Day 1

Day 2

Santiago Half-day City Tour

All day

After breakfast at the hotel, follow our professional tour guide to take a half-day tour in San Diego! First, we will head downtown to visit the Plaza de Armas and its surrounding communities and get a better understanding of the history of the city. Then follow us to picturesque Cerro Santa Lucia, where you can have a panoramic view of the entire city from the mountain top. Along the way, you'll see ancient churches and monasteries and hear some stories about the city's colonial history.

Plaza de Armas de Santiago

The Plaza de Armas de Santiago is considered the heart of the capital of Chile, marking the milestone known as Kilometer Zero, from which the distance between the different cities of the country begins to be measured. In its surroundings not only emblematic buildings converge, symbols of the origin of the city and witnesses of its development of more than four centuries, but also characteristic characters that fill this space with life. The plaza was laid out by the architect Pedro de Gamboa. The Municipality, the Central Post Office, the National Historical Museum

and the Metropolitan Cathedral were installed around it. Since its establishment it has been the social heart of Santiago, without ever losing its status as the center of citizen life and undisputed heritage and tourist icon of the capital.

Cerro Santa Lucia

Cerro Santa Lucía is one of the most visited public green areas in the capital. It is a silent witness of the growth of the city of Santiago since the Spanish conquerors arrived in the Mapocho Valley on December 13, 1540. You can find an original Spanish coat of arms, a mythical bell that used to belong to the Church of the Company of Jesus, a museum, telescopes, swings and a beautiful merry-go-round here. Streetlights, statues, fountains and vases were brought from Europe to ornament and embellish the place.

Day 3

Viña del Mar & Valparaíso 1 Day Tour

Viña del Mar is known as the "Garden City" because it was originally surrounded by large green areas and now retains vast and beautiful urban gardens. Also known as the "Gem of the Pacific," the city is the headquarters of the country's legislative branch and home to the Chilean Navy. You will see various historic buildings and the famous Flower Clock. The port and bay are also not to be missed! At noon, you can choose to have a lunch at a local restaurant and taste delicious seafood. Before arriving at Valparaíso, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, we will drive along the seaside and enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Pacific coast. You'll visit Cerro Alegre, where you can appreciate what this city has to offer - its lovely cable cars, colorful neighborhoods and unforgettable sea views.

Fonck Museum

The Fonck Museum was created on November 25, 1937. Its name recalls the German doctor and philanthropist settled in Chile, Dr. Francisco Fonck Foveaux, in recognition of his work and research in the field of archaeology. The mission of the Museum of Vina del Mar is to deliver a summary of the Chilean Prehistory, Ethnography and Natural History. It highlights the Easter Island exhibition and has exhibitions of Native Peoples of Continental Chile and part of South

America. It has a sample of Natural History that includes fauna of Chile and insects of the national territory.

Valparaíso

Valparaíso is a city located 120 kilometers west of Santiago. It is the nation's main port, the capital of the fifth state, and the legislative seat of the state. Densely populated hills and ancient elevators are known. Highlights include the National Assembly, Prat Pier, Artillery Elevator, Sotomayor Square, 21st May Avenue, the Pablo Neruda Museum Casa "Sebastián" and the Arturo Prat Naval Museum.

Day 4

Today we will transfer you to Arturo Merino Benitez International Airport (SCL), where you will take a flight to Pres Ibanez Airport (PUQ). **Air ticket will be at your own expense. There will be no tour guide on the plane.**

Day 5

Puerto Natales - Vehicle - **Cueva del Milodón** - Vehicle - **Torres del Paine National Park** - Vehicle - **Puerto Natales**

All day

Today's tour begins with destination to the Cueva del Milodón located 24 kilometers north of Puerto Natales. Before reaching the cave, the access road passes through the "Silla del Diablo", a name that comes from popular imagination given to a rocky structure with the appearance of an armchair which is said to have been the "seat" of Milodon and that the legend transformed into "devil". Then we will continue along the new access road to the Torres del Paine National Park, being able to observe lagoons and mountain ranges along the way. Next, it is possible to admire the beautiful landscape that surrounds us from the Gray Lake Viewpoint (view of the Gray Glacier, the Paine Massif and the Toro Lake). A couple of kilometers further on it is possible to see the Cuernos del Paine, reaching the fork that takes us to the Lake Gray area. In this sector we can take a pleasant walk along the shore of Lake Gray and if the conditions help us, it

is possible to access the viewpoint of the Gray Peninsula. Back in the parking lot of the Nursery, we resume the route to take a moment of rest with the option of having lunch. At the end of this restful rest, we begin the second stage of our visit to the Torres del Paine National Park, heading to the Salto Grande sector. We will visit the Nordenskjöld Lake Viewpoint and continue enjoying various views on our undulating route that gradually brings us closer to the Laguna Amarga sector. After admiring this pleasant spectacle, we will return to the city of Puerto Natales passing through the Sarmiento Lake Viewpoint, arriving in the late afternoon and bringing with it an unforgettable experience.

Puerto Natales → Cueva del Milodón (ticket included) → In-depth tour of Torres del Paine National Park (ticket and lunch fee included) → Puerto Natales

Torres del Paine National Park

Torres del Paine National Park is located in southern Chile and has been selected as one of the "50 Places You Must Visit in a Lifetime" by National Geographic magazine. The main attractions in the park include Torres del Paine, Torres del Paine, Nordenskjöld Glacier Lake, etc., as well as Lago Gray and Glacier Grey. Torres del Paine National Park is located in the transition zone between the Magellanic subpolar forest and the Patagonian steppes, so it has a very high level of biodiversity. The park contains more than two hundred species of plants and contains four vegetation zones: Patagonian Steppe, Pre-Andean Shrubland, Magellanic Forest and Andean Desert. Additionally, the park is known for protecting wildlife species.
