Tour introduction

Day 1

Frankfurt - Vehicle - Karlovy Vary - Vehicle - Prague

All day

Departing from Frankfurt, Germany in the morning, expected to cross the border into the Czech in the afternoon. First, come to the hot spring town of Karlovy Vary, where hot spring corridors and magnificent Baroque style buildings are everywhere. In addition to appreciating the beauty of architecture, you can also sip mineral water that heals the body and mind. Then we will head to the capital of Czech Republic and arrive in Prague, the ancient capital of Eastern Europe known for its medieval gemstones, in the evening.

[Wednesday] Itinerary:

Frankfurt → Czech → Karlovy Vary (1 hours) → Prague

Morning Transportation: Driving from Frankfurt to Karlovy Vary, the hot springs town of Czech

Travel distance: 380km Travel time: 4Hour30Minute

Afternoon

Karlovy Vary

Karlovy Vary is the site of numerous hot springs (13 main springs, about 300 smaller springs, and the warm-water Teplá River), and is the most visited spa town in the Czech Republic. The historic city centre with the spa cultural landscape is well preserved and is protected by law as an urban monument reservation. It is the largest spa complex in Europe. In 2021, the city became part of the transnational UNESCO World Heritage Site under the name "Great Spa Towns of Europe" because of its spas and architecture from the 18th through 20th centuries.

Day 2

Prague - Vehicle - Bratislava

All day

Today we will visit Prague, the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic, which boasts numerous buildings from various historical periods and styles. The overall impression of Prague's architecture is that the changes at the top of the buildings are particularly rich. After the tour, we will drive to Hungary and stay overnight in Bratislava or nearby cities.

[Thursday] Itinerary:

Prague → Prague Castle: Starý královský palác+St. George's Basilic+Golden Lane (1 hour for outside visit, if you need to enter, please purchase tickets in advance) → **Charles Bridge** (Pass By) → **Old city center** (visit the city hall clock tower, square, etc., 30 mins) → **Overnight in Bratislava**

Morning

Prague Castle

A beauty of its own to discover is the Prague Castle! It is one of the largest coherent castle complexes in the world. It consists of a large-scale composition of palaces and ecclesiastical buildings of various architectural styles from the remains of Romanesque-style buildings in the 10th century through the Gothic modifications of the 14th century.

Starý královský palác

This palace was the seat of Bohemian princes and kings until the 16th century. It was built on the remains of the Romanesque Soběslav Palace. Most notable is the Gothic Vladislav Hall – the largest secular space of medieval Prague (1487 – 1500, Benedikt Rejt) with remarkable rib vaulting, used today as the venue for ceremonial state events.

St. George's Basilica

St. George's Basilica (Czech: Bazilika sv. Jiří) is the oldest surviving church building within Prague Castle, Prague, Czech Republic. The basilica was founded by Vratislaus I of Bohemia in 920. It is dedicated to Saint George. Primarily Romanesque in style, it is part of the collection of buildings that comprise the castle, the political capital of the nation, and the spiritual center of the Czech state.

Golden Lane

Let's take you to visit colorful and vibrant townhouses! Golden Lane originated after the construction of a new northern wall of the castle. The area of the northern bailey was used for the building of modest dwellings, which are now the last remainder of the small-scale architecture of Prague Castle. Let's take a look at this architectural destination.

Charles Bridge

Charles Bridge is a 14th century stone bridge linking the two sides of Prague. This magnificent structure is one of the city's finest attractions, is the main pedestrian route connecting the Old Town with the Lesser Town and Prague Castle. It is a uniquely designed bridge filled with musicians, painters, vendors and tourists.

Day 3

Bratislava - Vehicle - Budapest

All day

Today we will arrive in Budapest, the capital of Hungary. Firstly, we will visit the Heroes' Square to celebrate the founding of the country and commemorate the alliance of the Magyar people. Then, we will come to the largest building in Hungary - the Hungarian Parliament Building, to appreciate the Gothic Revival style design. Following, take a look at the Erzsébet Bridge, which was built in memory of Princess Sisi and spans the beautiful Danube River, connecting Buda and Pest on both sides. Afterwards, visit Fisherman's Bastion and the Matthias Church where Hungarian kings were crowned throughout history. Then, check in at the Statue of Liberty on Fortress Hill, which offers a panoramic view of Budapest. If time permits, we can also arrange a Danube River cruise for you to enjoy the scenery on both sides of Budapest.

Heroes' Square

Welcome to Budapest's Heroes' Square! It houses one of the city's iconic symbols, the Millennium Memorial, which includes the seven chieftains of the Magyar tribes that founded Hungary and other important heads of state. In between the statues is a large column crowned by Archangel Gabriel.

Hungarian Parliament Building

The Hungarian Parliament Building, also known as the Parliament of Budapest after its location, is the seat of the

National Assembly of Hungary, a notable landmark of Hungary, and a popular tourist destination in Budapest. It is situated on Kossuth Square in the Pest side of the city, on the eastern bank of the Danube. It was designed by Hungarian architect Imre Steindl in neo-Gothic style and opened in 1902. It has been the largest building in Hungary since its completion.

