D1 Home Town ✈ Lima, Peru

Depart from home city to Lima, Upon arrival, transfer/walk to the hotel.

Hotel: Hotel Costal del Sol Wyndham Lima Airport or similar

D2 Arrive Cusco – Moray & Maras – Sacred Valley

Arrive in Cusco today. Upon arrival, we will transfer to the Sacred Valley. En route, we will visit Moray & Maras. Moray is an archaeological site in Peru. It contains unusual Inca ruins, mostly consisting of several terraced circular depressions. Maras is a town near the city of Cusco in the Sacred Valley of southeastern Peru. It's known for the Maras Salt Mines.

D3 Sacred Valley – Machu Picchu – Cusco

This morning from Ollanta Train Station we take a train ride through the mountains to Aguas Calientes. This town is also known as "Machu Picchu Pueblo" and is the last stop before the entrance to the most important archaeological site in Peru, Machu Picchu. Our train journey is approximately two hours. Upon reaching Aguas Calientes station, we board a shuttle bus for a short trip up to Machu Picchu, the masterpiece of engineering and architecture that is believed to have been the sanctuary and retreat for the Inca Emperor Pachacutec. Machu Picchu, or "Old Mountain", is considered a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. We will have a guided tour of the site. Enjoy your own lunch in Aguas Calientes. In the afternoon, return by train to Ollanta and transfer to the hotel in Cusco.

D4 Cusco

This morning we set out for a guided tour of the ancient capital of the Inca Empire—Cusco. The tour visits important landmarks such as Cusco's Cathedral, Cusco main square, Convent of Santo Domingo. Continue to Qenko, an archaeological complex of mainly religious use where it is believed agricultural rituals were performed. In addition, Sacsayhuaman Fortress is an imposing example of Inca military architecture. Enjoy dinner and culture show at a local

D5 Cusco ✈ Lima, Peru

After breakfast, fly to Lima, Peru. This afternoon, start a city tour. We will visit the Main Square. From the square, we can see the Presidential Palace, the Archbishop's Palace and the Lima Cathedral. You will then visit the Aliaga House, a vice-regal construction dedicated by Spanish Conquistador. Next we will visit Miraflores & Barranco area to see the Statue of El Beso – The Kiss & The Bridge of Sighs. Later return to the hotel.

D6 Lima ✈ Buenos Aires, Argentina

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Later, transfer to the airport for the flight to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for check-in.

D7 Buenos Aires

Set out today to visit this famous city, also known as the "Paris of South America", where you will experience the beauty and magic of Buenos Aires. You will visit the popular attractions of the morning, including "9 Avenue de Julio", "Teatro Colon" and "Plaza de Mayo", the Metropolitan Cathedral, Palacio Barolo, "La Rosea Palace", and San Telmo Market. In addition, we will go to Boca (Bocca) to visit this Silk Road community. Boca was the site of immigrants from Italy to Argentina. The base of Stowe and Boca has been the home of many important artists. After the journey, we passed through the famous areas of Barre and Recoleta. Approaching evening, depart hotel to see the famous Tango show including dinner and beverage.

D8 Buenos Aires ✈ Iguassu Falls

Early morning transfer to the airport for the flight to Iguassu, Argentina. Upon arrival, you will directly visit the Iguazu Falls, which consists of 275 waterfalls. Walk along the mountain path along the river and walk through the entire scenic area, then enter the water trestle and be surrounded by the majestic waterfalls. Before you go, enjoy the stunning natural landscape. Then cross the border of Argentina and enter Brazil to the hotel. This evening, you will discover the traditional music and dances of Latin America and sample a variety of typical Brazilian and international dishes at a Dinner Show.

