Arc de Triomphe

The Arc de Triomphe is one of the most famous monuments in all of Paris, France. The Arc de Triomphe honors those who fought and died for France during the French Revolutionary and Napoleonic Wars. Beneath its vault lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier from World War I. It set the tone for public monuments with triumphant patriotic messages.

Avenue des Champs - Elysées

The Avenue des Champs-Élysées is a Paris must-see! This unique avenue is said to be one of the greatest! The avenue is approximately 1.9 km long and 70 m wide, running between the Place de la Concorde and the Place Charles de Gaulle, where the Arc de Triomphe is located. It is known for its theatres, cafés, and numerous luxury shops. It also is home to famous annual Bastille Day military parade and as the finish of the Tour de France cycling race.

Place de la Concorde

The Place de la Concorde is one of the major public squares in Paris, France. Measuring at about 19 acres in area, it is the largest square in the French capital. It was also notorious for the public executions of King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette in the course of the French Revolution.

Museum and Napoleon's Tomb

The tomb chamber is about 4 meters long and over 2 meters wide. It is made of red quartzite and placed on a green granite base. On the ground, the name of Napoleon's victory battle is engraved on a mosaic. There are five coffins in the tomb: the first is a tin coffin, the second is a peach blossom wood coffin, the next two are lead coffins, and the fifth is an ebony coffin. The latter is engraved with the name Napoleon. Twelve white marble female statues (known as the "Goddess of Victory") guard this tomb. The circular gallery is decorated with ten marble bas reliefs (surface sculptures) to celebrate Napoleon's rule and the emperor's civil actions.

Eiffel Tower

You cannot visit Paris without seeing the Eiffel Tower! This global cultural icon of France is one of the most recognizable structures in the entire world! Today is your chance to see it in person and take as many pictures as you would like!

Montparnasse Tower

Paris City Tour

All day

Today we will visit the Paris. In the morning, go to the Seine River and take a sightseeing boat to enjoy the beautiful scenery on both sides of the Seine River. Then visit the Louvre Museum and admire the three treasures of the museum: Leonardo da Vinci's famous painting Mona Lisa, the statue of Venus, and the goddess of victory. After lunch, you can visit Paris freely. If you like shopping, you can go to large department stores to buy fashionable handbags, fashion and French perfume. In the evening, you can enjoy in the Moulin Rouge Show or taste French cuisine at your own expense.

Seine River Cruise

The Seine River divides the entire downtown area of Paris in two. The well-known Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, and Louvre are all built on the banks of the Seine River. Take a cruise to admire the famous French architecture on both sides of the Seine and experience the romantic feelings of France.

Louvre Museum

The Louvre Museum is the world's largest art museum and a historic monument in Paris, France! It is best known for being the home of the Mona Lisa! As a central landmark of the city, it attracts millions of people each year! The Musée du Louvre contains more than 380,000 objects and displays 35,000 works of art in eight curatorial departments with more than 60,600 square meters (652,000 sq ft) dedicated to the permanent collection. The Louvre exhibits sculptures, objects of art, paintings, drawings, and archaeological findings.

Moulin Rouge Show in Paris

The Moulin Rouge performance in Paris is a should-not missed performance in Paris! This dance integrates more acrobatics and sports skills. The dancers' exquisite costumes are tailored by Italian design masters. The stage design is quite sophisticated, and the scenes are diverse. The dancers come from all over the world, and the level of performance is very high. Acrobatics, magic and other performances are interspersed during the show, which is amazing and exciting.

All day

After breakfast, we will head to Reims, the economic capital of the Champagne region in France and a significant city in French history, known as the City of Kings. Since the 11th century, French kings have been required to ascend to the throne in Reims, making the Cathedral of Reims one of the most important attractions. Then we will drive to Luxembourg, an ancient city renowned for its fortresses with a history of over 1000 years.

Morning

Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Reims

The outstanding handling of new architectural techniques in the 13th century, and the harmonious marriage of sculptural decoration with architecture, has made Notre-Dame in Reims one of the masterpieces of Gothic art. The

former abbey still has its beautiful 9th-century nave, in which lie the remains of Archbishop St Rémi (440–533), who instituted the Holy Anointing of the kings of France. The former archiepiscopal palace known as the Tau Palace, which played an important role in religious ceremonies, was almost entirely rebuilt in the 17th century.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Reims to Luxembourg

Adolphe Bridge

Adolphe Bridge is also called the New Bridge, it was built between 1900 and 1903 during the rule of Grand Duke Adolphe. This event was followed with great interest from abroad, because the bridge had the biggest stone arch in the world up to then. The big double arch spans more than 85 meters across the Pétrusse valley.

