Day 1 Arrive at Athens, Greece

We offer free pick-up services on the first day of your tour at the Athens International Airport (ATH) at 12:00 and 18:00 (this will be the time that the tour guide leaves the airport after meeting with the guest).

Day 2

Athens City Tour

Athens, the capital of Greece, is known as the cradle of Western civilization and the birthplace of European philosophy. It is the origin of the modern Olympic Games and is called the "City of Gods". It is named after the noble goddess Athena and narrates its history with heroic legends and epic wars.

Itinerary:

Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (Outside visit, 15 mins) → **Presidential Palace** (Outside visit, 15 mins) → **Athens Hellenic Parliament** (Outside visit, 20 mins) → **The main venue of the first Olympic Games** (Outside visit, 10 mins) → **Acropolis of Athens** (**Ticket included**, 120 mins) → **Plaka Old Town** (30 mins) → **Little Kook** (30 mins)

All day

Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

The Tomb of the Unknown soldier is located in Syntagma Square by the Hellenic Parliament building. The tomb honors all the Greek soldiers who were killed in war. There is a special remembrance ceremony performed here that further honors the soldiers.

Presidential Mansion

The Greek Presidential Palace is located in Athens, the capital of Greece. It is also the official residence of the Greek President. Built of marble, the palace is beige in color and adopts a neoclassical architectural style. Ten Victorian marble columns stand in a row on the facade of the three-story building. The Greek flag flies from the roof of the central main building, making the entire building look magnificent.

Athens Hellenic Parliament

The Greek Parliament Building, originally the palace of King Otto, the first king of Greece, was designed by the German court architect of Bavaria, Carlo Gallodonna. Besides the Acropolis, the most popular attraction in Greece is the daily Changing of the Guard ceremony. A must-see when visiting Athens, the Changing of the Guard ceremony at the Monument of the Unknown Soldier in Constitution Square is a must-see. The guard changes every two hours, with a grand ceremony every Sunday at 12:00 AM. Following the ceremony, two officers come forward to help the two guards adjust their uniforms, after which visitors can take photos with them.

The Panathenaic Stadium

The spectacular Panathenaic Stadium remains one of the city's most popular tourist attractions and is a shining beacon of modern Athens. Following several transformations over its long history, it eventually became the home of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896 and remains the only stadium in the world built entirely out of marble.

Acropolis of Athens

The Acropolis of Athens, located southwest of the city center and perched atop the over 150-meter-high Acropolis Hill, is the city's landmark and a symbol of ancient Greece. Encompassing four of the greatest masterpieces of classical Greek art—the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, and the Temple of Athena Nike—the Acropolis embodies the civilization, mythology, and religion that flourished in Greece for over a thousand years and is considered a symbol of the concept of World Heritage. In 1987, the Acropolis was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List as a cultural heritage site.

Plaka Old Town

Plaka is the best area for strolling in Athens. There are many 19th-century streets and interconnected alleys here. In addition to experiencing the traditional Greek folk customs, tourists can also buy exotic souvenirs in the numerous small shops, such as replicas of ancient Greek sculptures, attempted imitations of ancient Greek bronze statues, Greek-style gifts and pottery, painted plates, gold and silver jewelry with Greek classical patterns, traditional clothing, etc.

Little Kook

With a menu that would make a diabetic cry, Little Kook is a well-known coffee shop and dessert place with a hardcore following. But beyond its delicious cakes and scrumptious pancakes, what makes Little Kook stand out is its fairy-tale-themed interior.

Day 3

Athens - Airplane - Santorini

Today we'll depart Athens and fly to Santorini, a city in the Aegean Sea whose whitewashed walls and blue roofs captivate visitors from around the world. Upon arrival, we'll arrange for a private transfer to your hotel for check-in. Afterwards, you'll have free time on the island or, at your own expense, take a two-hour sunset tour of Oia.

Santorini

Located in the southern Aegean Sea, Greece, Santorini boasts picturesque scenery, a wealth of classic Aegean blue and white architecture, vibrant beaches, and pristine, beautiful bays, making it a coveted honeymoon paradise and vacation destination. It's also the legendary site of the ancient civilization of Atlantis, steeped in mystery. The small town of Fira, perched atop a cliff on Santorini's west side, is bustling with narrow alleyways lined with shops and restaurants. It's also a great spot for ocean views. Relaxing on the sandy beach, enjoying the sea breeze and the bright sunshine, is a truly relaxing experience.

