Important Information

Kenya requires all foreign nationals entering Kenya to apply for an electronic entry visa in advance, and a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required to enter Kenya through countries in the Middle East and Africa and Tanzania (except for those over 60 years old due to health reasons).

Safe travel instructions

- * Smoking and photography are prohibited in airports and public places. Violation may result in fines.
- * In case of traffic jam and road congestion, please close your doors and windows. Be careful with your valuables.
- * Please fasten your seat belt when you ride in the car. Please take your valuables with you when you get off at the hotel.
- * Please contact the front desk in time if you find any problems with the room. Please take cash and valuables with you.
- * Please do not touch or feed wild animals when visiting the scenic area or in the hotel.
- * Kenya is like spring all year round, the temperature is 19-29 degrees during the day, you can bring spring and summer clothes, please be prepared for mosquito and ultraviolet protection throughout the trip, and please be prepared for cold and heat protection when the temperature difference between day and night in East Africa is large
- * The tap water in the hotel is not allowed to drink directly. Please choose bottled water.
- * Travel with sunscreen and some insect repellent.
- * The voltage in Kenya is 220/240 volts, 50 Hz. The socket is a British three-eye square plug, all stipulate that a triangular inch plug and a three-pin socket should be used, it is recommended to buy an adapter before traveling.
- * Toilets are scarce. On the way, we will arrange some roadside shops to stop. Toilet use is free. However, the goods in roadside shops are generally more expensive and are not recommended to buy. If you are not interested, it is not recommended to bargain.
- * When staying in national parks and wilderness hotels. 24-hour hot water and electricity are not guaranteed. Please find out the details upon arrival.
- * During the trip, please abide by the local laws and respect the local people, and do not make any insulting words and actions. Some people in Kenya believe that cameras take their souls, so taking pictures requires their consent.
- * Tipping is seen locally as an act of kindness. If someone gives you some good service, set a standard for tipping, about \$1. The Kenyan currency is the shilling (KES), which is approximately 100 Kenyan shillings to 1 US dollar (subject to exchange rates).
- * For environmental reasons, local hotels cannot guarantee disposable supplies. Please prepare by yourself.

* Please pack some common cold medicine, gastrointestinal medicine, anti-mosquito medicine and emergency medical supplies in your bag in case of emergency. If you need to take designated drugs for a long time, it is advisable to prepare sufficient amounts and doctor's prescriptions before departure, and truthfully inform the tour leader of the condition and emergency measures to maintain optimal health. Liquid medication must be carried with you with a doctor's prescription, otherwise you must check it in.

Special Reminder

Kenya requires all foreigners entering Kenya to apply Kenya e-visa in advance. Entry into Kenya and Tanzania through countries in the Middle East and Africa requires a yellow fever vaccination certificate (except for those over 60 years old due to physical health reasons)).
