The itinerary has thoughtfully arranged two major tourist

and shopping districts: Ximending Commercial District and Taipei 101 Shopping Mall, allowing you to have time for shopping while exploring Taipei. The rich itinerary takes you through the past and present of Taipei and allows you to experience the different customs of Taipei.

Commercial District (90 minutes) → Longshan Temple (30 minutes) → Chiang Kai-shek Memorial (watch the handover of guards, 40 minutes) → Taipei 101 Mall (50 minutes, you can go to the observation deck at your own expense)

All day

The Grand Hotel Taipei

This five-star hotel was built in the 1950s to entertain foreign guests and hold state banquets. The hotel has majestic red pillars and golden tiles, a magnificent classical atmosphere, and conveys the beauty of traditional art. It is one of the representative landmarks of Taipei City. Historically significant.

National Palace Museum

The National Palace Museum was completed in 1965 in Wai Shuanggai. It is a Chinese palace-style building with exhibition spaces on the first to third floors and the Sanxi Hall, a teahouse on the fourth floor. It houses the largest collection of Chinese art treasures in the world. The collection is mainly inherited from the Song, Yuan, Ming and Qing dynasties, covering almost the entire five thousand years of Chinese history. The number is nearly 700,000, making the National Palace Museum the "Chinese "Cultural Treasure House".

Dadaocheng

Dadaocheng was developed in the early days and was the most prosperous distribution center in northern Taiwan. In recent years, it has regained its vitality, attracting tourists to stroll through the old streets, enjoy coffee and food in traditional buildings, and experience the atmosphere of blending the old and the new.

Dihua Street

With Dihua Street as the center, there are traditional dry goods stores and Chinese medicine stores on both sides of the street. Because of the unique style of the old houses here, it has attracted many coffee shops and small art exhibitions. The collision of innovation and nostalgia creates dazzling sparks. It has also become a good place for domestic and foreign tourists to visit Taipei in recent years and seek to explore emerging cultural and creative industries.

Cheng-en Gate (Beimen)

It is a Qing Dynasty city gate located in Zhongzheng District, Taipei City, Taiwan. It is the main gate of Taipei City. It was completed in the 10th year of Guangxu in the Qing Dynasty (1884). It is the only one of the five city gates in Taipei City that has completely preserved its original appearance during the city construction period. It is a representative work of

Taiwan's new city gates and one of the few Qing Dynasty buildings left in Taipei City. There was originally an urn outside

the gate, but it no longer exists. It is now listed as a national monument of the Republic of China together with other

city gates in Taipei City.

Ximending Commercial District

The bustling Ximending business district is home to a wide variety of shops. Whether you are worshiping at the Five

Zang Temple or buying souvenirs, you can do it all at once here, so it attracts many international tourists. There will

also be street performers performing from time to time. If you happen to encounter one, you might as well stop and

enjoy the vibrant downtown area of Taipei.

Longshan Temple

Lungshan Temple is not only the oldest temple in Taipei City, but also a national historic site. Here you can learn about

Taiwan's traditional folk belief culture, and you can also experience throwing a fork to ask for fortune. Whether it is

health, career, love, etc., you can ask the gods for guidance.

Chiang Kai-shek Memorial

Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall was built to commemorate the first president of the Republic of China, Chiang Kai-shek.

The exterior of the building is mainly white walls, and the roof tiles are decorated with sapphire blue glazed tiles. The

park includes archways, museums, squares and gardens, and is grand and magnificent., leaving a deep impression on

visiting tourists. Appreciating the guard handover ceremony, the uniform movements and the solemn atmosphere, one

can't help but feel awe.

Taipei 101 Mall

Taipei 101 was once one of the tallest buildings in the world. With a height of approximately 508 meters, Taipei 101 is

also the most representative landmark in Taipei. It has a unique architectural style that travelers to Taipei must not

miss. If time permits, you can go to the observation deck on the 89th floor at your own expense to enjoy the

magnificent scenery of Taipei from high altitude and enjoy an all-round excellent view.

