Milan Cathedral

The Cathedral of Milan is one of the greatest symbols of Milan! It is a uniquely and intricately designed church. It is one of the largest cathedrals in Italy and all of Europe. The cathedral is a place of prayer and teachings and is truly a must-see in Milan!

Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II

The Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II is Italy's oldest active shopping gallery and a major landmark of Milan in Italy. Housed within a four-story double arcade in the center of town, the Galleria is named after Victor Emmanuel II, the first king of the Kingdom of Italy. The structure consists of two glass-vaulted arcades intersecting in an octagon covering the street connecting Piazza del Duomo to Piazza della Scala. The street is covered by an arching glass and cast-iron roof, a popular design for 19th-century arcades and the central octagonal space is topped with a glass dome.

La Scala

La Scala, or Teatro alla Scala, in Italian, is one of the most famous opera houses in the world. Its sober and elegant exterior never fails to surprise those that visit it for the first time. Many famous operas have had their first production in La Scala, such as Othello, Nabucco by Verdi or Madame Butterfly by Giacomo Puccini.

Arles

Arles is a coastal city and commune in the South of France, a subprefecture in the Bouches-du-Rhône department of the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region, in the former province of Provence. It's easy to understand why Vincent Van Gogh was so charmed by Arles, with its sun-kissed stone houses, cobbled squares, and Roman ruins. Set on the banks of the Rhône River, the city also harbors a robust contemporary arts scene.

Arles Amphitheatre

The Arles Amphitheatre is a Roman amphitheatre in the southern French town of Arles. It is likely the most prominent tourist attraction from the city which thrived in Ancient Rome. The towers sit atop are medieval add-ons. Built in 90 AD, the amphitheatre held over 20,000 spectators of chariot races and bloody hand-to-hand battles. Lately, it draws smaller crowds for bullfighting during the Feria d'Arles as well as plays and concerts in summer.

Van Gogh Cafe

Van Gogh Café just as it sounds is an interesting café filled with delightful treats and coffee. If you are a sweet-tooth lover, this is your place!

Pont du Gard

The Pont du Gard is a three-level Roman monument built halfway through the 1st century AD. It is the principal construction in a 50 km long aqueduct that supplied the city of Nîmes with water. It was added to UNESCO's list of World Heritage sites in 1985 because of its exceptional preservation, historical importance, and architectural ingenuity.

Avignon

As the capital of the Vaucluse and the Côtes du Rhône, the seat of the popes, city of art and culture, Avignon is full of history and full of life. The historic city center, the Popes' Palace, all the episcopal buildings and the Saint Bénézet Bridge are listed as world heritage sites by UNESCO. Just as its name implies, the Popes' Palace, is a symbol to the city and awe-inspiring monument to the importance of Avignon in the Christian world of the Middle Ages.

Palace of the Popes

The Palace of the Popes is a historical palace located in Avignon, Southern France. It is one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe. Once a fortress and palace, the pope's residence was the seat of Western Christianity during the 14th century. Since 1995, the Palais des Papes has been classified as a historic center of Avignon and as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, for its outstanding architecture and historical importance for the Papacy.

Avignon Bridge

The Saint Bénézet bridge was a major witness of the history of Avignon. Today, it is known throughout the world thanks

to the famous song. Built from the 12th century, it was washed away several times by the floods of the Rhone, and finally abandoned in the seventeenth century. It is even classified as a World Heritage by UNESCO.

Grignan

As you would expect from the Plus Beaux Villages de France label, Grignan is a highly photogenic place. It is set on a rocky promontory above a landscape of lavender grapevines, truffle fields and scrubland. It has been occupied since prehistoric times, but the dominant architecture is pale medieval stone with a majestic Renaissance château at the very top of the village.

Lyon

Lyon is known as the former capital of the Gauls at the time of the Roman Empire. Lyon is the seat of an archbishopric whose holder bears the title of Primate of the Gauls. Lyon became a major economic hub during the Renaissance. The city is recognised for its cuisine and gastronomy, as well as historical and architectural landmarks; as such, the districts of Old Lyon, the Fourvière hill, the Presqu'île and the slopes of the Croix-Rousse. All of these locations are inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Annecy

Annecy is known as the prefecture and largest city of the Haute-Savoie department in the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes region of Southeastern France. It is nicknamed as the "Pearl of French Alps" in Raoul Blanchard's monograph.

Needle of the Mid-day

The Aiguille du Midi is a 3,842 meter tall mountain in the Mont Blanc massif in the French Alps. The name "Aiguille du Midi" translates literally to "Needle of the Noon" or "Needle of the Mid-day". The mountain gets its name from the fact that it lies to the south when viewed from in front of the church in Chamonix.

Chamonix-Mont-Blanc

Chamonix is a vibrant town known as both a world-class ski resort and a mountaineering destination. With these vast, jagged mountains towering over the town, the scenery here is arguably the most spectacular in the French Alps. The natural beauty of this valley is the main draw for tourists. The snow-capped peaks soar into the bright blue sky and the ancient glaciers sweep down towards the valley floors. It is filled with so much beauty from all-around.

Arc de Triomphe

The Arc de Triomphe is one of the most famous monuments in all of Paris, France. The Arc de Triomphe honors those who fought and died for France during the French Revolutionary and Napoleonic Wars. Beneath its vault lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier from World War I. It set the tone for public monuments with triumphant patriotic messages.

Avenue des Champs - Elysées

The Avenue des Champs-Élysées is a Paris must-see! This unique avenue is said to be one of the greatest! The avenue is approximately 1.9 km long and 70 m wide, running between the Place de la Concorde and the Place Charles de Gaulle, where the Arc de Triomphe is located.
