Due to its influence of Russian culture, the city's architectural art is world-famous. Today, we will even take you aboard a five-star night cruise to Stockholm, which is the capital of Sweden.

Sibelius Park and Monument

Sibelius Park and Monument was constructed in remembrance of the Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. This seaside park and memorial is one Helsinki's most popular attraction. The abstract monument, entitled *Passio Musicae*, was created by an artist named Eila Hiltunen. It is actually a kinetic, musical sculpture with a bundle of 600 steel tubes that captures the wind. Explore the beauty and spark a debate about abstract art at this unique place.

Helsinki Cathedral

The Helsinki Cathedral rises on the northern side of the Senate Square and is the stage of national and academic festive services! It is one of the most popular tourist sights to discover! This church is part of Helsinki's Empire era center and a landmark for those arriving near the sea. It has also become the symbol of Helsinki.

Tempeliaukion-kirkko

Hewn into solid stone, the Tempeliaukion church, designed by Timo and Tuomo Suomalainen in 1969, feels close to a Finnish ideal of spirituality in nature – you could be in a rocky glade were it not for the stunning 24m-diameter roof covered in 22km of copper stripping. The acoustics are exceptional; regular concerts take place here. Opening times vary, depending on events and seasons, so check online before visiting. There are fewer tour groups to navigate around midweek.

Market Square, Helsinki

The Market Square is a central square located in Helsinki! It is in the center of Helsinki and at the eastern end of Esplanadi. The Baltic Sea is located to the south and Katajanokka is located to the east. From spring to autumn, the Market Square is fully active with vendors selling fresh Finnish food and souvenirs! There are also many outdoor cafés at the square and some even provide the best meat pastries for you to try!

Vasa Museum

The Vasa ship capsized and sank in Stockholm 1628. After 333 years on the seabed, the mighty warship was salvaged, and the voyage continues. Today, Vasa is the world's best preserved 17th century ship and the most visited museum in Scandinavia!

Stockholm Palace

Welcome to one of the largest palaces in Europe! The Royal Palace is the official residence of His Majesty the King of Sweden, with over 600 rooms. The Palace was largely built during the eighteenth century in the Italian Baroque style, on the spot where the "Tre Kronor" castle burned down in 1697.

Fjällgatan

The Fjällgatan is located on the Stigberget, a cliff on the north side of the island Södermalm in the centre of Stockholm. The street is part of a historical district and offers a fantastic view of large parts of Stockholm's city centre.

The Sognefjord or Sognefjorden (Urban East Norwegian: [ˈsôŋnəˌfjuːɲ], English: Sogn Fjord), nicknamed the King of the Fjords (Norwegian: Fjordenes konge), is the largest and deepest fjord in Norway. Located in Vestland county in Western Norway, it stretches 205 kilometres (127 mi) inland from the ocean to the small village of Skjolden in the municipality of Luster.

Hardangerfjord

The Hardangerfjord is the fifth longest fjord in the world, and the second longest fjord in Norway. It is located in Vestland county in the Hardanger region. The fjord stretches 179 kilometres (111 mi) from the Atlantic Ocean into the mountainous interior of Norway along the Hardangervidda plateau.

Steinsdalsfossen Waterfall

The Steinsdalsfossen waterfall is a good experience even it is far from being Norway's highest or biggest waterfall. What makes it special is that here you can walk behind the cascade without getting wet on a small paved road. Following the trail you can come to the look-out point with amazing views of valley and the mountain range not far from this place. The waterfall is at its fullest and most spectacular in spring when the snow is melting. But it is lovely on a cold day as well, as it was partly frozen.

Vigeland Park

Sculpture park in the Frogner Park with more than 200 sculptures by Gustav Vigeland (1869–1943) in bronze, granite and cast iron, including The Angry Boy (Sinnataggen in Norwegian), The Monolith (Monolitten) and The Wheel of Life (Livshjulet). Vigeland was also responsible for the design and architectural outline of the park, which is one of Norway's top tourist attractions, with more than one million annual visitors.

Holmenkollen Ski Jump Tower

It is only a short walk to the ski jump tower. It rises to a height of 420 metres above the fjord and looks frighteningly

steep. The legendary ski jump was replaced by a new, very modern facility. To the observer it looks like a giant soup spoon.

Gustaf Adolf's Square

Gustaf Adolf's square is located in central Gothenburg. It was named Stortorget (the Big square) until 1854 when a statue was raised over the founding father of Gothenburg, king Gustavus Adolphus of Sweden.

Gotaplatsen

Götaplatsen was established for the World Expo in 1923 when Gothenburg celebrated its 300th anniversary and has been one of the city's most well-known places since then. The square is not only home to the famous Poseidon statue designed by Carl Milles, but also the Gothenburg Museum of Art, City Theatre and Concert Hall.

Goteborg Operan House

The Gothenburg opera house is an opera house at Lilla Bommen in Gothenburg, Sweden. It is a large house – 160 metres long and 85 metres wide at its widest – and the building is 32 metres high.

H.C. Andersen Statue (outside visit, 15 minutes) → **The Little Mermaid statue** (outside visit, 15 minutes) → **Shennong Fountain** (outside visit, 15 minutes) → **Amalienborg Palace** (outside visit, 15 minutes)

H.C. Andersen Statue

The Statue of Hans Christian Andersen in Rosenborg Castle Gardens, Copenhagen, Denmark, is a bronze statue of famous Danish writer Hans Christian Andersen. Saabye's sculpture depicts Andersen in a sitting position addressing his

audience. The sculpture is mounted on a terracotta plinth with bronze reliefs.

The Little Mermaid

Arguably one of Copenhagen's most iconic tourist attractions: The sculpture of The Little Mermaid was inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's famous fairy tale. Unveiled on 23 August 1913, The Little Mermaid was a gift from Danish brewer Carl Jacobsen to the City of Copenhagen. The sculpture is made of bronze and granite and sits in the water at Langelinie Pier.

Amalienborg Palace

Visit the seat of one of the world's oldest monarchies and go behind the scenes in a real royal palace. Don't miss the palace square where you can watch the unforgettable changing of the guards.

Travel tips

Restrictions on entry at Finland's external borders imposed due to the COVID-19 pandemic ended on 30 June, 2022.

This means that EU travellers, Schengen travellers and third-country travellers arriving in Finland will no longer be required to hold vaccination or COVID-19 test certificates, and COVID-19 tests will not be carried out at border crossing points.

Border checks will return to pre-pandemic procedures.

Travellers arriving from non-EU and non-Schengen countries must still have normal travel documents, i.e. a passport and, if necessary, a visa. restrictions can change rapidly. For official information please refer to the Finnish Border Guard and the Finnish institute for health and welfare.
