## Tour introduction

### Day 1

**Chicago - Vehicle - Indianapolis - Vehicle - London, KY**

All day

Today we will set out from Chicago. At noon, we will visit the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum where there are collections of almost all kinds of race cars from 1909. Following, we will take a quick visit to Indiana Statehouse. Then, we will stay overnight in London, KY.

#### Itinerary:

**Chicago → Indianapolis → Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum (Optional, 60 mins) → Indiana Statehouse (30 mins) → Hotel**

#### **Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum**

The Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum is an automotive museum on the grounds of the Indianapolis Motor Speedway in Speedway, Indiana, United States, which houses the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Hall of Fame. It is intrinsically linked to the Indianapolis 500 and Brickyard 400, but it also includes exhibits reflecting other forms of motorsports, passenger cars, and general automotive history. In 2006, it celebrated its 50th anniversary. The museum foundation possesses several former Indianapolis 500-winning cars, and they are regularly rotated onto the display floor exhibits.

#### **Indiana Statehouse**

The Indiana Statehouse is the Indiana State Capitol building of the U.S. state of Indiana. It is located in the state capital Indianapolis at 200 West Washington Street. The building houses the Indiana General Assembly, the office of the Governor of Indiana, the Supreme Court of Indiana, and other state officials. It was Built in 1888, and is the fifth building to house the state government.

### Day 2

**London, KY - Vehicle - Great Smoky Mountain Park - Vehicle - Knoxville**

All day

In the morning, we will leave London for the Great Smoky Mountains in Tennessee. Many kinds of animals inhabit here,

and there are about 1,500 species of bears alone. So it will be a great opportunity to see the wild bears! Then follow us and take a visit Gatlinburg. You may take the cable car to the mountain top. Following, we will go to Pigeon Forge, where you can visit the Titanic Museum built to commemorate the sinking of the "Titanic" at your own expense.

#### **Great Smoky Mountain National Park In-depth Tour**

Great Smoky Mountains here we come! It offers a spectacular view and fresh air of the mountains! Besides, open areas in the park offer some best opportunities to see wildlife, for example black bear, elk, white-tail deer, as well as kinds of wildflowers!

#### **Gatlinburg**

Gatlinburg is a city known for its charm and beauty, and winter is no exception. From magical holiday traditions to pristine skiing slopes, Gatlinburg offers plenty of ways to delight in the season's best activities. Discover the best of Gatlinburg's inspiring landscapes and small-town allures when the temperatures drop.

#### **Titanic Museum Pigeon Forge**

Let's drive to Pigeon Forge where we will visit the Titanic Museum Attraction to sail the seas in 1912! You will get a feel for what the passengers deluxe hallways looked like and learn about the statistics about the ship. As you enter, you will be given a passenger boarding ticket. On this ticket, is the name of an actual Titanic passenger and the class they were traveling. You will learn the individual stories of several passengers. In the Titanic Memorial Room, find out whether your ticketed passenger survived.

### **Day 3**

#### **Knoxville - Vehicle - Lookout Mountain**

All day

After breakfast, we will head to Chattanooga and explore the magnificent Lookout Mountain and Ruby Falls which is a 145-foot-high underground waterfall located within Lookout Mountain. Following, we will take a visit to Rock City.

Finally, we'll take the Lookout Mountain Incline Railway.

**Itinerary:**

**Knoxville → Lookout Mountain → Ruby Fall (Optional, 90 mins) → Rock City (Optional, 75 mins) → Lookout Mountain Incline Railway (Optional, 75 mins) → Hotel**

Morning

**Ruby Falls**

A breathtaking 145-foot underground waterfall is a natural wonder. It is located over 1,120 feet below the surface of Lookout Mountain. It is fed by rainwater and underground springs and the water from the falls eventually flows into the Tennessee River.

**Rock city**

On the top of the Rock City, it is said seven neighboring states might be seen from Lover's Leap - you can find out whether it is true or not. However, we are sure you will be amazed by the breathtaking panoramic views of the natural landscape, massive ancient rock formations, and gardens with over 400 native plant species.

**Incline Railway**

This historic hilltop on the southern border of Tennessee has a colorful history as a place of importance during wartime. Most notably, it was the centerpiece of the Battle of Lookout Mountain during the American Civil War. This team has been running almost continually since 1895 and except for an engine update in 1911, it hasn't changed very much in more than 100 years of operation. The ride stretches about one mile up the mountain and the incline reaches a breathtaking 72.7% grade – almost straight up! Enjoy the “America’s Most Amazing Mile“ aboard!

**Day 4**

**Mammoth Cave National Park - Vehicle - Chicago**

All day

Today, you will head to visit Mammoth Cave National Park at your own expense. The first human to enter Mammoth Cave passed under its imposing arch about 4,000 years ago. Now, you can explore the winding caverns for yourself. Then, we will go back to Chicago.

## **Day 5**

### **Chicago City Tour**

All day

Experience the best of Chicago all in one day! This is ranked as one of the world's best architecture city with fascinating architecture to discover. You will take a walk in Millennium Park, observe the Cloud Gate, and enjoy the spectacular view of the city from 360 Chicago!

#### **Itinerary:**

**Millennium Park & Cloud Gate** (20 mins) → **Grant Park** (10 mins) → **The Art Institute of Chicago** (Optional, 120 mins) → **Chicago Water Tower** (10 mins) → **Michigan Avenue** (pass by) → **Chicago Cruise** (Optional, 90 mins, seasonal) → **360 Chicago** (Optional, 75 mins)

We will pass by Navy Pier, Clarence Buckingham Memorial Fountain, Marina City, Trump International Hotel and Tower and Willis Tower Observation Deck.

Morning

#### **Millennium Park**

Three square blocks of open lakefront complete with a Ferris Wheel, outdoor music pavilion and ice skating rink. This is one of the city's most popular sites.

#### **Grant Park**

Grant Park is a large urban park in the city's central business district. It was renamed in 1901 to honor US President Ulysses S. Grant. The park contains performance venues, gardens, artworks, sporting, and harbor facilities. It hosts

public gatherings and several large annual events and is popularly referred to as "Chicago's front yard".

### **The Art Institute of Chicago**

The Art Institute is the 2nd-largest art museum in the US after the Met in New York. It houses pieces by renowned painters such as Van Gogh, Monet, and Cezanne, as well as an extensive collection of African American art.

### **Chicago Architectural Cruise**

The Architectural Cruise of Chicago is a perfect way to view one of America's most formidable cities, all from the comfort of a boat leisurely sailing down the Chicago River, either during the day or at twilight.

### **360 Chicago**

This observation deck sits atop the John Hancock Tower in Chicago, providing exquisite aerial views of the city's skyline that you can't get anywhere else. The new LIFT feature extends out above the city below for an exhilarating experience.
