Milan, the capital of Milano province and of the region of Lombardy, northern Italy. It is internationally recognized as one of the world's most important fashion capitals, but it also has a wealth of interesting museums and things to see and do. We will visit the Milan Cathedral. Then we will head to the Leukerbad Thermal baths, where we can enjoy the hot springs on the mountaintop while enjoying the mountain scenery. Saunas, steam baths, and other related facilities will thoroughly nourish and care for your body (please bring your own swimsuit and towel).

#### Itinerary:

**Milan pick-up → Milan** (60 mins): Outside Visit Milan Cathedral → **Leukerbad Thermal baths** (120 mins, include ticket) → **Hotel**

The calcium-sulphate-rich water with its remarkable fluoride content and the majestic views of the Daubenhorn massif round off the experience of peace and relaxation.

## **Day 3**

**Brig - Train - Aletsch Glacier - Train - Brig**

All day

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will walk to the platform near the hotel under the guidance of our leader, take a train to Betten Talstation, and take a cable car to board the famous Bettmeralp to visit the largest and longest glacier in the Alps - the Aletsch Glacier. In 2001, the Aletsch Glacier and Jungfrau Peak were both listed as World Heritage Sites and are representative scenic spots in the Aletsch. Its glaciers and rocks are 23 kilometers long, covering an area of 85 square kilometers. Lunch at Bettmeralp Peak Restaurant. After the tour, we will take the cable car down the mountain and then return to Brig by train. After dinner, stay at the hotel and rest.

**Bridg takes the train to Beten → takes the cable car to board Bettermore → Aletsch Glacier (2 hours) → takes the cable car down the mountain → takes the train back to Bridg**

### **Aletsch Glacier**

Incredibly immense, incredibly beautiful: the Large Aletsch Glacier is the Alps' mightiest ice flow. The Aletsch region is part of a Unesco World Heritage Site. And not just because the "Large Aletsch Glacier", which carries an incredible 11 billion tons of ice, is the largest glacier of the Alps. The ice extends from the northern slopes of Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau down towards the Valais. The water flows through the untamed Massa Gorge into the Rhone.

## **Day 4**

**Brig - Train - Zermatt - Train - Brig**

All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will take the train to the Zermatt Town, located among the peaks of the Alps and known as the "Glacier City", it is a world-renowned mountain tourist destination free from car pollution. Then take the Alpine Gear Tram and climb onto the Gornegrat Observation Platform at a height of 3130 meters, overlooking the Alpine Glacier, enjoying the comfort of a silver world and experiencing the feeling of being on top of a glacier. The special triangular shaped Matterhorn Peak overlooks the Alpine peaks with a towering posture. You can take a tram to the small town of Zermatt at the foot of the mountain to stroll and take photos of the beautiful scenery while walking. Finally, take the train back to Brig before sunset.

**Bridg takes the train to Zermatt Town → Zermatt Town(1 hour) → takes the tram to the Gornegrat Observation Platform and overlooks the Matterhorn Peak (2.5 hours) → takes the train back to Bridg**

### **Matterhorn**

At 4,478 metres, the majestic Matterhorn, also called the "jewel of the Swiss Alps" and certainly the most famous mountain in Europe, looms over the breathtaking Alpine panorama. This Switzerland landmark is at the border of the western Swiss canton of Valais between Zermatt and the Italian resort of Breuil-Cervinia, and offers a paradise for all nature-lovers looking for peace and quiet. Its symmetric pyramid shape, the rocky tooth reaching the sky and the light reflections of the nearby Stellisee make the Matterhorn's landscape a unique natural spectacle in Zermatt.

## Chillon Castle

Perched on a small island on Lac Léman also known as Lake Geneva, near the town of Montreux, Chillon Castle is a spectacle not to be missed during any visit to Switzerland. Ideally located with breath-taking views of the surrounding Alps. Byron, inspired by the thought of Bonivard in chains in the dank underbelly of the castle, penned The Prisoner of Chillon, a poem that romanticised the castle and placed it firmly in the annals of history.

After completing the tour of Lausanne, continue to take the train to Geneva, the second largest city in the Swiss Confederation. It is also an international city where various international institutions gather around the world. Take the train back to Montreux in the evening.

### **Lausanne Cathedral**

As the spiritual capital of French-speaking Switzerland, the Cathedral of Lausanne is of interest to people from all parts of the world. Constructed during the XIIth and XIIIth centuries, consecrated 20th October 1275 in the presence of Pope Gregory X and Rudolf of Habsburg. It became a protestant cathedral in 1536.

### **Olympic Museum**

The Olympic Capital, Lausanne has been home to the IOC (International Olympic Committee) for 100 years and in 1993, the IOC founded its unique official museum on the banks of Lake Geneva. In 2013, The Olympic Museum was completely renovated with the most up-to-date facilities. Now on three floors, the exhibition presents the origin of the games, the competitions and the athletic spirit through over 150 screens and 1500 objects: The Olympic torches and medals of all The Olympic games, as well as the equipment of the most famous athletes.

