Rise and shine! Today we will visit the world-famous Giza Necropolis! The Giza Pyramids are among Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the most famous of which is the Great Pyramid of Giza. Then we will have a look at the great sculpture Great Sphinx of Giza next to the Pyramids to explore the "Mystery of the Sphinx". Following, we will head to visit the Valley Temple of Khafre. In the afternoon, we'll drive to Memphis and visit the semi-open-air museum, where you can explore the ancient ruins freely. Finally, we will go to visit the oldest pyramid in Egypt known as Pyramid of Djoser.

Itinerary:

Cairo → Giza Necropolis (60 mins, **ticket included, a separate ticket is required for entrance to the Great Pyramid of Giza**) → **The Great Sphinx of Giza** (30 mins) → **Valley Temple of Khafre** (30 mins) → **Memphis** (60 mins, **Memphis semi-open air museum ticket included**) → **Pyramid of Djoser** (60 mins)

Giza Necropolis

The Giza Necropolis are among the most popular touristic destinations in the world. Each of these spectacular structures served as the final resting place of a king of the 4th Dynasty (c.2613–2494 BC). The Great Pyramid of Giza was built for King Khufu (c.2589–2566 BC), and the other two for Khafre and Menkaure, his son and grandson. Khufu's pyramid is both the oldest and largest of the three, and the first building to exceed it in height would not be built for another 3,800 years!

The Great Sphinx of Giza

The Great Sphinx of Giza is an enormous stone sculpture of a mythical creature with the head of a man on the body of a lion. The enigmatic Sphinx measures 66 feet (20 m) in height, and 240 feet (73 m) in length from paw to tail, and represents a mystical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a human man. The Great Sphinx of Giza is one of the greatest mysteries of Ancient Egypt, as it is still unknown exactly when it was built, by whom, and for what reason...

It is one of Egypt's oldest and most emblematic monuments and provides fascinating insight into the culture, history and architectural achievements of the ancient civilisation.

Valley Temple of Khafre

The Valley Temple of Khafre is located next to the statue of the Sphinx and extends towards east-west, and it has two entrances, one on the north side and the other in the south. Within the eastern and western walls there are cavities. It is believed that the cavities of the eastern wall were designated for sunrise rites, while the cavities of the western wall were dedicated to sunset rites.

Memphis

Memphis is an ancient Egyptian city, one of the World Heritage Sites and was founded in 3200 BC by King Narmer. It was the capital of Egypt in the era of the Old Kingdom (dynasties 3-6). Most of the pyramids found near Cairo, numbering well over 100 in total, were built during this period when Memphis was the most important city in Egypt and most probably the world.

The Museum of Memphis

The Open-Air Museum at Memphis is one of the truly "must see" sites in Egypt! Today, in Memphis, you can visit this

historical Open Air Museum, which amongst other artifacts exhibits a limestone colossus of King Ramses II. This enormous statue, carved in limestone, (and missing the King's feet) is about 10m (33.8ft) long. You can also see a stunning, giant alabaster Sphinx, weighing more than 80 tons, which once stood outside the massive temple of the god Ptah. You can also experience the sight of the remains of granite statues, showcasing Ramses II, as well as granite coffins and commemorative tablets from later periods.

Pyramid of Djoser

The Step Pyramid of Djoser, constructed at Saqqara about 4,700 years ago, was the first pyramid the Egyptians ever built. The pyramid started off as a mastaba tomb, a flat-roofed structure with sloping sides — and, through a series of expansions, evolved into a 197-foot-high (60 meters) pyramid. It has six layers, one built on top of the other. These enormous tributes to the memory of the Egyptian kings have become synonymous with the country.

After breakfast, we'll head to visit the Egyptian Museum in Cairo. The museum houses more than 300,000 precious collections of statues, paintings and handicrafts from prehistoric to Greek and Roman periods. Then, our staff will transfer you to the airport and you will take a flight to Aswan. In Aswan, a romantic Nile sailboat is specially arranged. Following, we will take you to the pier to go through the cruise boarding procedures. After boarding, you can have enough time for free activities.

1. If there is no wind on that day, the Nile sailboat will not be accessible, and it will be replaced by a motor boat.

Discover the world's largest collection of Egyptian antiquities! The Egyptian Museum in Cairo (EMC) is one of Egypt's most important attractions that should not be missed during your stay in Cairo. It is located on the northern side of Tahrir Square, Downtown, Cairo. It is the oldest archaeological museum in the Middle East, housing over 170,000 artefacts. The Museum's exhibits span the Predynastic Period to the Graeco-Roman Era (c. 5500 BC - AD 364). Come to visit EMC and appreciate the largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities in the world.

