Day 1

All day

You can also take a sightseeing cruise to enjoy the beautiful lake view. Moreover, you can get a glimpse of the world's only golf course on a lake. Then we will drive to Missoula, Montana and take a visit to the famous 50,000 Silver Dollar Collection Bar. Stay overnight in Missoula.

Itinerary:

Seattle → Lake Coeur d'Alene Cruise (optional, 90 mins) → The 50,000 Silver Dollar (60 mins) → Missoula

Afternoon

Coeur d'Alene

You will find the world's longest floating boardwalk, located at the Coeur d'Alene Resort. Built in 1986, the boardwalk is over 0.75 mile long and offers rest stops with benches for those who want to savor the amazing lake views, or keep a watch out for osprey or bald eagles. By the shores of beautiful Lake Coeur d'Alene, you will also find the Floating Green golf course, the one and only of its kind.

50,000 Silver Dollar Collection Bar

This 50,000 plus Silver Dollar collection was started by Gerry and Marie Lincoln in 1952. Now in their fourth generation, the Lincoln family continues the Silver Dollar collection. People from all over the world have their names inscribed. Over \$2500 are embedded in the bar top with the remainder graciously adorning the surrounding walls and ceiling.

Yellowstone National Park spans an area of 3,468 square miles (8,983 square kilometers), located primarily in the U.S. state of Wyoming, although it also extends into Montana and Idaho. Yellowstone National Park is one of the most stunning Wonderlands in the world. The majority of the world's geysers are preserved here. They are the main reason the park was established in 1872 as America's first national park – an idea that spread worldwide later. Around noon, we will arrive in the Yellowstone and will show you around before go to hotel in Idaho in night.

Itinerary:

Missoula → Yellowstone National Park (Mandatory, 5 hours) → West Yellowstone

Note: In the Yellowstone Park, we will go to visit: Artist Paint Pots (30 mins), Fountain Freight Road (60 mins), Morning Glory Pool (15 mins), Old Faithful Geyser (visit duration depends on the eruption time of the geyser), Grand Prismatic Hot Springs (60 mins) and other scenic spots, please refer to the tour guide's actual arrangements.

Afternoon

Yellowstone National Park

Yellowstone National Park, the first national park in the United States, it is a true gem that you will not want to miss out on! Yellowstone offers spectacular scenic views year-round and a chance to watch animals that migrate in and out of the park! No matter where you are in the park you will get to see these some spectacular animals! Here you will find bears, wolves, moose, elk, bison and more!

Old Faithful Geyser

Old Faithful is a cone geyser in the Upper Geyser Basin of Yellowstone National Park. It is one of the park's most well-known natural features and is famous for its predictability. It generally erupts every 91 minutes.

The Grand Prismatic Hot Spring

The Grand Prismatic Spring, with approximately 370 feet (110 m) in diameter and is 160 feet (50 m) deep, which discharges an estimated 560 US gallons (2,100 L) of 160 °F (70 °C) water per minute. It is the largest hot spring in the United States, and the third largest in the world. The vivid colors in the spring are the result of microbial mats around the edges of the mineral-rich water. The mats produce colors ranging from green to red; the amount of color in the microbial mats depends on the ratio of chlorophyll to carotenoids and on the temperature gradient in the runoff. In the

summer, the mats tend to be orange and red, whereas in the winter the mats are usually dark green. The center of the pool is sterile due to extreme heat.

Mud Volcano Area

The Mud Volcano blew itself apart in the early 20th century, but visitors can still see the impressive crater and other geothermal features in the surrounding area, such as the Mud Cauldron, Black Dragon's Caldron, and Dragon's Mouth Spring.

Yellowstone Norris Geyser Basin

Norris Geyser Basin, named after an early Yellow-stone Superintendent, may be the hottest geyser basin in Yellowstone. The stark, barren landscape of Porcelain Basin is the result of an acidic environment. Due to the hostile condition plants, algae and bacteria have difficulty in establishing themselves. Instead the basin derives its colors from mineral oxides, in spectrums of pink, red, orange (iron oxides) and yellow (sulfur and iron sulfates). The largest geyser in the world is located here. Steamboat Geyser has long periods of dormancy, but when it does erupt it sends jets of water nearly 380 feet high in a spectacular display.

