Zion National Park

Utah's First National Park. Follow the paths where ancient native people and pioneers walked. Gaze up at massive sandstone cliffs of cream, pink, and red that soar into the brilliant blue sky. Experience wilderness in a narrow slot canyon. Zion's unique array of plants and animals will enchant you as you absorb the rich history of the past and enjoy the excitement of present-day adventures.

Canyon Overlook Trail

In 1930 the Civilian Conservation Corps built the Canyon Scenic Trail to provide access to the viewpoint above the Gateway Arch, completing the loop from Zion to Bryce Canyon and the Grand Canyon. In 1937, the tunnel was replaced with concrete for timber supports. Pine Creek Canyon is surrounded by Zion cliffs and sandstone towers. Scenic Trail is located on the east side of Zion. This trail starts from sandstone steps with metal handrails and leads visitors over the rocky terrain above the dark slot canyon. The end of the trail opens up to a vast expanse of smooth red and cream rock, with views of Our Lady of the Tower from the edge of the fenced cliff facing Zion's main canyon. Visitors can get a bird's-eye view of historic Mount Zion, the Carmel Highway and the tunnels.

Bryce Canyon National Park

Afternoon

Canyonlands National Park

Canyonlands National Park is located at the easternmost end of Utah. It has striking red hills and exquisite natural arches. It preserves a large area of colorful land landscape, which has been eroded by the Colorado River and its tributaries into countless canyons, terraces, and isolated peaks. The park is divided into three distinctive areas - Island in the Sky, Needle Mountain, and Labyrinth. These areas share a primitive desert atmosphere, and each area has its own characteristics. You can also enjoy the magnificent view of the turbulent Colorado River and its tributaries.

Dead Horse Point State Park

32 miles from Moab, Dead Horse Point State Park is one of Utah's most spectacular state parks. The view from Dead Horse Point is one of the most photographed scenic vistas in the world. Towering 2,000 feet above the Colorado River,

the overlook provides a breathtaking panorama of Canyonlands' sculpted pinnacles and buttes. Millions of years of geologic activity created the spectacular views from Dead Horse Point State Park. Deposition of sediments by ancient oceans, freshwater lakes, streams and wind blown sand dunes created the rock layers of canyon country. Igneous activity formed the high mountains that rise like cool blue islands from the desert below.

Arches National Park

Arches National Park lies north of Moab in the state of Utah. Bordered by the Colorado River in the southeast, it's known as the site of more than 2,000 natural sandstone arches, such as the massive, red-hued Delicate Arch in the east. A long, thin Landscape Arch stands in Devils Garden to the north. Other geological formations include Balanced Rock, towering over the desert landscape in the middle of the park.

Afternoon Mesa Verde National Park It is a North American Indian cultural heritage reservation, located in the desert and canyon-filled rocky area in southwestern Colorado, USA.The park's natural resources include cliffs, canyons, deserts and other landforms, as well as rich vegetation and biological resources. There are more than 4,400 house sites in the park, including spectacular cliff villages such as the Cliff Palace. The scenic area is divided into six sub-areas: Gorge River Landscape Display Area, Jialing River Story Area, Slope Valley Water Forest Area, Waterfront Activity Experience Area, Industrial Memory Garden Area, and Riverside Cultural Area. The main attractions include the Cliff Palace, Spruce Tree House, etc., which show the architectural skills of ancient Indians.In 1978, Mesa Verde National Park was listed on the World Heritage List by UNESCO.

Four Corners Monument

It is the junction point of four states: Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and Utah. This is the only intersection point between four states in the United States. When it was first built in 1912, it was just a simple cement slab. It was completely rebuilt in 1992 and again in 2010. The center of the junction is surrounded by a metal landmark made of flower steel, and is surrounded by a cement floor about 6 meters square. A diagonal line is drawn along the state line, and the state emblem is embedded in each perimeter, which is very distinctive. feature.

Goosenecks State Park

Goosenecks State Park is located in Utah, USA. It was established in 1962 and covers an area of 10 acres. It is the best place to watch the deep meanders of the San Juan River. About a million years ago, the upturned ground forced the river to cut 1,000 feet deep, forming a unique crazy turn in the world, attracting tourists from all over the world. Goosenecks State Park is still in its original state and has not been developed by humans. The most worth admiring is the world-famous Goosenecks. The Goosenecks Canyon is 1,000 feet deep and has a total of three bays. These winding bays are indeed like the neck of a goose, so it is named Goosenecks. Visitors can look down from the upper part of the Goosenecks and see the fierce momentum of the San Juan River winding through the desert 1,000 meters below. This rare geological landscape is incredible.

Monument Valley

Monument Valley is a region of the Colorado Plateau characterized by a cluster of vast sandstone buttes, the largest reaching 1,000 ft above the valley floor. It is located on the Arizona–Utah state line, near the Four Corners area. Monument Valley has been featured in many forms of media since the 1930s. Director John Ford used the location for a number of his best-known films and thus, in the words of critic Keith Phipps, "its five square miles [13 square kilometers] have defined what decades of moviegoers think of when they imagine the American West."

Afternoon

Upper Antelope Canyon

The Antelope Canyon is a classic slit canyon, which is divided into upper and lower parts. From the end of March to the beginning of October of each year, there is a light column directly reflecting the valley bottom in the Upper Antelope Canyon. The mottled red sandstone in the canyon emits bright colors, attracting countless photography enthusiasts.

Horseshoe Bend

Horseshoe Bend has been featured as a landmark for Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, Grand Canyon National Park, the Cities of Page AZ, Kanab UT, St George UT, and the Navajo Nation. Boundary lines are very close in some places. About nine miles downstream is where Grand Canyon National Park truly begins. A social media darling, Horseshoe Bend has become one of the most recognized and visited places in the Glen Canyon National Recreation Area.

This dam uses the natural conditions of the Glen Canyon to build dams on both sides of the canyon to intercept the Colorado River for hydropower generation and water regulation. It is one of the most spectacular dams in the world, and one of the most magnificent and complex buildings created by humans, which is breathtaking.