The cruise will arrive at Kom Ombo in the afternoon, and we will visit the Temple of Kom Ombo. The oldest calendar pattern in Egypt and even the world is preserved in this temple. The entire temple adopts a symmetrical structure with the same specifications. The left side is dedicated to the eagle god Holos, and the right is dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god. This temple is one of the few temples dedicated to both gods at the same time. Following, the Crocodile Museum will give you a good chance to get close contact with African crocodiles. Finally, we will stay overnight on the cruise.

Itinerary:

Aswan → Abu Simbel Temples (Optional, 120 mins) → **Kom Ombo → Temple of Kom Ombo** (60 mins) → **Crocodile Museum** (60 mins, Admission fee included) → **Overnight on the cruise**

Special Note:

1. If you choose to participate in the Abu Simbel Temples, you need to disembark at around 03:00 am. And you have to bring a packed breakfast with yourself and enjoy it in the car. It is about 3 hours' one-way drive from the wharf to the Abu Simbel Temples. Guests who do not participate in the self-funded activities can enjoy themselves on the river boat. If the sailing time of the day is advanced to the morning, you will not be able to visit Abu Simbel Temple at your own expense, please understand.

Abu Simbel Temples

The Great Temple of Abu Simbel, in Nubia near Egypt's southern border, is among the most awe-inspiring monuments of Egypt. The temple is most well known for the four imposing seated colossal statues that dominate its façade. The temple was built with such precision that on two days a year, the 22nd of February and 22nd of October, the sun's rays enter the temple, cross the main hall, and illuminate the innermost statues. The temple was admitted into its list of World Heritage Sites in 1979.

Temple of Kom Ombo

The Temple of Kom Ombo is unique due to its double design. This meant that there were courts, halls, sanctuaries and rooms duplicated for two sets of gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek. The northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris ("Horus the Elder"), along "with Tasenetnofret or Panebtawy (Lord of the Two Lands)."

Crocodile Museum

The Crocodile Museum is a small museum, which displays some mummified crocodile specimens and other cultural relics related to crocodiles and mummies, as well as crocodiles still in embryo, small crocodiles and large crocodiles.

There are also 20 paintings and statues belonging to crocodile worship.

After arriving in Edfu in the morning, you will be arranged to take a special carriage tour to visit the Edfu Temple. This temple is considered to be the last temple built entirely in accordance with ancient Egyptian traditions. It is also the only well-preserved ancient temple in Egypt. Next, we will return to the cruise after the tour, you can fully appreciate the beauty of both sides of the Nile River and watch the spectacular scene of the cruise ships lining up to pass through the Esna lock. Finally, we will arrive in Luxor and disembark to visit the world's largest open-air museum - Luxor Temple and then stay overnight on the cruise.

Itinerary:

Kom Ombo → Edfu → Carriage ride & Temple of Edfu (90 mins, **tickets for Edfu Temple and carriage tour included**) →

Go through Esna Lock by cruise → Luxor → Luxor Temple (60 mins, **ticket included**) → **Stay overnight on the cruise**

Special Note:

1. During the carriage ride, the carriage may cause an accident due to the emotions of the horse itself. We highly suggest being sure to hold the handrails tightly during the ride. Before the carriage stops, do not stand up or act dangerously, especially it is forbidden to climb the groom's seat.

The Temple of Edfu

The Temple of Edfu is an Egyptian temple located on the west bank of the Nile in Edfu, Upper Egypt, named after the main god Horus. It is one of the best preserved shrines in Egypt. Edfu was one of several temples built during the Ptolemaic Kingdom, including the Dendera Temple complex, Esna, the Temple of Kom Ombo, and Philae. Its size reflects the relative prosperity of the time.

Esna Lock

Esna Lock is located in Esna town, south of Luxor, Egypt. Esna Lock is very narrow and can only accommodate one cruise ship at a time. Due to this factor, it usually takes several hours to pass through the sluice. While waiting to pass through the sluice, you can explore the unique scenic views of Esna's water market.

