Las Coloradas Pink Lake

Hidden away on the tip of Mexico's Yucatan Peninsula is a magical place full of color. These stunning cotton-candy pink lakes filled with salt are called Las Coloradas. The region is part of the Río Lagartos Biosphere Reserve, a protected wetlands area home to animals like flamingos, crocodiles, sea turtles, jaguars, and all kinds of sea birds. You may also have seen pictures of the breathtaking pink lakes, one of the most instagrammable spots in Mexico, through various social medias.

Cenote Hubiku

Cenote Hubiku is a popular cenote complex located between Valladolid and the Ek Balam ruins. The underground, semi open cenote has an opening in its roof where both natural lights and tree roots cascade towards its waters. At times, a small waterfalls cascades through the gap sending a spray of water down into the cenote. In fact, the Maya name Hubiku refers to its vast size and translates to "Iguanas Nest" or "the Great Lord".

After learning all about the dazzling ancient city, we will head to Cenote Ik-Kil as well as relaxing and feeling refreshed in the uniquely peaceful and beautiful environment.

Chichén Itzá

Chichén Itzá is a complex of Mayan ruins on Mexico's Yucatán Peninsula. A massive step pyramid, known as El Castillo or Temple of Kukulcan, dominates the ancient city, which thrived from around 600 A.D. to the 1200s. Graphic stone carvings survive at structures like the ball court, Temple of the Warriors and the Wall of the Skulls. Nightly sound-and-light shows illuminate the buildings' sophisticated geometry.

Cenote Ik-Kil

Ik Kil is a cenote outside Pisté in the Tinúm Municipality, Yucatán, Mexico. The cenote is open to the sky with the water level about 26 metres (85 ft) below ground level. There is a carved stairway that leads down to a swimming platform. Ik Kil was considered sacred by the Mayans who used the site as a location for human sacrifice to their rain god, Chaac.

Suytun cenote

Located outside the charming town of Valladolid in southeast Mexico, Suytun Cenote is a breathtaking natural sinkhole that attracts many travelers. The highlight is the middle platform of the cenote, which offers a stunning photo op, especially when rays of sunlight shine through the cave opening above. Just remember to bring a camera that can

handle the low light.

Travel tips

3. For guests planning to swim in the cenote, swimming suits, towels, and clothes for change should be prepared in advance.
4. For guests who booked optional X-parks, please be sure to arrive at the boarding point on time for the shuttle. Our staff will not be escorted. (relevant booking code: MC1XR, MC1XT, MC1XA)
5. Unlimited buffet with hundreds of delicious Mexican food is provided in XPLOR park. Water rafting activities may be highly energy-consuming, please attend based on your health condition. For shuttle back to hotel from Xplor park, please be sure to arrive at the boarding point at the parking area near front gate before 16:30. (relevant booking code: MC1XR)
6. For shuttle back to hotel from Xcaret park, please arrive at the boarding point at the parking area near front gate at 16:00. (relevant booking code: MC1XT)
7. For shuttle back to hotel from Xel-Ha park, please be sure to arrive at the boarding point at the front gate before 16:30. (relevant booking code: MC1XA)
8. English or Spanish driver or guide. Guide service will not be included.

Know Before You Book

1. Customer under 18 years old MUST be accompanied by at least one adult. A guardian traveling with children must provide proof of custody or notarized parental authorization for travel. In consideration of the guest safety, pregnant women are only allowed to join the tour if pregnant for 24 weeks or less by the end of the trip.
2. Please be sure to provide accurate and complete information upon booking. This includes name, gender, valid documents (passport, visa etc.), valid contact information (preferably a mobile phone), accurate flight information, tour location, etc., This helps to avoid any errors upon the reservation because errors affect travel. Any losses due to inaccurate or invalid information will be at your own cost and the company will not be held responsible.
3. Hotels have different room types, such as a King/Queen size beds or two double size twin beds. The maximum number of people who can legally stay in a room is 2 to 4 people. In addition, each hotel has a different method of charging the deposit, which requires the cooperation of the guests according to regulations. Please be noticed that most of the deposit collection and refund is handled by credit card. ALL AMERICA TRAVEL guarantee the number of rooms for guests but does not guarantee the specific room type and location. Hotel check-in time is usually after 15:00.