### **Flower Clock**

Geneva is recognized all around the world for its watch making tradition and being the mother of high-end watchmaking! To pay tribute to this honor, Geneva created the biggest clock in the world, made from flowers! It is absolutely amazing and definitely worth the visit! Geneva Flower Clock, named L'horloge fleurie in French, was created in 1955 and very quickly became world famous!

## **Day 7**

**Montreux - Train - Interlaken - Train - Bern**

All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will take the Golden Pass Scenic Train from Montreux to Interlaken. This is the highlight of the Golden Pass Scenic Train. The classic example of this section is that when the train leaves the city of Montreux, it slowly detours from the high mountain cliffs and climbs up the slope at nearly 60 degrees, gradually leaving Montreux Railway Station by the lake. After arriving in Interlaken town, we will move freely. The town is located between Lake



Tuen and Lake Brien in the Alps. The climate here is mild all year round, with beautiful scenery. It is also a summer resort in the eyes of Swiss people. Afterwards, take a train to Bern. In the old city of Bern, historical sites are everywhere, and the complete medieval historical landscape is preserved here. There are many heart-shaped springs in the streets of the old city of Bern, so Bern is also known as the "Spring City".

#### **Itinerary:**

**Take the Golden Mountain Pass Landscape Train from Montreux to Interlaken → Interlaken Free Activity (2 hours) →**

**Take the Train from Interlaken to Bern → Bern (1.5 hours):** outside visit Bern Parliament Building, stroll through the ancient city of Bern, outside visit Bern Bell Tower, and stepped cathedral

#### **Interlaken**

Interlaken is a traditional resort town located in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of central Switzerland. Interlaken was built on a narrow stretch of valley, between the emerald-colored waters of Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. It has old timber houses and parklands on either side of the Aare River. It is also surrounded by mountains, forests, meadows, glaciers, and it even offers hiking and skiing trails available year-round!

#### **Old City of Bern**

Old Town of Bern was entered onto the UNESCO's listing of World Heritage Sites in 1983. With its 6km of limestone buildings and medieval arcades, its Renaissance fountains with colorful figures offer amazing views! It even has a beautiful cathedral surrounded by picturesque rooftops of Bern! It is truly a gem of medieval architecture in Europe.

Hotel: Hotel Bären am Bundesplatz; Or NH Bern The Bristol; Or Best Western Plus Hotel Bern; Or similar;

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will leave Bern and drive to Luzern, located in central Switzerland. Luzern is known as the most beautiful and ideal tourist city in Switzerland, and is also the most beloved vacation destination for Swiss people. As a historic and cultural city, many artists have received endless inspiration here. Then we will take a cable car to climb the 3238 meter high Titlis. Finally, we will return to Milan.

#### **Itinerary:**

**Bern → Luzern (90 mins):** Chapel Bridge and Water Tower, Lion Monument → **Titlis (120 mins) → Milan**

#### **Precautions:**

The highest altitude of Titlis Peak is about 3238 meters. Please do not climb the mountain if you are feeling unwell; The top of Titlis Peak is covered with snow all year round. Please bring warm clothing and wear anti slip shoes; Due to the high altitude of Maiden Peak, the body may find it difficult to adapt for a while and should not engage in vigorous exercise. Smoking and drinking should be reduced to prevent altitude sickness; To climb the mountain, you need to take a cable car. Please follow the tour guide closely.

#### **Chapel Bridge and Water Tower**

Lucerne's landmark is considered to be Europe's oldest covered bridge! It was built in 1332 and was originally a part of the city fortifications. The pictorial panels, which were incorporated in the 17th century contain scenes of the Swiss and Lucerne's amazing history. This includes the biographies of the city's patron saints, St. Leodegar and St. Maurice.

Lucerne's water tower is a powerful and yet attractive construction that you must see!

#### **Lion Monument**

Lucerne's world-famous Lion Monument has been consistently impressing its visitors each and every year. The imposing stone lion, however, is more than "just" a monument. It can be seen as a commemoration, a work of art or a memorial. It is a powerful and proud landmark of the city of Lucerne.

#### **Titlis**

Of all the highlights in Central Switzerland, TITLIS is the big one - and the only glacier in the entire region that is actually accessible. So come and enjoy the breathtaking panorama of snow-capped mountaintops and untouched Alpine landscapes. At 3,062 metres, the summit offers not only a breathtaking 360° panorama of the wide Engelberg valley but

also a view straight down into the abyss, with countless crevasses carved into the glacial ice.

10. For all guests participating in the European tour, our company will assist in filling in the declaration card of the country of entry and assist in the virus test required for returning to the United States (the test fee is at your own expense).

11. Only for products with airport pick-up service: only one pick-up service within the free pick-up time range is provided for each order. If it is impossible to arrange due to weather and flight delay, etc., please pay for your own transportation costs.
