Opened in 1995, The Elephant House has established itself as one of the best tea and coffee houses in Edinburgh. Made famous as the place of inspiration to writers such as J.K. Rowling, who sat writing much of her early novels in the back room overlooking Edinburgh Castle.

Scott Monument

Standing proudly in Princes Street Gardens, is the Scott Monument! It is one of the most iconic Edinburgh landmarks and a must-see for tourists and locals alike. It was dedicated to Sir Walter Scott and is one of the largest monuments to a writer anywhere in the world today.

Princes Street

Princes Street is a unique street to discover on your trip to Edinburgh! It is filled with many hidden gems and a variety of shops, historical monuments, and restaurants!

Edinburgh Castle

Situated at the top of the Royal Mile on top of Castle Rock is the Edinburgh Castle. It is the number one visitor attraction place located in Scotland and the most iconic building in the city. Once inside, you can explore some of the oldest and most important buildings of the city, including St Margaret's Chapel, The National War Memorial, and the Half Moon Battery. Here, you will also find the magnificent Grand Hall and Scotland's Crown Jewels - including the

famous Stone of Destiny.

After breakfast, we will first drive to Windermere to enjoy beautiful lake views. After the trip, we will make our way to Manchester. Upon arrival, we will visit the Old Trafford, which is the home of the English football club Manchester United. Football is an important part of Manchester culture in the popular sports projects in Manchester, so the Old Trafford is a football holy land that cannot be missed by the majority of fans. Following, we will go to Albert Square, which was built before the 20th Century, and consisted of forty-six victorian terraced houses, a public house, gardens and a market sloping down the south side of the Square leading on to Bridge Street and Turpin Road.

Windermere

Windermere, known as "the most beautiful natural scenery in England" is a famous tourist center. The Windermere lake was formed at the end of the last glacial period in a glacial valley running north-south through the Khumbulian Mountains. It is part of the Lake District National Park and has yacht entertainment in summer. Here, you can stroll through the lake district, which the British call "the back garden" to enjoy the beautiful scenery along the way.

Windermere Lake Cruise + Steam Train

Take a boat tour of the lake area of Windermere to admire the lakes and mountains that overlook the villas in the valley like a fairy tale world. The steam train, left in the last industrial period in Britain, still maintain its former appearance. When the train leaves the station, it emits a huge steam mist that spreads throughout the station and disappears into the mountains through the old trestle bridge.

Old Trafford

Old Trafford Stadium is the world-famous home of Manchester United. Unusual aspects of the ground include the raised pitch, and that the teams enter the field from the corner of the Sir Bobby Charlton Stand. Outside the ground is the Sir Matt Busby Statue fronting the impressive green glassed East Stand facade, whilst above the entrance to the Club Museum outside the North Stand is a statue of Sir Alex Ferguson. There is also a clock and plaque in remembrance of the Munich disaster. Across Sir Matt Busby Way is the United Trinity Statue of three of the 1968 European Cup winning team; George Best, Denis Law and Bobby Charlton (now Sir).

Albert Square

Albert Square is the city's civic heart. This is the Heart of Manchester in all its Gothic style. The town hall towers over the square in its architecture splendour and square normally provides a huge space for many a seasonal events, including the famous Manchester Christmas Markets. This public square, dominated by Manchester town hall, has also become a focal point for major public events as well as political demonstrations. It features a number of monuments, most famously the Albert Memorial of Prince Albert, consort to Queen Victoria.

Big Ben

Big Ben is the nickname for the Great Bell of the striking clock at the north end of the Palace of Westminster. The official name of the tower in which Big Ben is located was originally the Clock Tower. It was renamed the Elizabeth Tower in 2012 to mark the Diamond Jubilee of Elizabeth II. When completed in 1859, it was the largest and most accurate clock in the world.

Westminster Abbey

Westminster Abbey is a large, mainly Gothic abbey church in the City of Westminster. It is one of the United Kingdom's most notable religious buildings and the traditional place of coronation and a burial site for English and later British monarchs. Sixteen royal weddings have occurred at the Abbey since 1100.

Parliament Square

Parliament Square in Westminster is located right next to Westminster Abbey and the Houses of Parliament. The square was created in the 1860s and contains statues of well-known statesmen including Winston Churchill, Abraham Lincoln, and Nelson Mandela.

10 Downing Street

10 Downing Street in London is the official residence and office of the prime minister of the United Kingdom. Colloquially known as Number 10, the building is in Downing Street in the City of Westminster, London. It is over 300 years old and contains approximately 100 rooms. A private residence for the prime minister occupies the third floor and there is a kitchen in the basement. The other floors contain offices and conference, reception, sitting and dining rooms where the prime minister works, and where government ministers, national leaders and foreign dignitaries are met and hosted.

Horse Guards Parade

Horse Guards Parade is the ceremonial parade ground in St James's Park and is the scene of Trooping the Colour on the King's official birthday in June. Horse Guards is the building with a clock tower over an archway, and remains the official entrance to St James's and Buckingham Palace. The building is guarded by two mounted cavalry troopers of The King's Life Guard. The Life Guard change takes place here at 11:00am daily and 10:00am on Sundays. During the Trooping the Colour, the central windows are opened so members of the Royal Family can watch the King reviewing his troops below.

Oxford Street

First for fashion, entertainment, technology and innovation, Oxford Street is the world's biggest high street. It offers 1.5 miles of unrivalled shopping, with more than 90 flagship stores, from fashion and beauty, to tech and homeware. Oxford Street is the ultimate shopping paradise. King's Cross Railway Station

King's Cross railway station, also known as London King's Cross, is a passenger railway terminus in the London Borough

of Camden, on the edge of Central London. It is in the London station group, one of the busiest stations in the United

Kingdom and the southern terminus of the East Coast Main Line to North East England and Scotland. Adjacent to King's

Cross station is St Pancras International, the London terminus for Eurostar services to continental Europe.

Buckingham Palace

Buckingham Palace is the London residence and administrative headquarters of the monarch of the United Kingdom. It

is located in the City of Westminster! The palace is often at the center of state occasions and royal hospitality.

The British Museum

The British Museum is a public institution dedicated to human history, art and culture located in the Bloomsbury area

of London, England. It has over eight million works of the largest collections during the era of the British Empire. It

documents the story of human culture from its beginnings to the present day.
