**Karlovy Vary**

Karlovy Vary is the site of numerous hot springs (13 main springs, about 300 smaller springs, and the warm-water Teplá

River), and is the most visited spa town in the Czech Republic. The historic city centre with the spa cultural landscape is well preserved and is protected by law as an urban monument reservation. It is the largest spa complex in Europe. In 2021, the city became part of the transnational UNESCO World Heritage Site under the name "Great Spa Towns of Europe" because of its spas and architecture from the 18th through 20th centuries.

It is known as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe and the first city in the world to be designated as a World Cultural Heritage site.

#### Charles Bridge

Charles Bridge is a 14th century stone bridge linking the two sides of Prague. This magnificent structure is one of the city's finest attractions, is the main pedestrian route connecting the Old Town with the Lesser Town and Prague Castle. It is a uniquely designed bridge filled with musicians, painters, vendors and tourists.

#### Old Town Hall (Prague)

Old Town Hall is the capital of the Czech Republic and one of the most highlighted places to explore. It was established in 1338 as the seat of the Old Town administration. The oldest part of the complex consists of the southern wing. It contains a beautiful Gothic tower with a bay chapel and a unique astronomical clock known as the Orloj. Every hour between 9 am and 11 pm the Orloj has the twelve apostles appear.

### **The Astronomical Clock**

The Astronomical Clock is the great landmark of Old Town Square. Situated on the southern wall of Prague Town Hall, it is such a compelling sight that it has possibly become the most photographed landmark by tourists visiting the beautiful capital city of the Czech Republic. The clock is unusual in that, in addition to indicating the 24 hours of the day, the astronomical dial shows the position of the sun and the moon in the sky, along with other astronomical information.

### **Prague Castle**

A beauty of its own to discover is the Prague Castle! It is one of the largest coherent castle complexes in the world. It consists of a large-scale composition of palaces and ecclesiastical buildings of various architectural styles from the remains of Romanesque-style buildings in the 10th century through the Gothic modifications of the 14th century.

### **River Vltava River Cruise**

Take in unique views of Prague's historical center along the Vltava River. Enjoy the stunning panorama of Prague Castle among other amazing historical structures.

## **Day 4**

Today, we will leave Prague and drive to Cesky Krumlov, also known as CK Town, which was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1992. The S-shaped bend of the Vltava River divides the ancient city into three parts: the castle area, the downstream valley, and the old city area. Entering this beautiful medieval small town in Europe, time seems to have lingered in the 18th century. This town is full of medieval charm, with white walls, red tiles, and slate roads visible everywhere, making people intoxicated. Then we will drive to Linz to check in at the hotel.

### **Vienna State Opera**

The Vienna State Opera is one of the top opera addresses in the world, with first-class productions of the very highest caliber and a different program every day: around 50 operas and ballet works per season, danced by the Vienna State Ballet. The variety of the operatic program is unparalleled anywhere in the world.

### **Austrian Parliament Building**

The Austrian Parliament Building in Vienna is where the two houses of the Austrian Parliament conduct their sessions. The building is located on the Ringstraße boulevard in the first district Innere Stadt, near Hofburg Palace and the Palace of Justice. The Parliament Building is the site of important state ceremonies, most notably the swearing-in ceremony of the President of Austria and the state speech on National Day each October 26.

### **Wiener Rathaus**

Wiener Rathaus, or Vienna's City Hall, is the most important secular building in the neo-Gothic style in the city. City Hall was built between 1872 and 1883 and is a building of superlatives. The Arkadenhof of City Hall is one of the biggest inner courtyards in Europe with an area of 2,804 m<sup>2</sup>. The height of its tower is 97.9 m and has become a symbol of Vienna.

### **The golden Strauss memorial**

The musician Johann Strauss, who is known around the world as the "King of Waltz" is a significant figure for the Austrians. This statue is located in the city park and has become a symbol of Vienna. The statue is located in a white curved arch with an exquisite angel relief carved on it. On the inside of the arch, the golden Strauss is "playing" the violin. The statues are always crowded with tourists who come to pay their respects.

### **St. Stephen's Cathedral**

St. Stephen's Cathedral is the mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna and the seat of the Archbishop of Vienna, Christoph Cardinal Schönborn, OP. The current Romanesque and Gothic form of the cathedral today in the Stephansplatz. It was largely introduced by Duke Rudolf IV (1339–1365) and stands on the ruins of two earlier churches that were previously there. The most important religious church that you must visit in Vienna is St. Stephen's Cathedral.

### **Schönbrunn Palace**

Schönbrunn Palace is one of Europe's most beautiful Baroque complexes and has been in the possession of the Habsburgs since 1569. The wife of Emperor Ferdinand II, Eleonore von Gonzaga, had a pleasure palace built on the site in 1642 and called the property "Schönbrunn" for the first time. The palace and garden complex created from 1696 onwards following the siege of Vienna was complete redesigned under Maria Theresa after 1743. Today, due to its historical significance, its unique layout and magnificent furnishings, the palace is a UNESCO World Heritage site.

