When completed in 1859, it was the largest and most accurate clock in the world.

Westminster Abbey

Westminster Abbey is a large, mainly Gothic abbey church in the City of Westminster. It is one of the United Kingdom's most notable religious buildings and the traditional place of coronation and a burial site for English and later British monarchs. Sixteen royal weddings have occurred at the Abbey since 1100.

Parliament Square

Parliament Square in Westminster is located right next to Westminster Abbey and the Houses of Parliament. The square was created in the 1860s and contains statues of well-known statesmen including Winston Churchill, Abraham Lincoln, and Nelson Mandela.

However, you can head to 10 Adam Street, only 800 meters (2,624 ft) away, where you can find a very similar door, now a hotspot, for tourists wanting to take a souvenir photo.

The British Museum