All day

Today, we will go to Jackson, a famous cowboy town. There is a vast elk sanctuary near the town. The most eye-catching thing in the town is the antler park in the center, which is built with 7,500 real antlers, which is spectacular. Following, we will arrive at Grand Teton National Park in the northwest of Wyoming, USA. The Grand Teton is 4199 meters above sea level and is the highest peak in the Teton Mountains. There are glaciers that have survived to this day. Then we will continue our tour of Yellowstone National Park. Finally we will return to West Yellowstone Hotel.

Itinerary:

West Yellowstone → Jackson Town → Antlers Park (30 mins) → Grand Teton National Park (Mandatory, 120 mins) → Yellowstone National Park (3 hours) → West Yellowstone

Note: In the Yellowstone National Park, we will visit: Artist Point (30 mins), Upper Falls (30 mins), Hayden Valley (15 mins), Mud Volcano (30 mins), Fishing Bridge (20 mins), West Thumb Geyser Basin (45 mins)) and other scenic spots, please refer to the tour guide's actual arrangements.

Morning

Elk Antler Arches Park

Elk Antler Arches Park has four arches and is made with thousands of elk antlers that make it so unique. It is such an amazing place to discover filled with unforgettable memories.

Grand Teton National Park

Grand Teton National Park is located in the Rocky Mountains, Northwest Wyoming. Grand Teton National Park is noted for its stunning mountain vistas and its shimmering alpine lakes. It is also home to a variety of abundant wildlife.

Yellowstone National Park

Artist Point

Artist Point is one of the most spectacular scenic areas in the Canyon Area of the Park. The sheer walls drop 700 feet to the bottom of the canyon. Upriver the powerful Lower Falls are still in view. Downriver the canyon widens and deepens to a maximum of 1,540 feet. The canyon walls are predominantly yellow but colors of blue, red, orange and brown are also present. The colors are ever changing and especially intensified when the sunshine's after a rain.

Hayden Valley

This valley, centrally located in Yellowstone National Park, is the first place to go to see wildlife in Yellowstone. As you drive along this beautiful, broad valley you are likely to see herds of bison, scattered elk (and the occasional herd), and the occasional grizzly bear. You are also likely to see waterfowl, including ducks, Canada geese and pelicans, swimming in or lounging near the Yellowstone River.

Mud Volcano Area

The Mud Volcano blew itself apart in the early 20th century, but visitors can still see the impressive crater and other geothermal features in the surrounding area, such as the Mud Cauldron, Black Dragon's Caldron, and Dragon's Mouth Spring.

West Thumb Geyser Basin

The West Thumb Geyser Basin is situated at the western edge of a large bay along the shores of Yellowstone Lake. This area is known as the West Thumb caldera which was formed by a volcanic eruption that took place 174,000 years ago. This bay is actually a smaller caldera within the larger Yellowstone caldera. The resulting caldera filled with water,

creating the bay.

Day 4

In the west and southwest, Yellowstone is home to some 10,000 thermal features, over 500 hundred of which are geysers. Today we will visit Norris Geyser Basin. Norris Geyser Basin is the hottest and most changeable thermal area in Yellowstone. We will deeply explore many of the features: Rainbow Colors, hissing steam, and pungent odors combine to create an experience unique in Yellowstone. After that, we will return to Missoula.

Itinerary:

West Yellowstone → Yellowstone National Park (5 hours) → Missoula

It hosted the World Expo in 1974 and was the smallest city to host the World Expo in history. This is also the first World Expo with an environmental theme in history, and World Environment Day begins in Spokane. We will visit Manito Park, a must-visit place in Caspokane to enjoy the cozy atmosphere created by small waterfalls, rose gardens and cafes. We will then return to Seattle/Vancouver.

Itinerary:

Missoula → Spokane → Manito Park (30 mins) → Seattle/Vancouver

Morning

Manito Park

Manito Park is THE place to see in Spokane! It is a public park located in beautiful Spokane Washington's South Hill neighborhood. Manito Park has five gardens, a conservatory and duck pond that are toured by over 150,000 visitors each year. The 90 acre park includes spacious manicured lawns, playgrounds, walking and biking paths, flowers, topiary shrubs, a greenhouse conservatory and multiple picturesque gardens. Manito Park's large trees and well tended landscaping make for a great place to visit in Spokane.