Alzette Valley

Platz der Verfassung

The Constitution Square was put up on the ancient Beck bastion (1644, 1685). The "Gëlle Fra", a monument which is located on this square, was set up in 1923 to commemorate the Luxembourgers who perished in the First World War, today it symbolises freedom and resistance for the Luxembourg people. From here you have a superb view over the Pétrusse Valley and the Adolphe Bridge.

All day

After enjoying breakfast, we will first drive to the German town of Trier. Trier is the oldest city in Germany, once the capital of the Western Roman Empire and the birthplace of the communist giant Marx. We will visit Museum Karl-Marx-Haus and the Porta Nigra. Then head to Koblenz, known as the German Horn, which is the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers in Europe. Then we will drive along the Rhine River and stop briefly in the bustling town of L ü dersheim on the way. In the afternoon, we will arrive in Frankfurt, the largest financial city in Germany, and visit the city center's Romberg Square and the St. Paul's Church, which symbolizes freedom and democracy.

Museum Karl-Marx-Haus

Karl Marx's birthplace, built around 1727 as a baroque residential home, hosts an exhibition dedicated to the man, the nineteenth century critic of society and capitalism as well as tracing the global legacy of his ideas into the present day. For families, individual visitors, school classes or away days: plan your visit to the Karl-Marx-House. Take part in our guided tours and workshops, explore the house or dwell in the garden.

Porta Nigra

The Porta Nigra (Black Gate) is Trier's landmark. The Romans built it in the 2nd century AD out of huge sandstone blocks that weighed up to 6 tons and were held together by iron clamps. You can climb to the top for great view over the city.

Rhein

Traveling 766 miles from the Swiss Alps to Rotterdam, the majestic River Rhine is truly one of Europe's greatest international waterways. Enshrined in the culture and literature of the six countries through which it passes, no other river in the world has so many old and famous cities on its banks.

Rüdesheim am Rhein

Rüdesheim am Rhein is a German winemaking town in the Rhine Gorge, and part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site in this region. It lies in the Rheingau-Taunus-Kreis district in the Regierungsbezirk of Darmstadt, Hessen. Known as Rüdesheim, it is officially Rüdesheim am Rhein, to distinguish it from Rüdesheim an der Nahe. It is a major tourist attraction, especially for foreign visitors.

Römerberg

Römerberg is a public space in Frankfurt, Germany. It is located in front of the Römer building complex, seat of the Frankfurt city administration since the 15th century. As the site of numerous imperial coronations, trade fairs and Christmas markets, the square is the historic heart of the medieval Altstadt (old town) and today a popular tourist destination.

St. Paul's Church

St Paul's Church is a former Protestant church in Frankfurt, Germany, used as a national assembly hall. Its important political symbolism dates back to 1848 when the Frankfurt Parliament convened there, the first publicly and freely-elected German legislative body.

After enjoying breakfast in the hotel, we will depart from Frankfurt to Bonn. Upon arrival, we will visit Beethoven-Haus Bonn and one of Germany's most outstanding comprehensive universities, the University of Bonn. Then drive to Cologne and visit Cologne Cathedral, a Gothic architectural wonder standing on the banks of the Rhine River that showcases Gothic architecture's pursuit of detail and infinite devotion to divinity. After the visit, head to Amsterdam, Netherlands.

Beethoven-Haus Bonn

The museum at Ludwig van Beethoven's birth place is one of the most frequented music museums worldwide and one of the 100 most popular sights in Germany. Since December 17, 2019, the museum has been hosting a new and enlarged permanent exhibition. It provides a new approach to experiencing Beethoven as an artist and fellow human being in a modern, inspiring and exciting way.

Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-Universität Bonn

Since 2019, the University of Bonn is one of only 11 German Universities of Excellence and the only German university with six Clusters of Excellence. With a strong record of disciplinary excellence and a number of Transdisciplinary Research Areas, the University of Bonn supports the achievement of excellence - since 1818.

