Yellowstone National Park spans an area of 3,468 square miles (8,983 square kilometers), located primarily in the U.S. state of Wyoming, although it also extends into Montana and Idaho. Yellowstone National Park is one of the most stunning Wonderlands in the world. The majority of the world's geysers are preserved here. They are the main reason the park was established in 1872 as America's first national park – an idea that spread worldwide later. Around noon, we will arrive in the Yellowstone and will show you around before go to hotel in Idaho in night.

**Old Faithful Geyser** 

Old Faithful is a cone geyser in the Upper Geyser Basin of Yellowstone National Park. It is one of the park's most well-

known natural features and is famous for its predictability. It generally erupts every 91 minutes.

The Grand Prismatic Hot Spring

The Grand Prismatic Spring, with approximately 370 feet (110 m) in diameter and is 160 feet (50 m) deep, which

discharges an estimated 560 US gallons (2,100 L) of 160 °F (70 °C) water per minute. It is the largest hot spring in the

United States, and the third largest in the world. The vivid colors in the spring are the result of microbial mats around

the edges of the mineral-rich water. The mats produce colors ranging from green to red; the amount of color in the

microbial mats depends on the ratio of chlorophyll to carotenoids and on the temperature gradient in the runoff. In the

summer, the mats tend to be orange and red, whereas in the winter the mats are usually dark green. The center of the

pool is sterile due to extreme heat.

**Mud Volcano Area** 

The Mud Volcano blew itself apart in the early 20th century, but visitors can still see the impressive crater and other

geothermal features in the surrounding area, such as the Mud Cauldron, Black Dragon's Caldron, and Dragon's Mouth

Spring.

**Yellowstone Norris Geyser Basin** 

Norris Geyser Basin, named after an early Yellow-stone Superintendent, may be the hottest geyser basin in

Yellowstone. The stark, barren landscape of Porcelain Basin is the result of an acidic environment. Due to the hostile

condition plants, algae and bacteria have difficulty in establishing themselves. Instead the basin derives its colors from

mineral oxides, in spectrums of pink, red, orange (iron oxides) and yellow (sulfur and iron sulfates). The largest geyser

in the world is located here. Steamboat Geyser has long periods of dormancy, but when it does erupt it sends jets of

water nearly 380 feet high in a spectacular display.

area is known as the West Thumb caldera which was formed by a volcanic eruption that took place 174,000 years ago.

This bay is actually a smaller caldera within the larger Yellowstone caldera. The resulting caldera filled with water,

creating the bay.

**Grand Teton National Park** 

Grand Teton National Park is located in the Rocky Mountains, Northwest Wyoming. Grand Teton National Park is noted

for its stunning mountain vistas and its shimmering alpine lakes. It is also home to a variety of abundant wildlife.

**Elk Antler Arches Park** 

Elk Antler Arches Park has four arches and is made with thousands of elk antlers that make it so unique. It is such an

amazing place to discover filled with unforgettable memories.

In the west and southwest, Yellowstone is home to some 10,000 thermal features, over 500 hundred of which are geysers. Today we will visit Norris Geyser Basin. # **Yellowstone Mammoth Hot Springs**

Originally, there were several hot springs flowing from hillside, which was dyed by the microbes in the springs, thus performing a splendid step with multiple colors. However, due to a crustal change in 2002, most of the hot springs were no longer active. After the microbes died, they turned into grayish white powder, which remains on the dried steps, reflecting the dazzling sunlight. The barren land has changed with geographic movements, and the place used to be active could suddenly be quiet, and vice versa.

## **Artist Point**

Artist Point is one of the most spectacular scenic areas in the Canyon Area of the Park. The sheer walls drop 700 feet to the bottom of the canyon. Upriver the powerful Lower Falls are still in view. Downriver the canyon widens and deepens to a maximum of 1,540 feet. The canyon walls are predominantly yellow but colors of blue, red, orange and brown are also present. The colors are ever changing and especially intensified when the sunshine's after a rain.

# **Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone**

This impressive gap in the earth in the first large canyon on the Yellowstone River. It is 24 miles long, and can reach a quarter-mile in depth and 3/4 a mile in width. It is gorgeously colored.

## **Upper Yellowstone Falls**

Located a quarter-mile upstream of the larger Lower Falls, the Upper Yellowstone River Falls plunge 109 feet down an eroded lava cliff into the basin below. The area below the falls has been subject to heavier erosion than above.

## **Lower Yellowstone River Falls**

The Lower Falls of the Yellowstone River in Wyoming are the largest by volume in the Rocky Mountains of the western United States, and they stand more than 300 feet tall-- almost twice as high as Niagara Falls.

## **Olympic National Park**

Olympic National Park Olympic National Park is a United States national park located in the state of Washington, of the Olympic Peninsula. The park has four basic regions: the Pacific coastline, alpine areas, the west side temperate rainforest and the forests of the drier east side. U.S. President Theodore Roosevelt originally created Mount Olympus National Monument. The Olympic Peninsula has 73 miles of coastline, keeps the original view since ice age. With a low land of rainforest in its west, a magnificent Olympic Mountains in central, and few locations here can be visited by automobile makes it the paradise for hiking. Isolated from the mainland, many of its vegetation and animals can only be found here. The Olympic National Park locates in Olympic Peninsula is one of the most highly visited National Parks along the west coast.

# **Hurricane Ridge**

Located within Washington's Olympic National Park, this mountainous region is a popular destination for hiking, skiing and snowboarding. In the summer, several picnic areas open up, making this a great spot for a day-trip from nearby Seattle.

## **Poulsbo**

Poulsbo is located in the Liberty Bay of Kitapp County, more than 100 kilometers north of Seattle. It is said that many

residents of this town are Norwegian, so people call this town Washington's Little Norway. The whole town is characterized by Scandinavian style. This place has a history of more than 100 years, and you can see various stores with historical traces: gift shop, gallery, handicraft shop, antique shop, jewelry shop, etc. The most famous ones here are handmade European chocolate, bread, coffee, etc.

#### **Lake Crescent**

This deep lake in the heart of Olympic National Park holds water that is a brilliant hue of bright blue. It was formed during the last Ice Age by thousands of years of glacial activity.

# Temperate rain forest

Because of development, very few temperate rainforests outside of Olympic National Park exist along this stretch today. In Olympic, temperatures rarely drop below freezing or go above 80F, enabling an incredibly unique ecosystem to grow. Mosses, ferns, Douglas fir, red alders, Western hemlocks and Sitka spruce thrive in temperate rainforests, as do epiphytes, which are plants growing on other plants. Cat-tail moss and licorice ferns are two types of epiphytes you will find in Olympic.
