Rome, Assisi, Perugia, Chianti, San Gimignano, Siena, San Marino

D1 Home City/ Rome

Depart from home city for Rome, the capital of Italy.

D2 Rome

Arrive at Rome, a city blended with long history, unique culture and world famous monuments. You will be greeted and transferred to the hotel for rest.

Hotel: Sheraton Parco De Medici or similar

D3 Rome - Assisi (city tour) - Perugia

Head to Assisi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2000 and as well, the Birthplace of St Francis. On arrival, an inside visit is paid to its Basilica where the naval walls are decorated with the famous cycle to contain scenes from the life of St Francis from his youth through death with miracles attributed to him. Then, onto Perugia, known for its defensive walls around the historic center. Piazza IV Novembre, The Fontana Maggiore and San Lorenzo Cathedral are all included in the photo stops.

Hotel: Gio Wine e Jazz or similar B/D

D4 Perugia - Chianti Region - San Gimignano - Siena (city tour)

Coach to the most famous wine region in Italy, Chianti, where all will have a tasting of the local wine with dried meats and various brands of olive oils. Continue to San Gimignano, a UNESCO hill town with a skyline of medieval towers, for a specially arranged florentine steak lunch. A visit to its old town centres encircled by 13th-century walls and lined with medieval houses is a must. After a brief orientation, we will leave San Gimignano for Siena. The first stop of the city tour on arrival will be at the stunning Piazza del Campo, home to the Palio horse race. Then, onto the Gothic Palazzo Pubblico and the Torre del Mangia clock tower. Finally, at the Siena Cathedral to admire its facade and its marble stripes in symbolic black and white.

Hotel: NH Siena or similar B/L

D5 Siena - San Marino (city tour) - Rimini

Surrounded by Italy, San Marino is one of the small countries in Europe. We will take a panoramic view of the country from the mountain top and then enter the old town, a UNESCO site, for photo taking and lunch. Afterwards, take a cable car to the city center where stops at Basilica of St Marinus, Public Palace and Piazza della Liberta are all included. Leave San Marino for Rimini, a charming seaside town famed for its beautiful beaches. Photo stops and shopping time will be provided upon arrival.

Hotel: Mercure Rimini or similar B/L

D6 Rimini - Ravenna (city tour) - Bologna (city tour)

Drive to Ravenna, renowned for the colorful Byzantine mosaics adorning many of its central buildings. The city tour will cover Dante Tomb, the Tomb of Galla Placidia, San Vitale Church, etc and stop at Piazza del Popolo and Theodoric's Mausoleum for photo taking. In the afternoon, leave Ravenna for Bologna. Another city tour is arranged to explore Piazza Maggiore, Fontana di Nettuno, Palazzo del Comunale, etc. It will be ended at Asinelli Tower and L'Archiginnasio, home to the Municipal Library and a historic theatre.

Hotel: NH Bologna or similar B/L

D7 Bologna - Florence (city tour) - Pisa

Coach to Florence, the cradle of Renaissance. Stop at the Piazzale Michelangelo for a panoramic view of the city. The multi-colored Cathedral, Signoria Square, Ponte Vecchio Bridge, etc are all in the sightseeing list. Then, onto Pisa for photo taking of the famous Leaning Tower, the Cathedral and the Baptistery.

Hotel: AC hotel Pisa or similar B

D8 Pisa - La Spezia (Cinque Terre) - Parma

In the morning, leave Pisa for Cinque Terre, a string of five centuries-old seaside villages on the rugged Italian coast and as well, a dream holiday resort for urban Italians. We will ride on a train and pass through these five villages each with stopovers to enjoy the exhilarating air as well as the breathtaking scenery where the local villagers reside. Continue to Parma to visit a Prosciutto ham mill. A special dinner with Parma ham tasting at a local restaurant is arranged.

Hotel: Hotel Parma e Congressi or similar B/D

D9 Parma (city tour) - Fidenza Village (shopping) - Milan

The morning city tour will include visits to the Cathedral and its Baptistery, Basilica di Santa Maria della Steccata and the Baroque-style Teatro Riggio. Later, coach to Fidenza Village, an outdoor mall with more than 120 upscale luxury boutiques. Ample time will be provided for shopping your favorite items. Finally, we will arrive at Milan, the fashion capital of Italy. Visits to the Milan Cathedral, Galleria Vittorio Emanuele and La Scala Opera House are included before you are free for further shopping or to explore the city on your own.

Hotel: Tribe Hotel Malpensa or similar B