Luxor Temple

The Luxor Temple is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank of the Nile River in the city today known as Luxor and was constructed approximately 1400 BCE. In the Egyptian language it was known as ipet resyt, "the southern sanctuary". Its main function was during the annual Opet festivals. At these festivals, the statues of Amun, Mut, and Khonsu were moved from Karnak, along the Avenue of Sphinxes, and reunited here during the inundation.

After the ignition, the colorful hot air balloons fly into the sky, just like air taxis in the fairy tale world. First, we will check out the cruise at about 8:00 in the morning, and then we will head to the Valley of the Kings. You cannot just miss the legendary tomb of Tutankhamun! Following, we will visit the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon standing between the west bank of the Nile and the Valley of the Kings. After one-day tour, we will drive to Hurghada, where the coral reefs and turquoise waters ideal for windsurfing are ideal for relaxation.

LXR Hot-air Balloon (Optional, 45 mins) → **Valley of the Kings** (60 mins, **ticket included, additional ticket is required to enter Tutankhamun's Tomb**) → **Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut** (30 mins, **ticket included**) → **Colossi of Memnon** (15 mins) → **Hurghada**

Special Note:

1. If you choose to participate in the LXR Hot-air Balloon, you need to disembark at around 03:00 am and return to the boat for breakfast after the activity. Pack your luggage and check out at about 8:00 am, we will disembark and continue our tour.

LXR Hot-air Balloon

Experience a new side of Luxor! From the sky, you will get a 45-minute hot air balloon experience. As you soar over the ancient city, your pilot guide will point out various historic attractions and tell you a bit about the area's rich ancient history.

Valley of the Kings

Once called the Great Necropolis of Millions of Years of Pharaoh, or the Place of Truth, the Valley of the Kings (Wadi Biban al-Muluk) has 63 magnificent royal tombs from the New Kingdom period (1550–1069 BC), all very different from each other. The West Bank had been the site of royal burials from the First Intermediate Period (2181–2055 BC) onwards. The secluded site enclosed by steep cliffs was easy to guard and, when seen from the Theban plain, appears to be the site of the setting sun, associated with the afterlife by ancient Egyptians.

Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut

The Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut was commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut, the first female pharaoh in the history of ancient Egypt. Queen Hatshepsut Temple is a 3-story building with a lot of interesting statues, columns, and hieroglyphic writings. Set at the back of an impressive 300 meter (1,000 foot) tall canyon, this temple has to be one of the most photogenic places in Egypt. It's a work of beauty and symmetry, with inscriptions and hieroglyphs that are amazing, like usual. Some of these show scarab beetles and insects, and others tell the story of the queen's birth and reign.

Colossi of Memnon

The Colossi of Memnon are two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which stand at the front of the ruined Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III, the largest temple in the Theban Necropolis. The statues contain 107 Roman-era inscriptions in Greek and Latin, dated to between AD 20 and 250.

Al-Azhar Park

Al-Azhar Park In 1984, His Highness the Aga Khan announced his decision to create a park for the Cairene to commemorate the foundations of Cairo by his ancestors, the Fatimids, in 969. The selected location was the derelict Darassa site, a 30-hectare mound of rubble between the eastern edge of the 12th century City Walls and the "City of the Dead". Al-Azhar Park opened to the public in 2005.

Citadel of Saladin

The Citadel of Saladin is a medieval Islamic-era fortification in Cairo, Egypt, built by Salah ad-Din (Saladin) and further developed by subsequent Egyptian rulers. It was the seat of government in Egypt and the residence of its rulers for

nearly 700 years from the 13th to the 19th centuries. It is now a preserved historic site, including mosques and museums.

Amir Mosque

Amir Mosque is located in the old city of Cairo. It is the first mosque in Egypt and even in Africa. It was established in 642 AD by the Arabs who conquered Egypt at that time. Its establishment marked the beginning of the rise of the Arab nation and Islam in Egypt and Africa.

Ben Ezra Synagogue

The Ben Ezra Synagogue is an ancient institution, and has occupied at least three buildings in its history. There have been many major and minor renovations. The current building dates to the 1890s. The Ben Ezra Synagogue functions now as a tourist attraction and museum, rather than as a functioning congregation.

Hanging Church

The Hanging Church is one of the earliest churches in Cairo and may also be the first church style church. The Hanging Church is named for its location above a gatehouse of Babylon Fortress, the Roman fortress in Coptic Cairo (Old Cairo). Its nave is suspended over a passage. The church is approached by twenty-nine steps, and early travelers to Cairo dubbed it "the Staircase Church".
