<p>D2 Saturday</p>	<p>Melbourne-Great Ocean Road-Melbourne</p> <p>[Great Ocean Road] has become one of the few world-famous tourist attractions in Australia. With a total length of 276 kilometers, there are many wonderful sights along the way, and there is no other road in the world that can compare with it. Driving a Mercedes on the Great Ocean Road can be said to be a great combination of amazing journeys one after another. There are stunning views in less than one kilometer along the way, and none of the rock pillars towering over the sea are the same. The setting sun is shining slantingly and the birds are flying, which is a beautiful scenery that many people may never see in their lifetime. The majestic waves and straight cliffs along the Great Ocean Road are God's miraculous workmanship!</p> <p>The journey from Melbourne to Allansford passes through many large cities and towns, including Geelong, Torquay, Apollo Bay and Port Campbell.</p> <p>Famous attractions include the Twelve Apostles. The Twelve Apostles are located on the coastline in Port Campbell National Park. They are 12 rock cliffs formed by millions of years of weathering and sea erosion. The independent reefs standing in the azure blue ocean have different shapes, like human faces, and are called the "Twelve Apostles".</p> <p>[Lock Ard Grand Canyon] The Lock Ard Grand Canyon is only about 2 kilometers away from the 12 Apostles. It's a great place for a stroll.</p> <p>[Fitzroy Park] is one of the five major parks in Melbourne. It is a very beautiful park with ancient trees and green grass.</p> <p>The famous [Captain Cook's Cottage] is located in Fitzroy Park. Captain Cook is the discoverer of Australia and is revered as the founding father of Australia. The cabin where Captain Cook once lived was moved here from the UK to commemorate it.</p> <p>[St Paul's Cathedral] Diagonally opposite Flinders Street Station, it is also a typical Gothic building. It is the cathedral of the Melbourne Diocese of the Anglican Church of Australia and an important landmark in Melbourne. The colorful glass windows are embedded in the tawny limestone walls, which are exquisite and shocking.</p> <p>If you have time, continue to visit the [Royal Exhibition Hall] Melbourne's most typical architectural style - Victorian, the representative work: the Royal Exhibition Hall at 9 Nicholson Street. The first annual meeting of the Commonwealth of Australia was held here in 1901. Walking in the Rocks District, you can feel the charm of the intersection of the past and the present.</p> <p>[Darling Harbor] Darling Harbor, also known as Darling Harbor, is a comprehensive and diversified area integrating leisure, entertainment, shopping and food. It has beautiful seaside scenery and is surrounded by many famous attractions, such as: Sydney Aquarium, Thorpe Aquatic Center, Imax Cinema, Madame Tussauds Sydney, etc. It is one of Sydney's main leisure walking areas. Not only is it suitable for viewing during the day, but when the night falls, it is filled with a romantic atmosphere.</p> <p>[Bondi Beach], [Queen Victoria Building], [Sydney Hyde Park]</p> <p>[St Mary's Cathedral] is the largest Catholic church in Australia and the oldest religious building.</p> <p>The appearance of the Sydney Opera House [Sydney Opera House] is located in the convenient Long Point of Sydney. The building is shaped like a sailboat. It is a landmark building in Sydney and one of the most distinctive buildings in the 20th century. The Opera House was built in 1973. , listed as a World Cultural Heritage in 2007, is a world-famous performing arts center.</p> <p>Continue to visit the [Sydney Fish Market]. Take an off-road four-wheel drive vehicle to travel on the beach and enjoy the breathtaking beauty of the surrounding nature. The long coastline is surrounded by the blue sea on one side and the golden desert on the other. It is a wonder. After arriving at the sandboarding location, you can go sandboarding at your own expense and start an unforgettable sandboarding trip. Take your skateboard and slide down the sand dunes with a slope of 70 degrees and a height of 30 meters. It is exciting and enjoyable.</p> <p>At noon, we arrived at [Nelson Bay], a resting place for bottlenose dolphins. From the pier, [take a cruise] and embark on a relaxing and enjoyable dolphin chasing journey. When the cruise ship sails in the bay area, wild dolphins will swim with the ship. There will also be naughty dolphins jumping out of the water to greet you. You can lean on the railing of the ship and play with their bold and enthusiastic animals. . 2. Please consult the hotel front desk for breakfast fees for children under 4 years old who do not occupy a bed;