Day 3

Taipei - Vehicle - Sun Moon Lake

All day

After breakfast at the hotel in the morning, we set off and took a bus to the center of Taiwan—Sun Moon Lake National

Scenic Area. Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area has the largest freshwater lake in Taiwan. It is called Sun Moon Lake

because it is shaped like a moon arc in the south and a sun wheel in the north. In today's itinerary, you will be taken to visit the natural landscapes and cultural attractions of the Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area one by one. Wander among the green waters and green mountains, and experience the customs and customs of the indigenous people at Ita Thao Pier. Climb to the top of Ci'en Pagoda and get a bird's eye view of the distant scenery from the highest point of the entire Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area. Walking into Xuanzang Temple and Wen Mo Temple, you can experience how the large-scale buildings become more and more extraordinary against the backdrop of high mountains and clear water. I believe that today's trip to Sun Moon Lake can bring you an unforgettable and unique experience!

All day

Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area

Sun Moon Lake is the largest freshwater lake in Taiwan, bounded by Lalu Island, the water of the lake is divided into two, looking down from the sky, the east side is shaped like the sun, and the west side is shaped like a crescent moon, so it is named Sun Moon Lake. The surface of Sun Moon Lake is turquoise and clear, surrounded by mountains, picturesque scenery, since ancient times, it has been the hometown of the indigenous people of Taiwan, the Shao people, of which Lalu Island is a sacred place of the Shao people, mysterious and dreamy.

Ita Thao

Date Thao in the Thao language for "we are people" meaning, is the Thao people inhabited tribe, Date Thao old street in early 2007 was completed and opened, covers an area of about 328 ping, a collection of more than a number of Sun Moon Lake snacks and Sun Moon Lake souvenirs, souvenir shops, where you can eat millet mochi, millet wine, wild boar and other tribal delicacies, and the birth of Date Thao Old Street, is to restore the traditional Thao tribe water and land cultural life style.

Ci'en Pagoda

This tower was built in the first month of the 60th year of the Republic of China (1971 AD) by President Chiang

Zhongzheng in order to thank his mother for his greatness, hoping to show the people of the country, fulfill filial piety,
and always cherish mercy. Located at an altitude of 954 meters above sea level on Mount Sabahan, when the pagoda
was first built, all the building materials were transported by ship across the water surface of the Moon Lake and then
sent up the mountain in a flow cage, the project is quite arduous, the height of the tower is only 46 meters, and the top
of the tower is exactly 1,000 meters above sea level. After completion, the tower towers into the sky and becomes a
famous landmark building in Sun Moon Lake. From the top of the Ci'en Pagoda to Lalu Island, Lalu Island, Xuanzang
Temple and Ci'en Pagoda are about the same central axis, the terrain is like a dragon's head stretching into the pool to
draw water, Lalu Island is located at the entrance to the water, Xuanzang Temple is located at the dragon's head, and
Ci'en Pagoda is the heart of the dragon.

Xuanzang Temple

The temple was built in 1965, facing Lalu Island in front and Qinglong Mountain in the back. The geomantic feng shui says that the temple occupies the precious land of "Qinglong Xizhu". The temple is divided into two floors, enshrining Xuanzang's relics and Sakyamuni Buddha's golden body respectively. Xuanzang Temple is an imitation Tang-style building, and the square floor tiles exude a smooth and simple feeling. The plaque "National Treasure" in the temple was inscribed by President Chiang Kai-shek himself. On the large wall outside the temple, there are three pictures and inscriptions of Xuanzang's parade in the Western Regions; on the left is the Japan-China Friendship Memorial, with the biography of Master Xuanzang of the Tang Dynasty in the middle, and on the right is the Sino-Japanese Buddhist Friendship Exchange Monument. In addition, there are two stone statues in front of the door, and a big drum in front of the hall. Climbing up the stairs, you can see the wake-up bell for people to strike.

Wenwu Temple

This majestic Taoist temple is divided into three halls and is dedicated to Emperor Guansheng, the most sage teacher Confucius, Emperor Wenchang and other important gods. Through the professional explanation of the tour guide, you will have a deeper understanding of the history and culture of Sun Moon Lake.

