Seattle takes the ferry go to Bainbridge (45 mins) \rightarrow Olympic National Park \rightarrow Hurricane Ridge (75 mins) \rightarrow Lake Crescent (30 mins) \rightarrow Marymere Falls (45 mins) \rightarrow Bainbridge takes the ferry back to Seattle (45 mins)

Special Note:

Hurricane Ridge will be closed from 10/16/2023. In case of closure of Hurricane Ridge or other irresistible factors (such as heavy rain, mudslides and other extreme weather), the itinerary will be changed to Ediz Hook (30 mins) \rightarrow East Beach (30 mins).

Olympic National Park Olympic National Park is a United States national park located in the state of Washington, of the Olympic Peninsula. The park has four basic regions: the Pacific coastline, alpine areas, the west side temperate rainforest and the forests of the drier east side. U.S. President Theodore Roosevelt originally created Mount Olympus National Monument. The Olympic Peninsula has 73 miles of coastline, keeps the original view since ice age. With a low land of rainforest in its west, a magnificent Olympic Mountains in central, and few locations here can be visited by automobile makes it the paradise for hiking. Isolated from the mainland, many of its vegetation and animals can only be found here. The Olympic National Park locates in Olympic Peninsula is one of the most highly visited National Parks along the west coast.

Hurricane Ridge

Located within Washington's Olympic National Park, this mountainous region is a popular destination for hiking, skiing and snowboarding. In the summer, several picnic areas open up, making this a great spot for a day-trip from nearby Seattle.

Ediz Hook

Ediz Hook is a long, thin peninsula that juts out from the Port Angeles Harbor. The vast open view of the hook

showcases the blue and green colors of the Olympic Mountains and also gives a faint view of Canada from across the

water. Other than the group of stray community cats that roam the area, you are more than likely to find seals and

peeks of orcas in the distance. Additionally, there is an abundance of different types of birds. At the very end of Ediz

Hook there is a U.S. Coast Guard Station responsible for search and rescue, homeland security, and environmental

maintenance.

East Beach

The aptly-named East Beach is tucked away on Lake Crescent's northeastern end, less than one mile from Highway 101.

Its convenient location makes it a popular spot, and this place fills up fast during the warm summer months. East Beach

stretches from Stearns Wharf to the City limits just past the Clark Estate, on the eastern end of the four-mile stretch of

City beach parks. East Beach offers picnic facilities, more than a dozen volleyball courts, a playground, and beautiful

ocean views.

Lake Crescent

This deep lake in the heart of Olympic National Park holds water that is a brilliant hue of bright blue. It was formed

during the last Ice Age by thousands of years of glacial activity.

Marymere Falls

Marymere Falls is located in Olympic National Park near Lake Crescent in Washington, United States. The falls are

accessed by a one-mile, well-maintained, dirt trail through old-growth lowland forest consisting of fir, cedar, hemlock,

and alder trees. Falls creek descends from Aurora Ridge and tumbles over Marymere Falls and then flows into Barnes

Creek. It has a height of 90 feet (27 m). The falls is one of the more popular attractions in the area, due to ease of

access and proximity to U.S. Highway 101.

Snoqualmie Falls

The Snoqualmie Falls waterfall is located in Washington State. It is seen along the river of the same name. The falls and the town gained international recognition when they were used as filming locations for the hit show "Twin Peaks."

These falls are breathtaking and definitely worth the visit!

Afternoon

Leavenworth

Explore the German village 2.5 hours northwest from Seattle, the most popular town in this area where people celebrates all the time. You can see nice maple leaves here in falls. Leavenworth, the townsite was across the Wenatchee River from Icicle and was named Leavenworth the same year the rail construction began. Captain Charles Leavenworth, president of the Okanogan Investment Company, purchased the land in the present-day downtown and laid the streets parallel to the new railroad tracks. The railroad construction was completed during the winter of 1893. Lafayette Lamb and his brother, Chancery Lamb arrived in 1903 from Iowa to build the second largest sawmill in Washington state in winter the town is covered by white snow and holiday decorations. Lovely atmosphere can be found here all year round. Enjoy shopping for delicate European souvenirs and the famous German food and beer, or try on traditional German clothes.

Gas Works Park

On the northern shore of Lake Union formerly known as Brown's Point, Gas Works Park stands as a re-imagining of a former gasification plant into an iconic park for the city of Seattle. This unique project is perhaps one of the first examples of the conversion of a post-industrial landscape into a public park. Gas Works Park has a play area with a large play barn, and big hill popular for flying kites. Special park features include a sundial, and a beautiful view of Seattle.

Pike Place Market

One of the oldest farmers' markets in the United States, the Pike Place Market first opened in 1909-- more than 100 years ago. The still-thriving market overlooking Elliot Bay sees more than 10 million visitors every year.

Sky View Observatory at Columbia Center

Sky View Observatory at Columbia Center is one of Seattle's newest and most remarkable landmarks! Take the elevator up to the sightseeing floor and enjoy a full 360-degree panoramic view of downtown Seattle! Here you can sight the Ferris Wheel, Puget Sound, Space Needle, Microsoft, Mt.
