1 Vancouver ~ Rocky Mountaineer Train ~ Kamloops (B/L)

Depart from Vancouver and board the Rocky Mountaineer, one of the world's most scenic train journeys. Travel through Fraser Valley, coastal mountains, and the Cascade Range, enjoying breathtaking landscapes of forests, rivers, and canyons. The onboard hosts provide insightful commentary throughout the trip. In the evening, arrive in Kamloops and transfer to the hotel.

Accommodation: Kamloops area hotel

2 Kamloops ~ Rocky Mountaineer Train ~ Banff (B/L)

Continue the Rocky Mountaineer journey from Kamloops, passing through Rogers Pass, Kicking Horse Canyon, and Spiral Tunnels-engineering marvels of the Canadian Pacific Railway. Along the way, admire glaciers, waterfalls, and the towering peaks of the Canadian Rockies. In the evening, arrive in Banff and transfer to the hotel.

Accommodation: Canalta/Caribou Lodge, Banff or similar

3 Free Day in Banff (B)

On this day, guests will have free time to explore Banff at their own pace. They may also choose to join an optional full-day tour to Lake Louise and Moraine Lake. The journey begins with a visit to Lake Louise, often referred to as the "Jewel of the Rockies," famous for its breathtaking turquoise waters. Guests can also opt to enjoy a special lunch at the Fairmont Château Lake Louise (must be booked 7 days in advance and is non-refundable). Afterward, the tour continues to Moraine Lake, recognized as one of the most picturesque lakes in the world. The lake's crystal-clear blue waters, set against rugged mountain peaks, have made it a favorite among photographers. Moraine Lake is open only from June to mid-October, subject to government schedules. The day concludes with a visit to Yoho National Park, where guests can admire the emerald-green waters of Emerald Lake and witness the unique rock formations of Natural Bridge. In the late afternoon, return to Banff for an overnight stay.

Accommodation: Canalta/Caribou Lodge, Banff or similar

4 Banff ~ Icefields Parkway ~ Columbia Icefield ~ Jasper National Park (B/L/D)

In the morning, travel past Crowfoot Glacier and Bow Lake before entering Jasper National Park. Guests will have the option to take the Ice Explorer (Optional) onto the Athabasca Glacier, part of the 325-square-kilometer Columbia Icefield. Experience the thrill of standing on 250-meter-thick glacial ice, a truly once-in-a-lifetime adventure. Afterward, take a walk on the Glacier Skywalk, a 280-meter-high glass-floored walkway, offering breathtaking views of the Sunwapta Valley below. Continue to Peyto Lake, nestled at the foot of Caldron Peak at an altitude of 2,911 meters. Fed by the Peyto Glacier, the lake's waters contain glacial rock flour, reflecting sunlight and creating a stunning Tiffany-blue. (Opening is subject to government schedules.) In the afternoon, journey back through Yoho National Park before returning to Revelstoke for an overnight stay.

Accommodation: Sandman Hotel, Revelstoke or similar

5 Last Spike Memorial ~ Kamloops ~ Ginseng Farm ~ Vancouver (B/L)

After breakfast, depart Revelstoke and visit the Last Spike Memorial at the Craigellachie Historic Site. This location marks the completion of the Canadian Pacific Railway, which united Canada's east and west coasts. It also serves as a tribute to the thousands of Chinese workers who contributed to the railway's construction over a century ago. Next, the tour continues to Kamloops, a city known for its dry climate, which makes it ideal for growing premium ginseng. Guests will visit a ginseng plantation, where they will learn about the cultivation process and the health benefits of this traditional herbal remedy. A guided tour will provide insights into how ginseng is grown, harvested, and processed. Guests will also have the opportunity to taste fresh ginseng tea and purchase high-quality ginseng products.

In the late afternoon, the tour departs for Vancouver, concluding the five-day journey.
