Ibirapuera Park

Ibirapuera Park was inaugurated in 1954 to celebrate the 400th anniversary of São Paulo, and today is the most well-known park in town with over 14M visits per year. Ibirapuera Parks offers several cultural attractions and areas for fitness, bicycle path, thirteen courts and playgrounds. Due to its dimension, attractions and number of visitor, it is often comparable by foreigners to Ueno Park in Tokyo, Stanley Park in Vancouver, Hyde Park in London or Central Park in New York City.

Monument to the Bandeiras

Monument to the Bandeiras at Ibirapuera Park is one of the granite statues in the world and one of the most visited tourist landmarks in Sao Paulo. The monument depicts an expedition, led by two horsemen, followed by a group of

people of different ethnic backgrounds (Indians, Africans, Mestizos, and Portuguese), pulling a canoe that they used for traveling by river. The monument was presented to the city of Sao Paulo on its 399th anniversary.

Parque da Independência

Parque da Independência is more than a neighborhood park and is one of the important landmarks of the city. This vast stretch of greenery is home to various tourist attractions like Monument to the Independence of Brazil and Casa do Grito. Apart from that, there are well-maintained French gardens that make a lovely sight. Also, Parque da Independência is home to many different species of birds.

Monument to the Independence of Brazil

The Monument to the Independence of Brazil, also known as the Ipiranga Monument or the Altar of the Fatherland, is one of the best-known landmarks in São Paulo. Situated where Dom Pedro I declared Brazil's independence in 1822, this sculpture was jointly designed by Ettore Ximens and Manfredo Manfredo to celebrate the first centenary of Brazil.

Liberdade

Liberdade is São Paulo's large and colorful Asian (largely Japanese) district, with a great variety of restaurants and stores and a square that hosts folk festivals and a weekly open-air market. Rua Galvão Bueno is one of the main streets in Liberdade. Here, you'll find antique shops, booksellers, grocers, and an anime and manga mall. Rua Galvão Bueno features a pedestrian bridge over Viaduto do Glicério. This bridge is a great place to take photos of São Paulo. Join us to visit this street market!

Catedral Metropolitana de São Paulo

The Catedral Metropolitana de São Paulo, or Catedral da Sé, flanked by gigantic towers on either side. The majestic dome is inspired by the Cathedral of Florence's Renaissance minaret. The interiors boast intricate marble sculptures, stained glass panels and breathtaking architecture that's true to the Neo-Gothic school of design. The crypt houses tombs of archdiocese luminaries and the organ is one of the largest on the continent.

Avenida Paulista

Avenida Paulista is the most popular avenue of the city and concentrates all that is best in São Paulo. It is possible to visit museums and cultural centers, check book launchings and go shopping: all in one place! At the same time, Avenida Paulista allows contact with nature: the Trianon Park and Park Mario Covas. For those who prefer to immerse themselves in culture, it is worth visiting the Museum of Modern Art Assis Chateaubriand – MASP. Its permanent collection has several significant works of Western art of the Latin countries, not to mention the traveling exhibitions of various artists in the world.

Museu de Arte de São Paulo Assis Chateaubriand - MASP

Located in the heart of the city, Paulista Avenue, the MASP is one of the most important museums in the Southern Hemisphere and one of the main postcards of the city. It is on the list of the ten most visited tourist attractions of São Paulo, with a collection of about eight thousand pieces. Another point that attracts visitors is the architecture. In construction, it is unique in the world with the main body resting on four side pillars, forming a span of 74 meters long. The MASP was listed by Condephaat and in 2003 by IPHAN – Institute of Historic and Artistic Heritage.

The dam itself, built between 1975 and 1982, is 196 metres (643 feet) height and consists of large concrete segments joined to form a hollow chamber. Its reservoir stretches northward for about 160 km (100 miles), and it has totally submerged the formerly spectacular Guaíra Falls. Built as a joint venture by Paraguay and Brazil, the energy generated by Itaipu helps to meet the demands of the two countries.

Mount Corcovado

Mount Corcovado is 2,310 feet (704 metres) high and a part of the Carioca Range, overlooking Rio de Janeiro in southeastern Brazil. Mount Corcovado ("Hunchback") is named for its shape. On its narrow summit towers the imposing statue of Christ the Redeemer, 98 feet (30 metres) tall. The peak is accessible by road and by cog railway and

is one of Rio de Janeiro's most widely recognized landmarks.

Maracanã Stadium

Maracanã Stadium, officially called Estádio Jornalista Mário Filho, was built to serve as the flagship venue for the 1950 World Cup. It is among the largest football grounds in the world, though its capacity has been significantly reduced over the years as a result of multiple renovations. When it was built for the World Cup in 1950, it could hold somewhere

around 200,000 standing spectators.

Sambadrome Marquês de Sapucaí

The Sambadrome, designed by its mastermind, the world-renowned Brazilian architect Oscar Neimeyer, is a magnificent venue that was specially designed with the spectator in mind. The Sambadrome is a purpose-built stadium constructed specially to host the annual parade of Samba Schools each year during the festival of Carnaval in Rio de Janeiro. It is comprised of free-standing individual structures for spectator viewing, called sectors, which sit on both

sides of a long alleyway down which the Samba Schools parade.

