It is located on the shores of the beautiful Lake Pukaki. In the eyesof many climbers, this is the best climbing area in Australasia. Even less experienced adventurers willfind plenty to enjoy on alpine walks, including beautiful alpine lakes, vast meadows and spectacularglacier views. If you are lucky, you may encounter the funny Kea (Mountain Parrot).The huge Tasman Glacier is 27 kilometers long, and the majestic scenery is stunning. It runs slowlyalong both sides of the valley, and guests can take small ski planes and helicopters to land here at theirown expense. The dreamy milky white lakes are a major feature of Mount Cook National Park; orchoose to hike, the scenic Hooker Valley Track takes you into the foothills of the Southern Alps andenjoys beautiful views of mountains, glaciers and rivers.Later, at the Cook Alpine Salmon Farm at an altitude of 1969, you can taste top-quality salmoncultivated in glacier water. 10.Expenses to be paid by our company are not agreed upon in the contract and travel itinerary, and losses and expenses incurred during the itinerary due to force majeure (epidemic, traffic delays, strikes, natural disasters, etc.).

participation :

1. Please inquire at the hotel front desk for breakfast charges for children under 4 years old and not occupying a bed.

2. The entire tour will be conducted in Chinese, and no English translation will be provided. Fees for non-Asians will be negotiated separately ;

3. Guests are required to stay with the group for the entire journey. If they withdraw on the day of departure or in the middle of the tour, they will be deemed to have given up automatically for any reason, and all fees will not be refunded .

4. The tour price does not include additional costs arising from unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances. Including personal needs, flight delays/cancellations, war/potential threats of war, riots, civil unrest, terrorist activities/threats of actual terrorist activities, natural disasters, severe environmental weather, etc.;

Once the reservation is confirmed, if the reservation is canceled or changed by the guest, the fees incurred will be in accordance with the travel-related terms; if the trip cannot be made due to national policies, regulations and other factors, the paid group fee will be refunded after deducting the handling fee.;

Cancellation policy:

- A deposit of US \$ 5 00 is required when registering, and the remaining balance must be paid 3 weeks before departure.

- > If canceled or changed within 7-14 working days before departure, the full tour fee will not be refunded.

Booking instructions, recommended flights:

- Outbound: Any flight arriving in Christchurch in the afternoon of the first day, hotel check-in time is after 2 pm; Return: Any flight departing from Christchurch at any time on the last day, hotel check-out time is 10 am.
- Guests who miss the airport pick-up for any reason will have to solve their own transportation problems to the next stop, and all costs incurred and derived therefrom will be borne by themselves.
- All projects in the itinerary will be determined based on actual conditions (such as epidemic, weather, traffic, etc. force majeure). The company reserves the right to make adjustments to the itinerary based on actual conditions, and guests are not allowed to request compensation for this.