3. The tour guide will be Chinese-speaking throughout the tour, and no English translation will be provided. Fees for other international travelers will be negotiated separately;
4. If you withdraw on the day of departure or in the middle of the trip, you will be deemed to have given up automatically for any reason, and all fees will not be refunded; once the reservation is confirmed, any cancellation or adjustment will be in accordance with the relevant travel terms and conditions;
5. The tour fee does not include additional costs arising from unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances. Australia travel information:

【Customs】

1. Baggage of passengers entering Australia must undergo customs inspection. Customs prohibits passengers from bringing in food, such as meat (including beef jerky, pork jerky), seeds, vegetables, fruits, seafood, supplements, and dangerous goods (including any gunpowder, flammable goods, any weapons or similar items) etc. Note: Australian customs are very strict. All food that can be eaten must be declared upon entry. Whether it can be brought into the country is determined by the local customs. Failure to declare may result in a fine ranging from AUD\$200-10,000 or refusal of entry.
2. If you bring milk powder for infants into the country, it must be unopened before entering the country.
3. Passengers over the age of 18 can bring 2,250 ml of alcohol and 50 cigarettes or 50 grams (1.76 ounces) of cigars or tobacco products into the country duty-free. Those over the age of 18 can also bring items worth AUD\$900 as gifts, while those under the age of 18 are limited to AUD\$450.
4. All sharp objects must be placed in checked luggage, including any type of scissors, metal nail files, tweezers, etc. If any of the above items are found in the carry-on luggage by customs officers, they will be confiscated and will not be returned. Our company will not be held responsible.
5. Each passenger is allowed to carry a lighter with him or her in hand luggage. Lighters and matches are strictly prohibited from being placed in checked luggage.

【Loan currency】

Only Australian dollars are popular in the Australian market, and US dollars can also be exchanged (Hong Kong dollars are more difficult to change locally). If the amount of Australian dollars and foreign currencies inbound and outbound exceeds Australian dollars \$10,000 (or equivalent foreign currency), you need to declare it when entering. Credit cards are available in most places. Can be used universally.

【Voltage】

The voltage in Australia is 220-240V, and the socket plug has three flat pins (commonly known as eight-pin pins).

Please bring an adapter plug.

【Climate】

Australia is located in the Southern Hemisphere, and its seasons are opposite to those in the Northern Hemisphere. Summer lasts from December to February and winter lasts from June to August.

The rainy season is from January to March, so you can bring rain gear.

Due to the large temperature difference between morning and evening, the weather is relatively dry, so please bring sunscreen and skin care products.

【Personal items】

1. Passengers must bring personal items, such as toothpaste, toothbrush, slippers and other items. Some hotels are equipped with hair dryers, electric hot water bottles, irons and shirts for convenience.
2. If you need to take designated medicines for a long time, you should prepare sufficient amounts before departure to maintain your health. However, a doctor's prescription is required to bring it into the country. If guests feel unwell locally, the tour guide can help them go to local hospitals for medical treatment.
3. Mobile phones can also be used if they have roaming.

【Warm reminder】

1. There are many birds on the streets in Australia. Do not feed human food randomly to protect the ecology.
2. Cameras and other recording tools are indispensable during the journey. In addition to recording your own journey, you may occasionally photograph passers-by. Please note that

Australia is a place that attaches great importance to privacy. If you are reminded, please delete the photos immediately. If you want to When taking photos with babies or children, please ask the parents next to you first.

All hotel rooms in Australia are non-smoking rooms and smoking is strictly prohibited; Smoking is strictly prohibited in all vehicles and public transportation waiting areas, indoor public places, outdoor dining areas, children's entertainment areas, etc. in South Australia, otherwise there will be consequences. (Including fines, etc.) are all borne by the guest.