Ipanema Beach

Ipanema is sandwiched between the equally fabulous Leblon and Copacabana beaches to the west and north respectively. It is one of the best known around the world. Trendsetting Ipanema, the place made famous by the '60s song to bear its name, has a long tradition of dictating beach chic to the rest of the world. The mere mention of the name Ipanema Beach conjures thoughts of a perfect tropical setting, that is filled with beautiful acres of powder-white

sand and the alluring ocean blue.

Museu Histórico do Exército e Forte de Copacabana

The Museu Histórico do Exército e Forte de Copacabana is a traditional and wonderful location to visit. It is filled with a lot of historically rich traditions and beauty! It has a fantastic view of the coast along with incredible beaches. It is definitely a location you won't want to miss out on.

This park is a landmark of Rio de Janeiro and is formed by Morro da Urca and the Sugar Loaf. You can discover new angles of the city up to 396 meters above sea level by the cable car. At the heart of the Atlantic Forest, follow us to delve deeper into details, stories, and curiosities, can enjoy and live the ecological, the historical and the backstage.

Monument to the Dead of World War II

The Monument to the Dead of World War II, also known as the Monument to the Brazilian Soldiers of World War II is a large commemorative monument that is dedicated to Brazil's participation and losses during World War II. It is located in the Flamengo Park, on Guanabara Bay, in the capital city of the State of Rio de Janeiro and within the Federative Republic of Brazil. The main feature is the abstract sculpture which represents an arch that stands 31 meters (102 feet) above. Topped by a concave rectangular table, it is at first glance, a mystic and very massive ancient torch.

Furthermore, the monument is also comprised of another metal abstract sculpture that is dedicated to the people who created the Brazilian Air Force.

Sao Bento Monastery

Take an in-depth look with us at the Sao Bento Monastery! It is a beautiful place to visit and filled with many great

beauties within. It has three archways at its entrance and contains over hundreds of years of Brazilian history.

Museum of Tomorrow

The design of the Museum is inspired by the Carioca culture and through its architecture, explores the relationship between the city and the natural environment. The Museum includes 5,000 square meters of temporary and permanent exhibition space, as well as a 7,600 square meter plaza that wraps around the structure and extends along the dock. The building features large overhangs 75 meters in length on the side facing the square and 45 meters in

length on the side facing the sea.

Rio Yup Star

Rio Yup Star was the first Ferris Wheel in Latin America. It is 88 meters high and offers the most breathtaking view of Rio de Janeiro. From the top you can have an incredible view of the Rio de Janeiro landscape and the famous tourist spots such as the Pão de Açúcar, the Christ the Redeemer, the Guanabara Bay, the Museum of Tomorrow and so much more!

Catedral Metropolitana de São Sebastião do Rio de Janeiro

The Catedral's appearance and history are very unusual and make it one of the most curious sights in the marvellous city! The Metropolitan Cathedral is 75 meters high and 64 meters high, with four stained glass windows are distributed along its diameter. The Cathedral also has an area of 8,000 m², with capacity for 20,000 people standing or 5,000 seated!

Escadaria Selarón

Escadaria Selarón is the world most beautiful staircase! It was built by Jorge Selaron, a Chilean ceramic artist. In 1990 he started to renovate the staircases in front of his house. In the beginning, he was adding blue, yellow or green colored ceramic tiles which are the colors of the Brazilian flag. The project began as a pass time, but little by little, Selaron got addicted to continue project. In the following 20 years, Saleron used more than 2,000 tiles from all over the world to turn the 250 steps in front of the house into a piece of art. The background of the steps on both sides is red, and various patterns are spelled out with other tiles of different colors. Take a walk down the Seleron Steps to see all the surprises that are waiting for you to discover.

Travel tips

TRAVEL TO BRAZIL

International tourists from any country in the world are authorized to enter Brazil.

REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER BRAZILIAN TERRITORY

Travelers arriving in international flights, whether Brazilian or foreign, must provide **proof of vaccination**, printed or in electronic form, in Portuguese, English, or Spanish, to the airline responsible for the flight prior to boarding.

Proof of vaccination does not apply to:

any traveler with a health condition that contraindicates vaccination, as long as it is attested by a medical report; any traveler ineligible for vaccination due to age restrictions, in accordance with criteria defined by the Ministry of Health;

any traveler coming into the country due to humanitarian issues;

travelers from countries with low vaccination coverage, as defined by the Ministry of Health;

Brazilians and foreigners residing in Brazilian territory who are not fully vaccinated;

Travelers with the above exceptions must provide the airline responsible for the flight with a negative RT-PCR test taken 24 hours prior to boarding, in Portuguese, English, or Spanish.

Connecting Flights and Stopovers: A new RT-PCR test must be provided if travelers are in transit in non-restricted areas for more than 24 hours.

Travelers who are not fully vaccinated are not allowed to enter the national territory (with exceptions).

VACCINATION

All vaccines must be approved by the Brazilian Health Regulatory Agency (ANVISA), by the World Health Organization (WHO), or by the authorities in the country of origin. The vaccines used in Brazil are the following: AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Janssen, and CoronaVac.