D9 Iguassu Falls (Brazil Side) ✈ Rio de Janeiro

Today we will enjoy the splendor and beauty of the Iguassu Falls. Marvel at unique views of the falls, walk the footpaths through lush tropical vegetation and take in the beauty of this natural wonder. After lunch we will all join the incredible activity called Macuco Safari which is divided into 3 stages: Jungle, Trail and Boat. It all starts with open-air vehicle drive thru the 2 km jungles and then aboard an exhilarating boat ride along the Iguassu River into the falls. After tour, transfer to airport for flight to Rio De Janeiro, Brazil. Upon arrival, proceed to hotel for check in. Dinner at the hotel. *Please bring good raincoat or poncho for boat ride or you will get drench.

D10 Rio de Janeiro

The highlights of today's tour is to see from the top of Sugar Loaf Mountain for impressive views and the trip up to the top of Corcovado Mountain by a cogwheel train for photos of the iconic Christ the Redeemer statue. For lunch today, we have arranged a Brazilian famous dish. After lunch, will visit the city's marvelous sights including the Lapa district & Escadaria Selaron.

Today will take a flight from Santiago to Punta Arenas, Chile. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel in Puerto Natales for check in. Dinner at the hotel.

D13 Puerto Natales - Balmaceda

After breakfast, departs hotel to the Bories pier to embark in Catamaran 2 de Mayo. This spectacular visit is a must when visiting Puerto Natales. We invite you to know the peculiar world of fiords. In the route you will be able to appreciate our native flora and fauna, visit the Balmaceda and Serrano Glaciers. We navigate from Bories pier to Balmaceda and Serrano glaciers, then the Ultima Esperanza fiord, passing by wonderful mountains, cascades, ranches and Patagonian fauna. We visit the Balmaceda glacier, walk to the Serrano Glacier viewpoint in the Bernardo O' Higgins national park. Lunch at The Perales Estancia (ranch) Return to Puerto Natales at approximately 18:00 hours.

D14 Puerto Natales - Torres Del Paine

Morning departs hotel towards the Milodon Cave, located 24 kilometers to the north of Puerto Natales. Before reaching the cave, the access road passes by the "Silla del Diablo" (Devil's chair) name that comes from the popular imagination since this is a rock formation which resembles a chair that, supposedly, was the seat of the Milodon who was transformed into a devil. Next, it is possible to admire the breathtaking landscape that surrounds us from the Lago Grey viewpoint (overlooking the Grey Glacier, the Paine range and the Toro lake). A couple of kilometers ahead, we can see the Horns of the Paine, reaching a point that takes us to the Lago Grey zone. In this sector, we can make a pleasant walk by the shore of the Grey Lake and, if the weather helps, we will reach the Peninsula Grey viewpoint. After the meal and rest, we start the second stage of our visit to the Paine National Park, heading down to the Salto Grande Sector. There we will visit the Nordenskjold lake viewpoint and will continue to enjoy outstanding views in our way route until we reach Laguna Amarga area. After admiring these pleasant views, we return to Puerto Natales passing by the Sarmiento lake viewpoint.

D15 Puerto Natales - El Calafate, Argentina

Breakfast at the hotel. Private transfer between Puerto Natales and El Calafate hotel (5 hours approximately). Customs and migrations in the border with Argentina on the way to El Calafate. Reaching El Calafate in approximately 2:00pm. After check in hotel, free time to explore this small city with a lot of shops & restaurants.

D16 El Calafate

Full day visit to Perito Moreno Glacier which located in Los Glaciares National Park. The park has been declared as World Heritage by UNESCO. Those glaciers that named it (about 47) show us a 10-thousand-year-old world: cold and wild. The most famous one is Perito Moreno Glacier in the southwestern end of Argentino Lake at 80 km away from El Calafate. This glacier is so-called due to a great Argentinian explorer from last century and is one of the few glaciers that is still moving in the world. That is why it has become one of the most spectacular natural shows in South America. From time to time its 60-m-high snout releases some ice walls as huge as buildings that fall into Rico Bend or Canal de los Témpanos (Ice floes Channel) and then they continue sailing along the channel to the main area of the lake. After lunch, all will join a one hour boat ride to see North face of Perito Moreno glacier which is inside the most beautiful face. This is experience will take you up close to one of the world's most magnificent displays of nature.
