Acadia National Park protects the natural beauty of the highest rocky headlands along the Atlantic coastline of the

United States, an abundance of habitats, and a rich cultural heritage. At 3.5 million visits a year, it's one of the top 10

most-visited national parks in the United States. Visitors enjoy 27 miles of historic motor roads, 158 miles of hiking

trails, and 45 miles of carriage roads.

Cadillac Mountain

The Cadillac Mountain is formed millions of years ago through the formation of crustal movement and cooling pink

granite. Along the way we can enjoy a very nice view of Eagle Lake, then we reach up the summit, we can see up to 60

islands scattered in the spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean, we are really feeling Maine father, mother earth and

ocean romance darling generated.

Thunder Hole

As one of Maine's most awe-inspiring natural wonders, Thunder Hole is carved naturally out of the coastal rocks,

battered by waves for centuries. The combination of the waves hitting the rocks and the release of air from the cavern

cause a thunderous boom to happen. No trip to Acadia National Park is complete without visiting it. Thunder Hole is a

quintessentially Maine landmark that offers more than just the trademark thunder; there are stunning views in every

direction from the high rocks surrounding this historical inlet.

One World Trade Center Observatory

One World Trade Center is the main building of the rebuilt World Trade Center complex in Lower Manhattan, New York City. It is the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere. There, 102 stories up, you will find yourself face-to-face with New York's iconic skyline. Maybe you've seen views of the city before, but never quite like this one. Walk the three sprawling levels of the Observatory and discover many surprises along the way.

Liberty Cruise

Any trip to New York City must include a boat cruise around the Statue of Liberty. This iconic landmark has stood in the city that never sleeps for more than 100 years, built initially as a joint effort between the United States and France to celebrate the anniversary of America's independence. You will ride on this amazing sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a totally different angle.

Museum of Modern Art

Since its dedication in 1982, visitors have brought offerings to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial to honor and remember those who served in the Vietnam War.

Niagara Falls to Boston: approximately 470 miles

Niagara Whirlpool State Park

The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated that the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by an upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by the Niagara River.

Cave of the Winds

The Cave of the Winds on the New York side of Niagara Falls is an attraction, which allows sightseers to walk right up to the base of the Bridal Veil Falls with water crashing right down on them and flowing beneath the decking!

Maid of The Mist

It's the combination of height and volume that makes the Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water lays over the crest line of the falls every minute during daytime peak tourist hours. And the famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

Old Fort Niagara State Park

Old Fort Niagara is a rich historical landmark. It spans more than 300 years and its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in several major wars: The French and Indian War, the American Revolution War, and the War of 1812. In addition, the gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.
