BC ferry

Sail away on the BC Ferry! The BC Ferry is the main transportation that sails for about 1 hour and 30 minutes. Many people take the ferry to and from Vancouver and Victoria. The ferries were made in Germany and can accommodate up to about 400 cars, which is truly so amazing! The scenic beauty that the ferry provides is very amazing to look at! You can spot the surrounding island, seagulls flying around and if you're lucky enough, you can even see dolphins too.

The Butchart Gardens

Come and enjoy the beautiful Butchart Gardens! We promise, these gardens aren't like any other. They are truly one of the most magical and enchanting gardens that you will ever see in your life! The gardens receive over a million visitors each and every year. The gardens were constructed in 1904, and today is well-known as a National Historic Site. In Spring, countless tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths fill the gardens with different fragrances and vibrant colors. At the end of May, the rose garden will become the protagonist of the summer garden. The gardens even offer open stage and music performances in July and August! The garden even provides lovely fireworks show and views of its beautiful colorful water fountain.

Chinatown Victoria

The Chinatown in Victoria is the oldest Chinatown in Canada and the second oldest in North America after San Francisco's. Victoria's Chinatown is now surrounded by cultural, entertainment venues as well as being a venue in itself. All day

Today, you will start the free travel mode of Banff town, you can roam the town freely, walk into any boutique, you can find local souvenirs or delicious snacks, or participate in our carefully prepared various Activities at their own expense. Optional activities do not include transportation and tour guide services, and guests are responsible for their own transportation expenses. It is recommended to book activities before leaving the group.

Optional activities recommended:

- Stroll through the Cave and Basin National Historic Site (at your own expense), learn about the history of the birth of Banff National Park, and explore the process of changing historical sites. 13,000 years of history and humanistic complex have been deposited here, so you might as well calm down and feel its inner vigorous power.
- Enjoy a British-style afternoon tea (BSH afternoon Tea) in the world cultural heritage Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel (Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel), with the Bow Valley as the background, enjoying the food and scenery. (Experience time: about 1.5 hours)
- Don't take the usual way, check in Lake Minnewanka (Lake Minnewanka), the filming location of the Hollywood blockbuster "The Revenant", and take a Lake Minnewanka cruise to find the beautiful scenery in the promotional film of the Tourism Bureau; take #6 from the town of Banff Bus No. 1 goes to the boarding point for free. (Experience time: about 2-2.5 hours, of which about 1 hour by boat)
- . Participate in the Hoodoos Boat Tour on the Bow River, and the scenery is like a movie. (Activity time: about 1 hour)
- . Take a retro sightseeing car, start the legendary tour of Banff, and use a special form to start a journey with a sense of the times. (Activity time: about 1 hour)

Day 6

All day

We will head to visit Bow Lake. Along the way, you can overlook the Crowfoot Glacier. You can take a visit to the Num-Ti-Jah Inn and learn about the story of legendary of guide Jimmy Thompson. Following, we will head to the Peyto Lake. It is a maple-leaf-shaped lake, just like a blue ribbon inlaid in the Rocky Mountain valley. Then we will drive along No. 93 Icefield Avenue to Columbia Glacier. You may choose to take a snowmobile and experience the temperature of glacier aged over hundreds of years. You may also step on the 280-meter-high Skywalk to have a panoramic view of the Sunwapta Valley. Finally, we will go to Athabasca Falls with a drop of 23 meters. We will drive to the hotel in Jasper town to stay overnight.

Itinerary:

Banff \rightarrow **Crowfoot Glacier** (Pass-by) \rightarrow **Bow Lake** (30 mins) \rightarrow **Peyto Lake** (20 mins) \rightarrow **Icefields Avenue** (Pass-by) \rightarrow **Icefield Center Lunch** (Optional, 60 mins) \rightarrow **Icefield Snowmobile & Skywalk** (150 mins) \rightarrow **Athabasca Falls** (30 mins) \rightarrow **Jasper**

Special Note:

1. In the case of the closure of Peyto Lake due to force majeure factors such as maintenance and weather, etc. we will go to the Waterflow Lake instead.

Morning

Bow Lake

Bow Lake is located approximately 30 minutes north of Lake Louise and off the Icefields Parkway (Hwy 93) in the Canadian Rockies. It is half a mile north of the Crowfoot Glacier. It sits at an elevation of 1,920 m (6,300 ft) and is one of the largest lakes at the Banff National Park. It is fed by the meltwater from the Bow Glacier in the Wapta Icefield. Bow Lake is a wonderful place for a picnic and to enjoy scenic breathtaking views.

Peyto Lake

Peyto Lake is a popular sightseeing spot! It is a glacier-fed lake in Banff National Park in the Canadian Rockies. The lake itself is near the Icefields Parkway. During the summer, a significant amount of glacial rock flour flows into the lake from a nearby glacier. The suspended rock particles are what give the lake a unique bright, turquoise color. Due to its bright color, photos of the lake often appear in illustrated books.

Afternoon

Columbia Icefield

Columbia Icefield is what is left of a gigantic sheet of ice that covered and formed most of the landscape in the Rocky Mountains. The Ice field covers an area today of 325 square kilometers or 130 square miles and is such an amazing location to explore!

Athabasca Falls

Take a look and discover with us the true beauty of the Athabasca Falls. Discover all that it has to offer and take plenty of pictures for memories.

Day 7 Jasper National Park - Vehicle - Banff / Calgary

All day

Today, we will drive to the second largest glacial lake in the world Maligne Lake, and we will pass through the Medicine Lake along the way. You may take a lake cruise on the Maligne Lake at your own expense. Then, we will head to visit the longest and deepest in the Rocky Mountains-Maligne Canyon. After lunch, we will drive back to Calgary.

Itinerary:

Jasper → Medicine Lake (Pass-by) → Maligne Lake (90 mins, you can take a cruise at your own expense) → Maligne Canyon (30 mins) → Lunch (At your own expense, you can add a buffet at the Maligne Canyon Wilderness Restaurant, 60 mins) → Banff → Calgary

Special Note:

1. If the Maligne Lake Cruise is not open due to seasonal or weather reasons, the attraction will be replaced by Pyramid Lake and Patricia Lake.

Morning

Jasper National Park

Jasper National Park spans 4,200 square miles (10,878 square km) and contains significant active geologic processes, scenic mountains, along with diverse animal and plant populations. When Jasper was first protected as a forest park in 1907, it covered an area of approximately 5,000 square miles (12,950 square km). In 1930 it was declared a national

park with its present size. It was designated part of UNESCO's Canadian Rocky Mountain Parks World Heritage site in 1984.

Medicine Lake

Medicine Lake is located within Jasper National Park, Alberta, Canada. It is located approximately 20 km (12 mi) southeast of the townsite of Jasper, Alberta. Medicine Lake is approximately 7 km (4.3 mi) long and is a relatively shallow lake. The lake is part of the Maligne Valley watershed which is mainly glacial fed.

Maligne Lake

Maligne Lake is the largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies. Ringed by snow-and-ice-capped mountains, the 22 km long lake stretches past serene Spirit Island right to the melt-water channels of Coronet Glacier. An open forest of lodgepole pine and spruce, home of moose, Harlequin Ducks, and many other types of wildlife surround visitors at the north end of the lake.

Maligne Canyon

Maligne Canyon is the deepest canyon in Jasper National Park, with a depth of more than 50 metres at certain points. Follow us and discover the uniqueness of Maligne Canyon and all that it has to offer.