Day 4

Sun Moon Lake - Vehicle - Tainan - Vehicle - Kaohsiung

All day

In the morning, after enjoying a hearty breakfast at the hotel, you will start the second day of your journey around the island. On this day, you will take a bus to Tainan, the oldest city in Taiwan. Tainan is famous for its rich historical buildings and profound cultural heritage. It is the earliest developed area in Taiwan. There is a proverb that goes like this: "One mansion, two deer and three monga". One of the mansions refers to the city of Taiwan, which is the current Anping district of Tainan. Today, Anping District in Tainan City is the most densely populated tourist and food paradise in Tainan. There are well-known historical monuments such as Anping Castle and Anping Old Street in the area, as well as the remains of foreign trade left by various countries during their trade a hundred years ago. Anping, which was quite international at the time, has left many beautiful stories, slowly flowing through history along with the canal, waiting for your visit.

Fort Zeelandia

Anping Castle is the first fortress in Taiwan's history and a well-known historic site in Tainan. The city was built in the

17th century and was originally called "Relanja City". It was built by the Dutch East India Company during its rule of

Taiwan. It experienced different regimes during the Ming, Zheng and Qing dynasties, and during the Japanese colonial

period. It was rebuilt and renamed Anping Castle. The main body of the building is made of red bricks with square steps,

and a Western-style lighthouse is built on the steps. It has become the appearance of Anping Castle familiar to most

tourists today. Take a trip to Anping Castle, listen to the tour guide's in-depth introduction to this unique monument,

and witness Taiwan's historical changes of more than 400 years.

Anping Old Street

This historic old street is located on the east side of Anping Castle. It was established by the Dutch more than 300 years

ago. It is the first officially developed commercial street in Taiwan, so it is known as the first street in Taiwan. The

streets were designed to be narrow in the early days, mainly because the roads were only for pedestrians and carts at

that time, but this also created the crowded and lively atmosphere of the old streets today. Occasionally, when you

look up, you can see a few wind lions on the old roofs on the street. They sit in this old street and alley that retains a

strong quaint style, as if time has been temporarily suspended. In addition to its long history, Anping Old Street is also

famous for its unique Tainan snacks, such as tofu pudding, shrimp rolls, fish skin dishes, beef soup, etc.

Fo Guang Shan Monastery

The most impressive thing about this solemn temple in Fo Guang Shan is the "Big Buddha City". The dignified and

majestic golden statue of the Buddha is 120 meters high. Facing the east of the rising sun, overlooking the Gaoping

River, it is the tallest standing Buddha in Southeast Asia. Surrounded by 480 smaller Buddha statues, it gives people a

solemn feeling of being protected by thousands of Buddhas. Travelers who have visited will be deeply impressed by this

solemn and majestic demeanor.

or

Fo Guang Shan Buddha Museum

It displays the largest Amitabha Buddha statue in Asia. In addition to displaying the real relics of Sakyamuni, the park

also has an art gallery, a theater auditorium, a pavilion and a souvenir shop. In addition, visitors can also experience tea

meditation, scripture copying, or participate in the festive activities of the Five Harmonies Pagoda.

Night

Hotel: 高雄漢來大飯店 Grand Hilai Kaohsiung; similar

All day

In the morning, after enjoying a hearty breakfast at the hotel, we immediately took the bus to Kenting, the south of the border. South Kenting is rich in natural resources, has a warm climate, pleasant scenery and convenient transportation. It attracts about four million tourists every year to experience nature and its resources are precious and abundant. Our itinerary today starts from Kenting National Park, which is surrounded by the sea on three sides. It is not only the only tropical area in Taiwan, but also one of the few national parks in China that covers both land and sea. We then visit the Eluanbi Lighthouse at the southernmost tip of Kenting, Taiwan, and then walk along the The Jia'e Highway on the east coast goes north, between Eluanbi and Fengchuisha, to Longpan Park. Take in the beautiful scenery of South Kenting and fully feel the infinite charm of nature.

