D2 Arrive in Tokyo*NRT

Upon arrival at Tokyo Narita Airport, you can transfer to the hotel by free shuttle bus by own (around 15 min on the way). Guests can check-in hotel after 3pm.

Hotel: Narita Hilton or International Garden or similar

D3 Tokyo-Nikko

B, D

After breakfast, proceed to Nikko. Visit Lake Chuzenji, a representative alpine lake in Japan, with blue water and clear water quality. The majestic Kegon Falls is a perfect match with the surrounding beautiful natural scenery, which is a sight to behold. Afterwards, visit the World Heritage Site "Toshogu Shrine", which is regarded as "a masterpiece of human creativity by a gifted artist". Then visit Futarasan Shrine, the centre of belief in the gods of Mount Nikko, with its stately architecture and the simplicity of Shintoism without ostentation. Lunch is on your own arrangement.

Hotel: Kamenoi Okunikko or Kamenoi Nikko Yunishigawa or similar

D4 Nikko-Tokyo

B

After breakfast, proceed to Kawagoe Kita-in Temple. The most famous feature of it is the more than 5,000 Rohan statues. These statues were made by different artists during the Edo period and are one of the most famous sightseeing spots in Kawagoe. Kawagoe Ichiba Street is several hundred metres long and lined with warehouses. These old buildings bring you back to the old time. Then proceed to Ashikaga Flower Park, a popular tourist attraction in Japan and abroad. The park has eight major flower themes designed for the changing seasons, creating a fascinating world of flowers and a romantic atmosphere. Afterwards, we will go to Ginza, Tokyo's most famous commercial district. Lunch and dinner is on your own arrangement.

Hotel: Tokyo Dome Hotel or Shinjuku Granbell Hotel or similar

D5 Tokyo-Mt. Fuji

B, L, D

After breakfast, visit Senso-ji Temple, which is the oldest temple in Tokyo, and enjoy the vibrant stalls of Nakamise Dori. View the tallest standing tower in the world – Tokyo Skytree from afar. Then, visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge, which is outside of the Imperial Palace out gardens. Later, head for Shinjuku Kabukicho. Finally, transfer to Hot Spring Hotel near Mt. Fuji Area and enjoy Japanese-Style hot spring and dinner.

Special adding spots in Spring (Departure date 20th Mar-10th Apr): Chidorigafuchi Park, Shinjuku Gyoen
 Special adding spots in Autumn (Departure date 16th Oct-13th Nov): Yoyogi Park, Rikugien Garden

Hotel: Fuji Kawaguchiko Resort Hotel or Fujimihana Resort or similar

D6 Mt. Fuji-Nagoya

B, L

In the morning, visit Mt. Fuji 5th Station, located halfway up the mountain (If weather not permitting, go to Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center instead). Then, head to Oshino Hakkai. The traditional buildings, slowly spinning water wheels and amazing view of Mt. Fuji all transport you to another era. Then go to Bussharito Heiwa Park to appreciate the gardening featured with Japanese characteristics. Later, transfer to Nagoya and stroll on the famous Osu Shopping District. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Hotel: Hotel Keihan Nagoya or JAL City Nagoya Nishiki or similar



D7 Nagoya-Kyoto

B, L

After breakfast, visit the Nagoya Castle, which was the heart of one of the most important castle towns in Japan. Then transfer to Kyoto. Visit the Kiyomizu-dera Temple, a World Cultural Heritage site and the oldest temple in Kyoto, and stroll along the Sannenzaka & Ninenzaka Streets. Afterwards, head to Gion. It is a good place to experience the ancient charm and culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is almost always buzzing with energy, with eager devotees flocking to receive blessings and pray for good fortune. Walk on Hanamachi Street, the most stylish geisha district in Japan from the Edo period. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

 Special adding spots in Autumn (Departure date 16th Oct-13th Nov): Arashiyama Area-Togetsukyo Bridge

Hotel: Hilton Garden Inn Shijo Karasuma or Keihan Kyoto Hachijoguchi or similar

D8 Kyoto-Osaka

B, L

After breakfast, visit Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. The seemingly endless path of vibrant orange torii gates leading up Mt. Inari makes for an impressive setting and is one of the most famous images of Japan. Afterward, head to Nara to visit Nara Park where full of very playful and friendly deer. And don't miss the beautiful view in Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Visit the Osaka Castle Park (tower/museum excluded), the landmark of the Osaka city. This evening, visit Shinsaibashi, the largest shopping district in Osaka and taste the local cuisine at Dotonbori Food Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Hotel: Sheraton Miyako or New Hankyu or Bellevue Garden Kansai or similar

D9 Leave Osaka *KIX

B

After breakfast, transfer to Kansai International Airport by public transportation on own expense (guide will give advice in advance). End of the journey.
