After breakfast, visit the Imperial Palace of the Joseon Dynasty - Gyeongbokgung Palace, National Museum of Folklore. Then, go to Bukchon Hanok Village. It is a well-preserved 600-year-old Korean traditional residential area in Seoul. The village is best known for its eight views of Bukchon. Afterwards, visit National Museum of Korea here houses a vast collection of over 420,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era in a wide range of topics, including art and culture. Transfer to the Lotte World Mall(Tower excluded), one of the top shopping attractions in Seoul. Watch the amazing The Painters Show. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Freedom Bridge is a former railroad bridge which was used by repatriated POWs/soldiers returning from the north. A stop not to be missed is the 3rd Tunnel. Its purpose was to be used to invade the south. As one of the most vibrant traditional markets in Seoul, Gwangjang Market is home to a number of clothing and food stalls, offering tourists a taste of traditional Korean cuisine. Enjoy yourself in the famous shopping center Myeongdong. Dinner is on your own arrangement.
