canal leads into the lagoon near the Santa Lucia railway station and the other end leads into the basin at San Marco; in

between, it makes a large reverse-S shape through the central districts (sestieri) of Venice. The banks of the Grand

Canal are lined with more than 170 buildings, most of which date from the 13th to the 18th century, and demonstrate

the welfare and art created by the Republic of Venice.

Venice Gondola Rides

The gondolas plying the busy Grand Canal and the smaller waterways of Venice are one of the most iconic images in the

world. They are the symbol of history, tradition, and romance in the city on the lagoon, and a gondola ride in Venice

ranks among one of the most dreamed-about experiences for travelers.

It opened in 1995 and is located in the Austrian Tyrol, in the town of Wattens, Innsbruck-Land District, where the company was founded and still has its headquarters today.

Innsbruck

Innsbruck, capital of Bundesland (federal state) Tirol, western Austria, on the Inn at the mouth of the Sill River in the Eastern Alps. The old town has narrow streets lined with medieval houses and arcades. One of the most famous buildings is the Fürstenburg, with a balcony with a gilded copper roof, supposedly built by Duke Frederick and refashioned by the emperor Maximilian in about 1500.

honour of Richard Wagner. The lavish structure is complete with a walled courtyard, an indoor garden, spires, towers,

and an artificial cave. In contrast to the medieval castles it was modeled after, Neuschwanstein is equipped with

running water throughout, including flush toilets and hot water in the kitchen and baths, and has a forced-air central

heating system.

imposing stone lion, however, is more than "just" a monument. It can be seen as a commemoration, a work of art or a

memorial. It is a powerful and proud landmark of the city of Lucerne.

Titlis

Of all the highlights in Central Switzerland, TITLIS is the big one - and the only glacier in the entire region that is actually

accessible. So come and enjoy the breathtaking panorama of snow-capped mountaintops and untouched Alpine

landscapes. At 3,062 metres, the summit offers not only a breathtaking 360° panorama of the wide Engelberg valley but

also a view straight down into the abyss, with countless crevasses carved into the glacial ice.

Interlaken

Interlaken is a traditional resort town located in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of central Switzerland.

Interlaken was built on a narrow stretch of valley, between the emerald-colored waters of Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. It

has old timber houses and parklands on either side of the Aare River. It is also surrounded by mountains, forests,

meadows, glaciers, and it even offers hiking and skiing trails available year-round!

Schilthorn

A cable car runs every half hour from Stechelberg in the Lauterbrunnen valley in four stages up to the summit. Once at

the top, spectacular views of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau await you. The Schilthorn became a famous location as of

1969 by the famous James Bond film "On Her Majesty's Secret Service." The revolving restaurant at the summit, which

rotates around its own axis once every 45 minutes, owes its current name "Piz Gloria" to the film production. Visitors

may follow in James Bond's footsteps in the interactive Bond World exhibition or on the 007 Walk of Fame.

Avenue des Champs - Elysées
