Welcome to the Sunnylands! The construction of the Sunnylands estate began in 1963. When the Annenbergs were in residence, the main house hosted a significant art collection acquired by the couple. It contained works of Picasso, Van Gogh, Andrew Wyeth, and Monet. Many of their paintings were donated to the Metropolitan Museum of Art following Walter Annenberg's death in 2002. The house is hidden from public view, however there is a pink-brick wall surrounding the estate. In the meantime, take a special look at the hundreds of eucalyptus and olive trees located around the estate.

Salvation Mountain

Salvation Mountain is located in the lower desert of Southern California. Salvation Mountain is Leonard's tribute to God and his gift to the world. It has a simple yet powerful message which states: "God Is Love." Leonard's passion has lovingly created this brilliant "outsider art" masterpiece with not only biblical and religious scriptures of John 3:16, and the Sinner's Prayer. But it also includes flowers, trees, waterfalls, suns, bluebirds, and many other fascinating objects that are waiting for you to discover.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Salvation Mountain to Arizona Capitol Museum

Travel distance: 255mi Travel time: 4Hour30Minute

Arizona Capitol Museum

Join us as we take a special look at the Arizona Capitol Museum building. It is made largely from materials indigenous to Arizona. The materials include malapai, granite and the copper dome. The design is optimal for the desert climate of Arizona. The building is topped with a weathervane similar to the Winged Victory of Samothrace which is seen visible through a skylight from within the rotunda.

Shortly after, we will proceed to visit the beautiful San Xavier del Bac Mission, the best-preserved Spanish colonial building. Next, we will head to one of the most popular attractions in Tucson, Arizona, which is the Sonora Desert Museum. Following, we will head to the Saguaro National Park to admire various cacti, shrubs, flowers and so much more. Then, we will stay overnight in Deming, New Mexico.

Biosphere 2

Biosphere 2 is a miniature artificial ecological cycle system, a closed, man-made ecosystem commissioned by Space Biosphere Ventures. Construction took eight years and cost \$150 million, creating a complete biosphere that is completely sealed off from the outside world. Today, this world-renowned experimental project has been converted into a science museum and is now a tourist attraction. Further exploration of the biosphere requires the continued efforts of scientists.

The Pima Air & Space Museum

The Pima Air & Space Museum is located in Tucson, Arizona. It is one of the world's largest non-governmental funded aerospace museum. This museum features a display of nearly 300 aircrafts that are spread out over 80 acres (320,000 m²) on a campus occupying approximately 127 acres (513,000 m²). It has also been home to the Arizona Aviation Hall of Fame since 1991.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from The Pima Air & Space Museum to San Xavier del Bac Mission

San Xavier del Bac Mission

Mission San Xavier del Bac is a historic Spanish Catholic mission located about 10 miles (16 km) south of downtown Tucson, Arizona, on the Tohono O'odham Nation San Xavier Indian Reservation. The Mission that survives today was built between 1783 and 1797, which makes it the oldest European structure in Arizona. The O'odham has helped to construct the Mission.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from San Xavier del Bac Mission to Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum and Saguaro National Park

Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum

Founded in 1952, the Museum is regularly listed as one of the top ten zoological parks in the world due to its unique approach in interpreting the complete natural history of a single region. Not a "museum" in the usual sense, it is an unparalleled composite of plant, animal, and geologic collections with the goal of making the Sonoran Desert accessible, understandable, and valued.

Saguaro National Park

Located in Arizona, USA, Saguaro National Park was established to preserve the mature saguaro cactus forests that gave the park its name. The park covers 368 square kilometers and is divided into two sections, east and west. The park's landscape is primarily desert, with mountain cactus forests and pine trees, making it a great place to enjoy the desert scenery. The cactus forests are mostly found on the rocky slopes at the base of the park's desert mountains. The giant saguaro cacti do not bloom until late May or early June.

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart for New Mexico's renowned White Sands National Park, home to one of the world's most famous natural wonders. We'll then depart for Carlsbad Caverns National Park, named for the cascading stalactites of all sizes that hang within the caverns, resembling cascades of cascading stalactites. Some are layered like sparkling pearls inlaid on stone pillars, while others stand tall and jagged, resembling majestic beasts. Overnight in Roswell, the world-renowned UFO capital.

White Sands National Park

White Sands National Monument, located in New Mexico, is a desert formed by the weathering of white gypsum. Massive, undulating gypsum dunes cover approximately 300 miles of the desert, creating a vast expanse of white. The dunes are in constant flux, growing, reaching their peaks, and then collapsing, the desert advancing, covering everything in its path. It's important to remember to wear sunglasses when visiting to avoid snow blindness.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from White Sands National Park to Carlsbad Caverns National Park.

Carlsbad Caverns National Park

Carlsbad Caverns National Park, located in New Mexico, features a diverse array of caves that create a vibrant underground world. In 1955, UNESCO designated Carlsbad Caverns National Park a World Heritage Site. The stunning scenes from the film "Journey to the Center of the Earth" were also filmed here. The area is also home to

numerous bat species and other species.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Carlsbad Caverns National Park to Roswell

Roswell - Vehicle - Santa Fe - Vehicle - Albuquerque

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll travel to Old Santa Fe, home to a vibrant outdoor market, historic buildings, art galleries, museums, trendy restaurants, and shops. In the afternoon, we'll travel to Albuquerque, the Hot Air Balloon Capital of the World, where we'll visit the Hot Air Balloon Museum, learn about the history of hot air balloons, and enjoy a 3D movie. We'll spend the night in Albuquerque.

