D1 Eriday	Australian Open. Kind smiles and a strong sense of humanity can be seen everywhere in this city. For guests arriving at Melbourne Airport (MEL) before 10:00 AM, a Penguin Island Day Tour will be offered (flight delays or missing the tour will be considered as a forfeiture of the offer). D2 Saturday	Melbourne-Great Ocean Road- MelbourneMelbourne -Great Ocean Road-Melbourne[Great Ocean Road] has become one of the few world-famous tourist attractions in Australia.

	The total length is 276 kilometers, and there are many wonderful sights along the way. The magnificent waves and straight cliffs along the coast are God's miraculous workmanship! Driving on the Great Ocean Road, there is a breathtaking scenery in less than a kilometer along the way. None of the rock pillars towering over the sea are the same. The setting sun is shining slantingly and the birds are flying, which is a beautiful scenery that many people may never see in their lifetime. The route from Melbourne to Allansford passes through many large cities and towns, including Geelong, Torquay, Apollo Bay and Port Campbell, etc. Famous attractions include the Twelve Apostles. The Twelve Apostles are 12 rock cliffs formed by millions of years of weathering and seawater erosion along the coastline of Port Campbell National Park. The independent reefs standing in the blue ocean have different shapes, like human faces, and are called the "Twelve Apostles". [Lock Ard Grand Canyon] The Lock Ard Grand Canyon is only about 2 kilometers away from the 12 Apostles. Here you can watch the rocky landscape of the canyon up close, and you can go down the canyon ladder to the seaside and take a stroll to enjoy the scenery.

The famous [Captain Cook's Cottage] is located in Fitzroy Park. Captain Cook is the discoverer of Australia and is revered as the founding father of Australia. The cabin where Captain Cook once lived was moved here from the UK to commemorate it. [St Paul's Cathedral] Diagonally opposite Flinders Street Station, it is a typical Gothic building. It is the cathedral of the Melbourne Diocese of the Anglican Church of Australia. Its colorful glass windows are embedded in the tawny limestone walls, which is exquisite and shocking. If you have time, continue to visit the [Royal Exhibition Hall] Melbourne's most typical architectural style - Victorian, the representative work: the Royal Exhibition Hall at 9 Nicholson Street. The first annual meeting of the Commonwealth of Australia was held here in 1901. Transfer to the airport in the afternoon and fly to Sydney. #### Australia travel information:

#### [customs]

1. The luggage of passengers entering Australia must undergo customs inspection. Customs prohibits passengers from bringing in food, such as meat (including beef jerky, pork jerky), seeds, vegetables, fruits, seafood, supplements, dangerous goods (including any gunpowder, flammable goods, any weapons or similar items), etc. Note: Australian customs are very strict. All food that can be eaten must be declared upon entry. Whether it can be brought into the country is determined by the local customs. Failure to declare may result in a fine ranging from AUD\$200-10,000 or refusal of entry.

2. If you bring milk powder for infants into the country, it must be unopened before entering the country.

3. Passengers over the age of 18 can bring 2,250 ml of alcohol and 50 cigarettes or 50 grams (1.76 ounces) of cigars or tobacco products into the country duty-free. Those over the age of 18 can also bring items worth AUD\$900 as gifts, while those under the age of 18 are limited to AUD\$450.

4. All sharp objects must be placed in checked baggage, including any type of scissors, metal nail files, tweezers, etc. If any of the above items are found in the carry-on luggage by customs officers, they will be confiscated and will not be returned. Our company will not be held responsible.

5. Each passenger is allowed to carry one lighter with him or her in hand luggage. Lighters and matches are strictly prohibited in checked luggage.

## [Loan currency]

1. Only Australian dollars are popular in the Australian market, and US dollars can also be exchanged (Hong Kong dollars are more difficult to change locally). If the amount of Australian dollars and foreign currencies inbound and outbound exceeds Australian dollars \$10,000 (or equivalent foreign currency), you need to declare it when entering. Credit cards are accepted in most places. Can be used universally.

#### [Voltage]

1. The voltage in Australia is 220-240V, and the socket plug has three flat pins (commonly known as eight-pin pins).

2. Please bring an adapter plug.

## [climate]

1. Australia is located in the Southern Hemisphere, and its seasons are opposite to those in the Northern Hemisphere. Summer lasts from December to February and winter lasts from June to August.

2. January to March is the rainy season, so you can bring rain gear.

3. Due to the large temperature difference between morning and evening, the weather is relatively dry, so please bring sunscreen and skin care products.

## [Personal items]

1. Passengers must bring personal items, such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, slippers, etc. Some hotels are equipped with hair dryers, electric hot water bottles, irons, and ironing shirts for convenience.

2. If you need to take designated medicines for a long time, you should prepare sufficient amounts before departure to maintain your health. However, a doctor's prescription is required to bring it into the country. If guests feel unwell locally, the tour guide can help them go to local hospitals for medical treatment.

3. Mobile phones can also be used if they have roaming.

## [Kind tips]

1. There are many birds on the streets of Australia. Do not feed human food randomly to protect the ecology.

2. Cameras and other recording tools are indispensable during the journey. In addition to recording your own journey, you may occasionally take photos of passers-by. Please note that Australia is a place that attaches great importance to privacy. If you are reminded, please delete the photos immediately. If you want to take photos with your baby, For photos with children, please ask the parents next to you first.

All hotel rooms in Australia are non-smoking rooms (No-smoking Room) and smoking is strictly prohibited; Smoking is strictly prohibited in all vehicles and public transportation waiting areas, indoor public places, outdoor dining areas, children's entertainment areas, etc. in South Australia, otherwise there will be all consequences ( (including fines, etc.) are all borne by the guest.
