DAY 1 Hometown - Calgary

Fly from hometown to Calgary, crew members may visit [Chinatown] with already a hundred of year of history post pick up from the airport. Overlook the entire city and the Rockies afar on the breathtaking glass floors on top of [Calgary Tower], a landmark of the City of Calgary. Members arriving before 12pm may shop at the [CrossIron Mills Outlet Mall] (\$55/person including tax), one price for all ages. Or join in for a visit to Calgary's historical park [Heritage Park] (\$65/adult including tax, CAD\$55/child including tax)

DAY 2 Calgary - Banff & Lake Louise

- ▲ Lake Louise - Study the elegant legacy of the Edward VII era
- ▲ Banff Sulphur Mountain Gondola - Brings you straight to the peak of [Sulphur Mountain]
- ▲ Bow Fall - Where the well-known scene in "River of No Return" was filmed
- ▲ Hoodoos - Meaning "devils" in the Indigenous language and are regions where the "devils" appear
- ▲ Surprise Corner - A spectacular viewpoint of the town
- ▲ Sulphur Mountain - A marvellous place to take a panorama picture of the town of Banff or to simply enjoy the magnificent alpine
- ▲ Banff Town - Stroll around the little town to relax from the quick-paced cities, feel the peace and silence brought by nature

DAY 3 Banff - Icefield - Jasper

- ▲ Castle Mountain - as its name suggests, the mountains have unique castle-like character. These palatial cliffs leave unforgettable memories with its majestic appearance.
- ▲ Peyto Lake - The extraordinary beauty of the lake would lead one to question if the scene had been drawn out of a fine painting. The calm teal waters of the lake fended by the grand Rockies are like a goddess guarded by her steady nights.
- ▲ Crowfoot Glacier - Acquired such name from the crowfoot-like glacial markings on the side of the rock face formed by attrition of the glaciers above.
- ▲ Columbia Icefield - Glacial ice bounded by mountains appear to emit an icy blue glow on a sunny day due to the sunrays unable to penetrate through the dense ice.
- ▲ Skybridge - A challenge issued to your sense of heights with a clear glass bridge extending out to the side of the cliff. Walk out on the glass and imagine yourself floating on air thousands of meters above ground.
- ▲ Athabasca Falls - Known as the most heart-stopping water fall in the Rockies.

DAY 4 Jasper - Yoho

- ▲ Maligne Lake - The largest glacial lake in the national parks of Canada, and the largest within Canada, also the world's second largest glacial lake.
- ▲ Malign Canyon - Longest, deepest, and the most magnificent canyon around the Rockies. Distinctive karst topography is a result of the upstream Maligne Lake water dissolving carbonate bedrocks rocks.
- ▲ Crowfoot Glacier - Acquired such name from the crowfoot-like glacial markings on the side of the rock face formed by attrition of the glaciers above.
- ▲ Bow Lake - Glittering river water appears blue as it is a glacial lake. Stroll around and allow the refreshing air to calm your mind and body from the bustling cities.

DAY 5 Yoho - Calgary

- ▲ Moraine Lake - Famous for the stunning images it gives with its sapphire blue surface with a well balance of warmth in the water.
- ▲ Natural Bridge - Softer rocks are corroded away by the river faster than the firmer ones forming a bridge structure.
- ▲ Emerald Lake - Panoramic view of the peaks bordering the lake and the particular gem-like colour of the lake making it a popular attraction.
- ▲ Valley of the Ten Peaks - Peaks over 3000 meters tall mount on the center of the lake displaying its elegance.
- ▲ Johnston Canyon - Summer stream rushes over the edge of the cliff straight down to the heart of the Earth, while frozen water fall in the winter gives a thrilling vibe sending chills up the spine.
- ▲ Spiral Tunnel - Penetrate the heart of the mountains and is a creation of two years of constructions.
- ▲ Lake Louise Sightseeing Gondola - Enliven your body and soul in the aura of the Rockies and its lakes.

DAY 6 Calgary - Waterton

- ▲ Prince of Wales Hotel - Striking full wood architecture constructed during 1927. Appointed as a national historic site the year of 1995.
- ▲ Red Rock Canyon - Scenic place with vivid rock colours resulting from the iron mineral in the rocks oxidate as they are exposed to the atmosphere.
- ▲ Cameron Falls - A must-see attraction of a waterfall seems as if descending a set of staircases.
- ▲ Bison Paddock - Get an up-close look at the massive species that once roamed the Americas and were brought close to extinction by humans
- ▲ Waterton Lake National Park - The Canadian Waterton Lake National Park and the American Montana Glacier National Park is declared the world's first International Peace Park.

DAY 7 Calgary - Drumheller

- ▲ Drumheller - Currently discovered the fossils of 35 species of dinosaurs, winding back as far as 75 million years ago.
- ▲ Horseshoe Canyon - The canyon acquired its name from the horseshoe shape in the badlands. Stream flows from two deep valleys into Red Deer River.
- ▲ Rosedale Suspension Bridge - Marking the coal mining memoir during the early 20th century period.
- ▲ Royal Tyrrell Museum - One of the world's largest paleontology research center with numerous showpieces displayed within.
- ▲ The Little Church - A sacred place which has a capacity of 6 parishioners making it one of the smallest churches around the globe.
- ▲ The Hoodoos - Unique shaped stone pillars formed by weathering and water corrosion

DAY 8 Calgary - Airport

Free Time (Plan yourself). Take the hotel airport shuttle bus to the airport by yourself (free of charge, you need to make an appointment at the front desk of the hotel by yourself)

Hotel - Banff: Brewster's Mountain Lodge or similar / **Canmore:** super8 or similar
Lake Louise: Mountaineer Lodge or similar **Calgary:** Holiday inn or similar
Jasper: Mount Robson Inn or Marmot Lodge or similar / **Hinton:** Quality inn & suites