### Bratislava Castle

Bratislava Castle, the landmark overlooking the Capital, was built in the 9th century. As an age-long symbol of the city, it proudly stands on the hill above Danube river. Eleven kings and eight queens were crowned in Bratislava in the past. No wonder that the castle is a popular part of excursions through the city.

### Suspension bridge

On the beautiful Danube River in Bratislava lies a double-layered highway bridge that spans both banks and connects the old and new urban areas together. This is the famous local new bridge spot where tourists visit. Compared with various historical monuments, the new bridge is very young and modern, forming a unique landscape of the old city. There is also the "flying saucer" bridge that spans the north and south of the Danube.

### St. Martin's Cathedral

The St Martin's Cathedral is a church in Bratislava, Slovakia, and the cathedral of the Catholic Archdiocese of Bratislava.



It is situated at the western border of the historical city center below Bratislava Castle. It is the largest and one of the oldest churches in Bratislava, known especially for being the coronation church of the Kingdom of Hungary between 1563 and 1830.

### **Main Square, Bratislava**

The central point in old town Bratislava, the Main Square, has been the hub of the town for centuries. It is surrounded by landmarks, including Kutscherfeldov Palace, Pawera House, Ungerov Dom, and the Maximillian Fountain. Additionally, tons of restaurants, cafes, and bars in the area keep it bustling.

### **Szentendre**

Szentendre is a riverside town in Pest County, Hungary, between the capital city Budapest and Pilis-Visegrád Mountains. The town is known for its museums (most notably the Open-Air Ethnographic Museum), galleries, and artists. Due to its historic architecture along with easy accessibility via rail and river, it has become a destination for tourists staying in Budapest. There are many facilities, including souvenir shops and restaurants, catering to these visitors.

### **Heroes' Square**

Welcome to Budapest's Heroes' Square! It houses one of the city's iconic symbols, the Millennium Memorial, which includes the seven chieftains of the Magyar tribes that founded Hungary and other important heads of state. In between the statues is a large column crowned by Archangel Gabriel.

### **Budapest City Park**

#### **Hungarian Parliament Building**

The Hungarian Parliament Building, also known as the Parliament of Budapest after its location, is the seat of the National Assembly of Hungary, a notable landmark of Hungary, and a popular tourist destination in Budapest. It is situated on Kossuth Square in the Pest side of the city, on the eastern bank of the Danube. It was designed by Hungarian architect Imre Steindl in neo-Gothic style and opened in 1902. It has been the largest building in Hungary since its completion.

#### **St. Stephen's Basilica**

St. Stephen's Basilica is a Roman Catholic basilica in Budapest, Hungary. It is named in honour of Stephen, the first King of Hungary. Since the renaming of the primatial see, it has been the co-cathedral of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Esztergom-Budapest. Today, it is the third largest church building in present-day Hungary. It is the largest church in Budapest and a World Heritage Site.

#### **Danube River Cruise**

#### **Fisherman's Bastion**

Fisherman's Bastion in Budapest is easily one of the top Budapest attractions. The present-day lovely lookout towers and decorative fortification of the Fisherman's Bastion was built in the 19th century. It serves as a lookout tower for the best panoramic views in Budapest, Hungary.

### **Hallstatt**

Hallstatt is one of the most enchanting places you will visit! Hallstatt is a fairy-tale-like town sprinkled with pastel-colored houses and winding cobblestone streets. It is surrounded by the striking Northern Limestone Alps. The natural beauty and picturesque views that it portrays attracts visitors to the tiny town year after year.

### **Salzburg**

Salzburg's historic center (German: Altstadt) is renowned for its Baroque architecture and is one of the best-preserved city centers north of the Alps. The historic center was enlisted as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996. The city has three universities and a large population of students. Salzburg is a popular tourist destination for its rich musical history as it's the birthplace of 18th century composer Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart who was born there on 27 January 1756. Tourists also visit Salzburg to tour the historic center and the scenic Alpine surroundings. It is also the setting of the musical later turned film Sound of Music.

Marienplatz is a central square in the city centre of Munich, Germany. It has been the city's main square since 1158. Today the Marienplatz is dominated by the New City Hall (Neues Rathaus) on the north side, and the Old City Hall (Altes Rathaus, a reconstructed gothic council hall with a ballroom and tower) on the east side.

### **New Town Hall (Munich)**

The New Town Hall of Munich is located at Marienplatz. It is a tall and majestic brown-black Gothic-style building. The vertical lines make it more solemn. The front of the town hall is decorated with statues of Bavarian kings, legendary heroes and saints.

The Frauenkirche is a church in Nuremberg, Germany. It stands on the eastern side of the main market. An example of brick Gothic architecture, it was built on the initiative of Charles IV, Holy Roman Emperor between 1352 and 1362.