Oia Town Sunset Tour

The small town of Oia, also known as the Oia Art Village, is located in the northwest corner of Santorini and is rated as one of the 10 best sunset viewing spots by the World Tourism Organization. At the same time, it is also an artist's paradise, with blue and white houses, sometimes the dome of the church will be displayed in front of your eyes, and sometimes there will be bougainvillea climbing the walls to make you feel shocked. There is no hustle and bustle of FIRA, but there is a unique harmony, there is no magnificence of the red sand beach, but there is the spectacle of the sunset in the sky, the windmill on the edge of the town, telling the feelings of the sunset every day, the viewing platform allows guests to have The best camera position to capture that eternal moment. In the small town of Oia, it is no longer just a combination of blue and white. The red bougainvillea and the orange wind chimes make people nostalgic and unforgettable. Depart from your hotel or Fira town to Oia and return to your hotel after sunset.

Cliff Hotel Tips:

Cliff Hotel is a collective name for hotels located in different cliff areas of the Holy Island. The cliffs represent the geographical location. It does not mean that the hotel must be built on the edge of the cliff, nor does it mean that all rooms in the hotel can see the cliff view. The scale of the cliff hotel is limited. Therefore, the travel agency arranges the hotel in the cliff area. Most of the hotels are small and the rooms are simply furnished. The cliff hotel area is basically a stepped stone road. Parking is prohibited in front of the hotel and guests need to walk into the store with hand luggage. The walk takes about 10-20 minutes. The clientele of the cliff hotel is mainly for couples. Due to the geographical location, many cliff hotels are reluctant to accept children for safety reasons.

Day 4

Join us for another amazing day as we take you to visit the capital town of Fira! Enjoy the beauty of this city and explore all that it has to offer! Or take part in the Santorini island tour (about 5 hours) and the Santorini catamaran sailing (about 5 hours, at least 8 people per boat) at your own expense.

All day

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Santorini Catamaran Sailing

The catamaran yacht swims in the romantic Aegean Sea, the most popular project on the Holy Island! Pick-up from the pier by private car, take a catamaran yacht to sea, pass by red sandy beaches (formed by rich volcanic mineral soil) and white sandy beaches, no one can resist coral reefs and crystal clear waters. We will go to the peculiar black rock formed naturally after the volcanic eruption, known by the locals as "the face of the Indians". After passing the "Venice Lighthouse", the yacht will sail to the Nea Kameni volcanic natural hot spring and stopped in the calm bay for swimming, fishing and dining. In addition to visiting the yacht, you can also enjoy VIP-style service, free drinks, local seafood barbecue dinner, live cooking on board, free snorkeling, sea fishing

equipment, and a cheerful atmosphere. Make sure to also enjoy the beautiful scenery and the Aegean Sea, which will make you linger. After the end, we will transfer back to the hotel by private car.

Santorini Island Tour

First stop: the blue-domed church where National Geographic magazine took the promotional photos for Santorini (the first check-in spot on the island). Standing on the cliff, you can take postcard photos with your mobile phone, with the volcanic island in the distance, the Mediterranean cruise ship in the crescent bay, and the azure Aegean Sea. The second stop: the magnificent Red Sand Beach . This is a huge red cliff formed naturally by a volcanic eruption. There are large areas of red bare rock. The rock is rich in iron, so it has a charming red color, which looks even more magical and dazzling under the sunlight.

The third stop: Perissa , the famous black sand beach on Santorini Island . Formed by the weathering of black sandstone left by volcanic eruptions, this beach offers visitors a glimpse into the charm of the Aegean Sea. The azure waters are crystal clear and icy. Enjoy a cup of Frappe, a Greek specialty coffee, at a beachside café for a truly relaxing experience. The fourth stop: the picturesque town of Pargos (the town with an area of one square kilometer has 49 private churches), which is quiet and classical, with the same blue sky, white clouds, blue roofs and white houses, which is very suitable for taking pictures.

Stop 5: Fira , Santorini's capital . Built on the edge of the 400-meter-high volcano on the west side of the island, this town offers breathtaking scenery. The whitewashed houses and deep blue roofs blend seamlessly with the sky and ocean, creating a picture perfect for a postcard. Here, you can overlook the Aegean Sea, gaze at the volcanic islands across the way, soak in the sea breeze, sunbathe, or stroll along the walking paths, snapping photos.