Santa Fe Plaza

The Santa Fe Plaza is a National Historic Landmark in downtown Santa Fe, New Mexico in the style of traditional Spanish-American colonial cities. The plaza, or "city-square", was originally, and is still to this day, the center gathering place in town. Many know it as "the heart of Santa Fe". The landmark has since grown into a playground for many tourists interested in Spanish, Native American, and Mexican cultures, and includes music, design, jewelry, art and dancing activities. Known to locals simply as the "Plaza," it is home to annual events including Fiestas de Santa Fe, the Spanish Market, the Santa Fe Bandstand, and the Santa Fe Indian Market. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the plaza consists of a central park lined with grass, trees, and benches.

Afternoon Transportation: Travel from Santa Fe to Albuquerque

Travel distance: 60mi Travel time: 1Hour

Afternoon

Balloon Fiesta Park

Every October, a hot air balloon festival is held here. Due to the unique geographical conditions, the balloons are affected by southerly winds at low altitudes and northerly winds at high altitudes, allowing them to circle back to their starting point. Normally, this area is used as a hot air balloon museum, golf training, and model airplane flight training ground. Join us as we explore the history of hot air balloons and enjoy a 3D movie!

Gallup - Vehicle - Petrified Forest National Park - Vehicle - Sedona

Today, we will head to Gallup, New Mexico! We will take in all the unique beauty and then head to Petrified Forest National Park! This park is the largest and most beautiful, petrified forest in the world. Following, we will look at the Meteor Crater which is located on a plateau at an altitude of 1,740 meters. It is truly an incredible site to see and is one of the largest craters in the world! We will enjoy a day filled with incredible memories and stay overnight in Sedona.

Itinerary:

Albuquerque → **Gallup** (45 mins) → **Petrified Forest National Park** (2 hours) → **Meteor Crater Natural Landmark** (45 mins) → **Sedona**

Morning Transportation: Travel from Abu Queki to Gallup

Travel distance: 150mi Travel time: 2Hour20Minute

Gallup

The city was founded in 1881 as a railhead for the Atlantic and Pacific Railroad, and named after David Gallup, a paymaster for the railroad. It is on the Trails of the Ancients Byway, one of the designated New Mexico Scenic Byways. Because of the nearby rugged terrain, it was a popular location in the 1940s and 1950s for Hollywood Westerns movies.

Petrified Forest National Park

Petrified Forest National Park is one of the largest and most spectacular concentrations of petrified forests in the world. It is renowned for its numerous petrified forests of varying densities, with names such as Black Forest, Crystal Forest, and Rainbow Forest. Most of the trees in the park are conifers similar to Araucaria trees, which grew during the Triassic period, approximately 225 million years ago. Besides the fossilized wood, the park also features the badlands landscape known as the "Painted Desert" and early Indian ruins.

Meteor Crater Natural Landmark

Meteor Crater is a meteorite impact crater about 37 mi (60 km) east of Flagstaff and 18 mi (29 km) west of Winslow in the northern Arizona desert of the United States. Despite historic attempts to make the crater a public landmark, the crater remains privately owned by the Barringer family to the present day through their Barringer Crater Company, which proclaims it to be the "best-preserved meteorite crater on Earth". It was designated a National Natural Landmark in November 1967.

Afternoon Transportation: Travel by car from Barringer Crater to Sedona

Day 7

Sedona - Vehicle - Route 66 - Vehicle - Las Vegas

All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll explore Sedona, the Red Rock Country and renowned for its aura. We'll then visit the Chapel of the Holy Cross, a landmark believed to possess the strongest magnetic field in the region. In the afternoon, we'll travel along Route 66, America's Mother Road, passing the renowned Hoover Dam before arriving in Las Vegas, the world's gambling capital.

Itinerary:

Sedona (3 hours, optional for Sedona Trolley) → **Drive on Route 66** → **Hoover Dam** (Pass by) → **Las Vegas**

Sedona

Sedona, one of the world's most powerful locations, attracts millions of visitors annually for its breathtaking red rock formations. This mysterious place is believed to possess supernatural spirituality and is an ancient sacred

site revered by Native Americans. Legend has it that due to its unique structure, a mysterious energy focus exists. Simply stepping onto these red rocks can invigorate and transform your life. Consequently, countless pilgrims flock here each year to replenish their vital energy.

Chapel of the Holy Cross

The Chapel of the Holy Cross is a Roman Catholic chapel built into the buttes of Sedona, Arizona. The main feature of the chapel is a 90 ft (27.4 m) tall iron cross on the southwestern wall, which serves both aesthetic and structural purposes.

Route 66

U.S. Route 66 or U.S. Highway 66 (US 66 or Route 66), also known as the Will Rogers Highway, the Main Street of America or the Mother Road, was one of the original highways in the U.S. Highway System. US 66 was established on November 11, 1926, with road signs erected the following year. The highway, which became one of the most famous roads in the United States, originally ran from Chicago, Illinois, through Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico, and Arizona before terminating in Santa Monica in Los Angeles County, California, covering a total of 2,448 miles (3,940 km). It was recognized in popular culture by both the hit song "Get Your Kicks on Route 66" and the Route 66 television series, which aired on CBS from 1960 to 1964. In John Steinbeck's classic American novel, *The Grapes of Wrath* (1939), the road "Highway 66" symbolized escape and loss.
