**Escanaba → Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore In-depth Tour** (Mandatory, Include: Miner's Castle (35 mins) + Miner's

Beach (35 mins) + Tahquamenon Falls (90 mins) ) → **Point Iroquois Lighthouse** (30 mins) → **Soo Lock** (30 mins) → **St. Ignace**

Morning

### **Miner's Castle**

Welcome to Miner's Castle! The Castle is the place we can see unique rock formation and colorful cliffs standing by the translucent blue water of Lake Superior. Make sure to capture a picture or two!

### **Miner's Beach**

Miners Beach is just up the shore from Miners Castle – which tends to be more of an attraction than a beach. It even offers a spectacular view of Pictured Rocks to the East. The road is paved almost right down to the beach, with a spacious parking area, camping sites with fire pits, and even has a stairway down to the beach.

### **Tahquamenon Falls**

The Tahquamenon Falls and Lower Falls are two of the most famous falls, that are also called Amber Twin Falls. These two falls are colorful falls where water flows down under the beautiful sunshine!

### **Point Iroquois Lighthouse**

We will quickly be stopping by the beautiful Point Iroquois Lighthouse! It is a historic lighthouse where you can overlook Lake Superior connecting to Lake Huron.

### **Soo Locks**

The Soo Locks are a set of parallel locks, operated and maintained by the United States Army Corps of Engineers. It enables ships to travel between Lake Superior and the lower Great Lakes. They are located on the St. Mary's River between Lake Superior and Lake Huron and even between the Upper Peninsula of the U.S. state of Michigan and the Canadian province of Ontario.

## Day 3

Mackinac Island, just off Michigan's shoreline, is only accessible by ferry or plane. There is a unique local law that prohibits the use of motor vehicles. Be ready to either walk, bike, or horseback ride through this amazing island!

Afternoon

### Traverse City

Nestled in the pinky of the Lower Peninsula mitten, Traverse City is surrounded by the waters of Lake Michigan. We enjoy four distinct seasons of outdoor adventures with beaches, ski resorts, and hundreds of miles of trails to explore, as well as unique indoor experiences like restored theaters, award-winning wineries, and extensive shopping and dining.

## Day 4

**Holland - Vehicle - Chicago**

### **Holland**

Holland is a city famous for its Dutch heritage. In the 19th century, a group of Dutch immigrants settled down here.

### **Windmill Island**

Windmill Island has the world-famous “De Zwaan” (the swan), an authentic windmill (shipped from the Netherlands) and has over approximately 250 years’ worth of history. We will have plenty of time to walk around the beautiful gardens located on the island.

### **Gilmore Car Museum**

Gilmore Car Museum has the state’s largest collections of classic and vintage automobiles. At the museum, you will have the chance to appreciate the car collections produced from various periods dated between 1890 and 1960.

#### **Itinerary:**

**Millennium Park & Cloud Gate** (20 mins) → **Grant Park** (10 mins) → **The Art Institute of Chicago** (Optional, 120 mins) → **Chicago Water Tower** (10 mins) → **Michigan Avenue** (pass by) → **Chicago Cruise** (Optional, 90 mins, seasonal) → **360 Chicago** (Optional, 75 mins)

We will pass by Navy Pier, Clarence Buckingham Memorial Fountain, Marina City, Trump International Hotel and Tower and Willis Tower Observation Deck.

Morning

### **Millennium Park**

Three square blocks of open lakefront complete with a Ferris Wheel, outdoor music pavilion and ice skating rink. This is one of the city's most popular sites.

### Grant Park

Grant Park is a large urban park in the city's central business district. It was renamed in 1901 to honor US President Ulysses S. Grant. The park contains performance venues, gardens, artworks, sporting, and harbor facilities. It hosts public gatherings and several large annual events and is popularly referred to as "Chicago's front yard".

### The Art Institute of Chicago

The Art Institute is the 2nd-largest art museum in the US after the Met in New York. It houses pieces by renowned painters such as Van Gogh, Monet, and Cezanne, as well as an extensive collection of African American art.

Afternoon

### Chicago Architectural Cruise

The Architectural Cruise of Chicago is a perfect way to view one of America's most formidable cities, all from the comfort of a boat leisurely sailing down the Chicago River, either during the day or at twilight.

### 360 Chicago

This observation deck sits atop the John Hancock Tower in Chicago, providing exquisite aerial views of the city's skyline that you can't get anywhere else. The new LIFT feature extends out above the city below for an exhilarating experience.