Morning Transportation: Drive from Bonn University to Cologne

Morning

Cologne Cathedral

Cologne Cathedral is a Catholic cathedral in Cologne, North Rhine-Westphalia. It is a renowned monument of German Catholicism and Gothic architecture and was declared a World Heritage Site in 1996. At 157 m (515 ft), the cathedral is currently the tallest twin-spired church in the world, the second tallest church in Europe after Ulm Minster, and the third tallest church in the world. It is the largest Gothic church in Northern Europe and has the second-tallest spires. The towers for its two huge spires give the cathedral the largest façade of any church in the world.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Cologne Cathedral to Amsterdam

Travel distance: 262km Travel time: 3Hour

Night

All day

Today we will first visit the Zaanse Schans. We will visit the windmills that symbolize the Netherlands, traditional clog factories, and cheese factories, and introduce the manufacturing process of clogs and cheese. Afterwards, return to the Amsterdam and visit the Dam Square. The National Monument is located on the east side of Dam Square and was built to commemorate the soldiers who sacrificed their lives in World War II. Following, visit the Koninklijk Paleis Amsterdam, which is decorated with magnificent decorations and is a treasure trove of art and culture, worth savoring carefully. Next, you can take a glass sightseeing boat along the canal and enjoy the charming scenery on both sides. Finally, we will visit the diamond factory.

Amsterdam → Zaanse Schans (60 mins) → Amsterdam → Dam Square (30 mins) → Koninklijk Paleis Amsterdam (Outside visit, 15 mins) → Nationaal Monument (Outside visit, 15 mins) → Volendam (Optional, 1 hours) → Giethoorn (Optional, 1 hours) → Canal Cruise Amsterdam (Optional, 40 mins) → Diamond Factory (Inside visit, 60 mins)

Special note: An additional visit to the annual Dutch Flower Show is available from March to May each year (Optional, 1 hour).

Zaanse Schans

Zaanse Schans is a neighborhood in the Dutch town of Zaandam, near Amsterdam. Historic windmills and distinctive green wooden houses are relocated here to recreate the look of an 18th/19th-century like-villages. The Zaans Museum has regional costumes, model windmills and interactive exhibits on chocolate making. Artisan workshops even demonstrate rare handicrafts such as wooden clog carving, barrel making and pewter casting.

Dam Square

Dam Square was created in the 13th century when a dam was built around the river Amstel to prevent the Zuiderzee sea from flooding the city. It is now known as one of the main tourist sights and is full of entertainment. There are food stalls, restaurants and numerous shops including the trendy Bijenkorf and Magna Plaza. People love coming to Dam Square due to its uniqueness and beauty that it portrays!

Koninklijk Paleis Amsterdam

The Royal Palace of Amsterdam in Amsterdam (Dutch: Koninklijk Paleis van Amsterdam or Paleis op de Dam) is one of three palaces in the Netherlands which are at the disposal of the monarch by Act of Parliament. It is situated on the west side of Dam Square in the centre of Amsterdam, opposite the War Memorial and next to the Nieuwe Kerk.

Nationaal Monument

Standing an imposing 22-metres high in the centre of Amsterdam's Dam Square, the National Monument is the Netherlands' most important memorial to World War II. Besides serving as a daily reminder of the war's atrocities and those lost, the monument plays a central role in National Remembrance Day (Nationale Dodenherdenking, 4 May) when the royal family and local residents gather to pay their respects to fallen soldiers from both WWII and more recent conflicts.

Today we will depart from Amsterdam and drive to Brussels, the capital of Belgium, which boasts the most exquisite architecture and museums in Europe, with skyscrapers and medieval buildings complementing each other. The entire city is centered around the palace and built along the 'small ring'. Finally go to the French capital Paris.

Morning

Atomium

Halfway between sculpture and architecture, the Atomium was designed and built for the Brussels World's Fair (1958),

for which it was the flagship building and emblem. Representing an iron unit cell (9 iron atoms) magnified 165 billion times, the monument with its unique silhouette has, over time, grown to become the symbol of Brussels and Belgium. On the inside the Atomium offers, not just the most beautiful view of Brussels, but also an entirely astounding and surreal ride through its interior spaces and volumes which alone makes a visit worth it.

Brussels Town Hall

The Town Hall of the City of Brussels is a Gothic building from the Middle Ages. It is located on the famous Grand Place in Brussels, Belgium, across the Brussels City Museum. Interestingly enough, it is the only remaining medieval building of the Grand Place and is even considered to be a masterpiece of civil Gothic architecture.

Grand-Place Brussels

Let's explore the Grand Place! The Grand Place is located at the central square of Brussels. The Grand Place is one of the greatest tourist destinations and the most memorable landmark in Brussels. It is also considered one of the most beautiful squares in Europe and has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1998.

Manneken Pis

Manneken Pis is a landmark small bronze sculpture located in central Brussels. The sculpture is part of a fountain that has a little boy urinating into the fountain's basin. It was designed by Jérôme Duquesnoy the Elder and put in place in 1618 or 1619; however, the current statue is a replica which dates from 1965.
