Itinerary:

Washington D.C. → Luray Caverns (Optional, 120 mins) → Skyline Drive in Shenandoah National Park (120 mins) → Washington D.C.

Special notes:

- 1. Due to the Skyline Drive located across Shenandoah National Park, we enter from Thornton Gap and drive to north exit, this is a one-way tour and lasts 120 mins.
- 2. On the winding driveway on the mountains, we will stop at the overlooks to observe the beautiful Shenandoah Valley.
- 3. We will also take an easy walk on one of the trails among the mountains. Total 45 for this trail (round trip). If the weather is extreme, the tour leader will cancel the trail trip, and add other stops properly.
- 4. During the period from 10/11/2023 to 11/11/2023, along the Skyline Highway, you will enjoy the poetic and colorful autumn scenery of Shenandoah National Park during the journey.
- 5. If the weather is extreme, we cannot enter into the National Park.

Niagara Falls

The Horseshoe Falls, the American Falls, and the Bridal Veil Falls are all part of the Niagara Falls. The combined falls form the highest flow rate of any waterfall in North America, and it has a vertical drop of more than 50 meters (160 ft). During peak time tourist hours, more than 168,000 m3 (six million cubic feet) of water go over the crest of the falls every minute.

Niagara Whirlpool State Park

The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated that the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by an upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by the Niagara River.

Cave of the Winds

The Cave of the Winds on the New York side of Niagara Falls is an attraction, which allows sightseers to walk right up to the base of the Bridal Veil Falls with water crashing right down on them and flowing beneath the decking!

Maid of The Mist

It's the combination of height and volume that makes the Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water lays over the crest line of the falls every minute during daytime peak tourist hours. And the famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

The Pentagon is the headquarters building of the United States Department of Defense. Located in Arlington County, Virginia, across the Potomac River from Washington, D.C., the building was designed by American architect George Bergstrom and built by contractor John McShain. The Pentagon is the world's largest office building, containing five sides and five floors above ground-level, two basement levels, and five ring corridors per floor. The Pentagon is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is a National Historic Landmark.

911 Memorial Museum

Through commemoration, exhibitions and educational programs, The National September 11 Memorial & Museum Organization remembers and honors the 2,983 people killed in the horrific attacks of September 11, 2001, and on the February 26, 1993, bombing; of all those people who risked their lives to save others and those who demonstrated extraordinary compassion in the aftermath of the attacks.

George Washington's Mount Vernon

Mount Vernon is the former home of George Washington. George Washington was a revolutionary war hero, Founding Father, and the first president of the United States. His former estate has been turned into a museum that examines his unique life. Take a look at it with us today to see what makes this place so unique.

U.S. Capitol