Kenting National Park

Kenting National Park is located on the southern side of the Hengchun Peninsula at the southern tip of Taiwan. It is Taiwan's first national park. It is surrounded by the sea on three sides and is located in the only tropical area on the island of Taiwan. The area's unique geological structure and warm and pleasant tropical climate have given birth to a variety of amazing terrain landscapes and rich and diverse flora and fauna, making Kenting not only one of the first choices for domestic vacations, but also a popular destination for surfers and snorkeling enthusiasts A paradise for lovers.

Maopitou

This huge coral reef has been eroded repeatedly by waves over a long period of time, resulting in its unique appearance today. From a distance, it looks like a giant cat squatting on the ground, hence its name.

Chuanfan Rock

This is also a classic spot where many tourists stop to take photos when visiting Kenting. The Sail Rock is about 18 meters high. It was formed by old coral reefs rolling down from the nearby platform to the seaside. From a distance, it looks like a huge sail. Some people think it looks like a portrait of former US President Richard Nixon, especially Food for thought.

Eluanpi Lighthouse

Located at Eluanbi Cape in Pingtung County, it is the southernmost lighthouse on Taiwan's main island. It was originally built during the Qing Dynasty. After several damages, it was rebuilt and renovated during the Japanese occupation. At that time, it was listed as one of the eight scenic spots in Taiwan.

Longpan Park

This is a limestone platform eroded by rain. Limestone is easily eroded by water, so there are cliff collapses, seepage caves, limestone caves, red soil and other terrain landscapes in the area. A vast expanse of savannah allows visitors to enjoy the sea breeze and overlook the endless Pacific Ocean.

Night

Hotel: Hotel Royal Chihpin; similar

Day 6

Taitung - Vehicle - East Coast National Scenic Area - Vehicle - Hualien - Train - Jiaoxi

All day

After a good night's sleep and a delicious breakfast in the hotel, your Taiwan Island Tour will take you along the east coast. It is also known as the place with the most complete preservation of original natural beauty in Taiwan, with stunning scenery everywhere. Along the way you will stop at must-visit attractions on the eastern coast, including Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping and Fanshuliao. Each place has its own unique natural terrain features that are dazzling to see. Tonight, you will enjoy the famous Jiaoxi Hot Spring in Northern Taiwan at a luxury hot spring resort hotel in Yilan, experience a quiet and comfortable night, and prepare for your trip to Yilan's famous attractions the next day. Then take a train to Jiaoxi to experience Taiwan's smooth and fast subway services.

Xiaoyeliu

It is named because it resembles the unique and changeable natural sea erosion landscape of Yehliu Geopark on the north coast. Here, you can observe these unique landforms up close, such as monoclinal ridges, honeycomb rocks, turtle formation rocks, tofu rocks and mushroom rocks, etc., as if you are in a natural stone sculpture park.

Sanxiantai

Sanxiantai, which is nearly 400 meters long, is a cross-sea pedestrian bridge connected by eight arch bridges. One end is

connected to the main island of Taiwan, and the other end is connected to the offshore coral reef island. The island is dotted with strange rocks, and three of them have legends about three immortals standing there to rest, hence the name. The first sunrise every day in Taiwan also falls on Sanxiantai, so every New Year's Day, people from all over the world always gather here to welcome the first dawn of the new year.

Shitiping

This area is named after its multi-layered sea erosion terraces. It has experienced millions of years of seawater erosion and weathering, forming special geological landscapes such as single-sided mountains, sea erosion trenches, sea erosion cliffs and potholes, which are amazing. Incessantly.

Fanshuliao

Fanshuliao takes its name from Fanshuliao Creek. It is the most unique canyon landscape on the east coast. Due to the different geology on the east and west sides, the accumulation and cutting of the stream over the years has formed completely different landforms on both sides. On the west side is the valley basin; on the east side is the steep canyon. The unique stone-banked canyon terrain has the reputation of "Little Taroko".

Night

Hotel: Wellspring by Silks Jiaoxi, Yilan; Hotel Royal Jiaoxi, Yilan; similar

Day 7

Yilan - Vehicle - Taipei drop-off

National Center for Traditional Arts

Walking into it feels like walking into Taiwan a hundred years ago.
