea-sighting spots such as the Truman Little White House, the Harbor area and the Old Customs House, or go to the Seaside Plaza for some shopping!

Afternoon

Key West

Deep in the Caribbean Sea lies a string of coral reef islands known as the Florida Keys, resembling pearls scattered across the ocean, dazzling and captivating. The southernmost of these is Key West. Key West is the southernmost town in the continental United States, earning it the nickname "Sunset Land." Despite its small permanent population, the island is visited by tourists year-round. The vibrantly colored houses dominate the landscape, while neatly planted paths lined with lush palm trees and dotted with vibrant flowers create a truly captivating scene.

Southernmost Point Buoy

The Southernmost Point Buoy is an anchored concrete buoy located in Key West, Florida. It is the southernmost point in the continental United States at just about 18 feet above sea level. The large painted buoy was established as a tourist attraction in 1983 by the city at the corner of South Street and Whitehead Street. Today, it is one of the most visited and photographed attractions in the entire United States!

Hemingway Home & Museum

The Ernest Hemingway Home and Museum is located on Key West Island in Florida, USA. Hemingway lived there for only ten years, a period that marked the peak of his writing career, with many of his most important works penned here. The home still retains its original appearance, including books and magazines scattered throughout

and a living room ready for entertaining friends. Entering the courtyard, one is greeted by a serene and tranquil atmosphere of lush greenery and blooms. At the end of a short corridor, nestled among the canopy of trees and flowers, lies a Spanish-style two-story building. Its lemon-yellow walls, grass-green window frames, and dark blue roof create a sense of depth and remoteness.

We'll then pass through West Palm Beach and head to Palm Beach Island. Known as Florida's "Cultural Capital," Palm Beach became the first winter escape for America's wealthy over 100 years ago. Enjoy breathtaking views of the Atlantic Ocean and the countless exorbitantly priced beachfront villas.

Fort Lauderdale Beach

Fort Lauderdale, known as the Venice of America, is about an hour's drive from Miami. It boasts unique Palm Beach, a city center encompassing waterways, lakes, and rivers, and a 12-kilometer-long white sand beach lined with palm trees. The pristine waters flow from the warm, clear Atlantic Ocean. Fort Lauderdale Beach is ranked among the ten most beautiful beaches in the United States, boasting pristine white sand and perfect for a winter getaway.

Lion Country Safari

The only animal kingdom in the Southern United States that combines both a drive-in and walk-through experience, this zoo offers close encounters with nearly a thousand wild animals, reminiscent of the African

savannah. Encounter over 900 species, including lions, white rhinos, chimpanzees, zebras, giraffes, and the ever-popular alpaca. Besides the dazzling exhibits, you can also experience animal feedings and participate in activities like jet boat rides. At this premier animal kingdom, you're guaranteed an unforgettable experience, experiencing close encounters with animals. If you're lucky, you'll also be able to attend major zoo events such as World Oceans Day and art performances.

Miami Beach

Miami Beach is a narrow island between Biscayne Bay and the Atlantic Ocean, separated from the city of Miami by a bay. The kilometers of white and soft beaches make it a resort in Miami, with complete facilities such as hotels, shopping malls, restaurants, and entertainment. The famous explosion scene at sea in "Iron Man 3" and the chase scene in "Fast and Furious 2" were both filmed here. The Miami Beach Art Festival in December every year is a comprehensive art festival that combines arts and crafts exhibitions and literary performances. Wonderful art performances will be staged in Miami Beach, which should not be missed.

Brickell City Centre

Brickell City Centre is the core commercial and cultural district of a modern city, integrating business, shopping, and entertainment. It boasts numerous high-rise buildings, housing financial institutions, high-end hotels, and large shopping malls, while preserving historic architecture and public art spaces, showcasing a fusion of tradition and modernity. Transportation is convenient, with a well-developed subway and bus network, and the tree-lined pedestrian area is ideal for a leisurely stroll. Cultural events such as music festivals and exhibitions are held year-round, attracting both tourists and residents. Whether bustling with commercial activity during the day or shimmering with city lights at night, Brickell City Centre is vibrant and has become a landmark area of the city.

Vizcaya Museum and Gardens

The Vizcaya Estate Museum is the private estate of industrial magnate James Deering. The entire building is in Italian Renaissance style and is built by the sea. It has three floors and 70 rooms of different styles, exhibiting exquisite artworks collected by the owner from the 15th to the 19th century. The 10-acre outdoor garden is elegant and peaceful, with plants neatly trimmed by professionals, and dotted with European fountains and sculptures. It is also a good place to enjoy the unbeatable sea view of Biscayne Bay. The private estate has hosted dignitaries and celebrities from various countries many times, and many Hollywood movies have been filmed here. It has now become a popular place for taking wedding photos and artistic photos.
