It not only has the prosperity of a modern city, but also the atmosphere of ancient literature and art.

Night tour itinerary: Zurich Old Town (2 hours) → Lindenhof (1 hour) → Fraumünster Church (outside visit, 1 hour)

Afternoon

Zurich Old Town

This Zurich Old Town has the highest concentration of clubs in Switzerland and is easily one of the most famous shopping districts that demonstrates a plethora of cultural offerings. Zurich Old Town is a cultural, social, and historical melting pot and the perfect place for you to explore.

Lindenhof

Lindenhof is known as the scene of numerous historical events. This area continued to be a place for gatherings for Zurich's inhabitants right up to the beginning of the modern era. This spot provides a glorious view of the Old Town, Grossmünster Church, City Hall, the Limmat river, the university and the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology.

Fraumünster Church

This unique church was founded in 853 by King Louis the German. Its convent was inhabited by the female members of the aristocracy of Europe. The most stunning treasures are the stained-glass windows and the five-part cycle in the chancel and rosette in the southern transept the works by Marc Chagall.

The Cathedral of St.Gallen

Despite years of struggles during the stormy Reformation era, the current Cathedral of St. Gallen demonstrates the

most elegant and delightful works of art. The construction of the cathedral began in 1755 and the existing building is one of the last monumental Baroque buildings in all of Europe. A white interior is adorned with a green wedding cake ornamentation (stucco-work), rose marble altars and a gilded altar screen.

Liechtensteinisches Postal Museum

Liechtenstein's Postal Museum was founded in 1930 and was officially opened in 1936. The Postal Museum's collection includes every postage stamp issued by the Principality of Liechtenstein since 1912. These intricate aesthetic designs and sophisticated techniques are world-famous. In addition, the museum showcases designs, test prints and needle plates for you to discover. Visitors can also learn about the history of the country's postal service and admire machines used by postal workers in days gone by.

Chur

Switzerland's oldest city, Chur, charms all of its visitors with its fine mountain settings, twisting alleys and historical buildings. Numerous boutiques, restaurants, bars, museums, and galleries in the largely traffic-free Old Town create a Mediterranean-style atmosphere. Chur awaits for you to explore its true beauty.

Titlis

Of all the highlights in Central Switzerland, TITLIS is the big one - and the only glacier in the entire region that is actually accessible. So come and enjoy the breathtaking panorama of snow-capped mountaintops and untouched Alpine

landscapes. At 3,062 metres, the summit offers not only a breathtaking 360° panorama of the wide Engelberg valley but also a view straight down into the abyss, with countless crevasses carved into the glacial ice.

Chapel Bridge and Water Tower

Lucerne's landmark is considered to be Europe's oldest covered bridge! It was built in 1332 and was originally a part of the city fortifications. The pictorial panels, which were incorporated in the 17th century contain scenes of the Swiss and Lucerne's amazing history. This includes the biographies of the city's patron saints, St. Leodegar and St. Maurice. Lucerne's water tower is a powerful and yet attractive construction that you must see!

Schwanenplatz

Schwanenplatz is situated on the right shore of Lake Lucerne/River Reuss next to the main highway bridge. It is a classical starting point for visits welcomed into the old downtown area. The square itself is quite busy, but as soon as you enter into the small streets of downtown Lucerne, you will be amazed with what this place has to offer!

Lion Monument

Lucerne's world-famous Lion Monument has been consistently impressing its visitors each and every year. The imposing stone lion, however, is more than "just" a monument. It can be seen as a commemoration, a work of art or a memorial. It is a powerful and proud landmark of the city of Lucerne.

Interlaken

Interlaken is a traditional resort town located in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of central Switzerland. Interlaken was built on a narrow stretch of valley, between the emerald-colored waters of Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. It has old timber houses and parklands on either side of the Aare River. It is also surrounded by mountains, forests, meadows, glaciers, and it even offers hiking and skiing trails available year-round!

Lungern

Lungern is a city in Obwalden, Switzerland. It has many popular attractions, including Alter Kirchturm Lungern, Brunig Park, Lungernersee, making it well worth a visit.

Sigriswil

Upon crossing the 340m long suspension bridge between Sigriswil and Aeschlen you will be easily amazed with the magnificent views. The views include the famous Bernese Oberland peaks, the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, as well as Lake Thun! The views even offered down the gorge will easily take your breath away!

Kleine Scheidegg

Kleine Scheidegg has long been one of Europe's top holiday attractions! This is also one of the points where the Jungfrau train begins and it marks a remarkable journey up to the Jungfrauoch-Top of Europe.

Jungfrau

The Jungfrau is one of the main summits of the Bernese Alps! It is located between the northern canton of Bern and about halfway between Interlaken and Fiesch. It is one of the most distinctive sights of the Swiss Alps and the Jungfrau is part of the Jungfrau-Aletsch area, which was declared a World Heritage Site in 2001.

or

Schilthorn

A cable car runs every half hour from Stechelberg in the Lauterbrunnen valley in four stages up to the summit. Once at the top, spectacular views of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau await you. The Schilthorn became a famous location as of 1969 by the famous James Bond film "On Her Majesty's Secret Service." The revolving restaurant at the summit, which rotates around its own axis once every 45 minutes, owes its current name "Piz Gloria" to the film production. Visitors may follow in James Bond's footsteps in the interactive Bond World exhibition or on the 007 Walk of Fame.

Old City of Bern

Old Town of Bern was entered onto the UNESCO's listing of World Heritage Sites in 1983. With its 6km of limestone buildings and medieval arcades, its Renaissance fountains with colorful figures offer amazing views! It even has a beautiful cathedral surrounded by picturesque rooftops of Bern! It is truly a gem of medieval architecture in Europe.

The 360-degree revolving restaurant on the top of the mountain is an excellent place to watch the scenery of the Alps. On a clear day, you can see the beauty of more than 200 peaks in the Alps. Among the mountains, the most famous is the Jungfrauoch. (Jungfrau) and the Mönch and Eiger around her are the most magnificent to see.