Erzsébet Bridge

Erzsébet Bridge is the third newest bridge of Budapest, Hungary, connecting Buda and Pest across the River Danube. The bridge is situated at the narrowest part of the Danube in the Budapest area, spanning only 290 m. It is named after Elisabeth of Bavaria, a popular queen and empress of Austria-Hungary, who was assassinated in 1898. Today, her large bronze statue sits by the bridge's Buda side connection in the middle of a small garden.

Fisherman's Bastion

Fisherman's Bastion in Budapest is easily one of the top Budapest attractions. The present-day lovely lookout towers and decorative fortification of the Fisherman's Bastion was built in the 19th century. It serves as a lookout tower for the best panoramic views in Budapest, Hungary.

Matthias Church

It is a historic building with an important history. Two Kings of Hungary were crowned within its walls: Franz Joseph I of Hungary and Elisabeth, and Charles IV of Hungary and Zita of Bourbon-Parma.

Szabadság szobor

Due to its central location atop Gellért Hill, at the south eastern bastion of the Citadella, the Statue of Liberty is visible from any point of downtown. Although opinions differ about the statue originally erected to commemorate Soviet heroes, it is undoubtedly one of the most important symbols of Budapest.

After enjoying breakfast in the hotel, we will depart for Vienna, the capital of Austria and a famous European metropolis. This place has a strong atmosphere of classical music and art, and is known as the "Capital of World Music".

Budapest → Vienna (2 hours) → Ring Road: Austrian Parliament Building, Hofburg, Heldenplatz, Vienna State Opera → Stadtpark → Domkirche St. Stephan → Schönbrunn Palace (Optional, 1 hours) → Waltz Music and Dance Performance Evening Party (Optional, 1 hours)

Schönbrunn Palace

Schönbrunn Palace is one of Europe's most beautiful Baroque complexes and has been in the possession of the Habsburgs since 1569. The wife of Emperor Ferdinand II, Eleonore von Gonzaga, had a pleasure palace built on the site in 1642 and called the property "Schönbrunn" for the first time. The palace and garden complex created from 1696 onwards following the siege of Vienna was completely redesigned under Maria Theresa after 1743. Today, due to its historical significance, its unique layout and magnificent furnishings, the palace is a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Austrian Parliament Building

The Austrian Parliament Building in Vienna is where the two houses of the Austrian Parliament conduct their sessions. The building is located on the Ringstraße boulevard in the first district Innere Stadt, near Hofburg Palace and the Palace of Justice. The Parliament Building is the site of important state ceremonies, most notably the swearing-in ceremony of the President of Austria and the state speech on National Day each October 26.

Hofburg

The Hofburg is the official residence and workplace of the President of Austria and was formerly the principal imperial palace of the Habsburg dynasty. Located in the center of Vienna, it was built in the 13th century and expanded several times afterwards.

Heldenplatz

Heldenplatz (German: Heroes' Square) is a public space in front of the Hofburg Palace in Vienna, Austria. Located in the Innere Stadt borough, the President of Austria resides in the adjoining Hofburg wing, while the Federal Chancellery is on adjacent Ballhausplatz.

Vienna State Opera

The Vienna State Opera is one of the top opera addresses in the world, with first-class productions of the very highest caliber and a different program every day: around 50 operas and ballet works per season, danced by the Vienna State Ballet. The variety of the operatic program is unparalleled anywhere in the world.

Stadtpark

It is located on the east side of the Vienna Ring Road in Austria and is built along the Vienna River. The flower clock, lawns, flocks of birds and statues of musicians here form a very beautiful scene, making it a great place for walking and outings.

Domkirche St. Stephan

St. Stephen's Cathedral is the symbol of Vienna and also the very center of the city. At 136 meters in height, it is the tallest church in Austria. St. Stephen's Cathedral is not only Austria's most important Gothic building. The Steffl, as it is affectionately known in Vienna, is much more than that. It is a landmark, a symbol of identity and synonymous with the reconstruction of the Republic after the Second World War. Construction of St. Stephen's Cathedral began in the 12th century and its interior changed repeatedly over the centuries until it was finally given its current Baroque appearance. The tallest of its four towers is the south tower at 136 meters.

Hallstatt

Hallstatt is one of the most enchanting places you will visit! Hallstatt is a fairy-tale-like town sprinkled with pastel-colored houses and winding cobblestone streets. It is surrounded by the striking Northern Limestone Alps. The natural beauty and picturesque views that it portrays attracts visitors to the tiny town year after year.

Marienplatz

Marienplatz is a central square in the city centre of Munich, Germany. It has been the city's main square since 1158. Today the Marienplatz is dominated by the New City Hall (Neues Rathaus) on the north side, and the Old City Hall (Altes Rathaus, a reconstructed gothic council hall with a ballroom and tower) on the east side.

All day

After breakfast, we will head to Switzerland, known as the Garden of the World, passing through the capital of Liechtenstein, Vaduz, which is famous for its Alpine landscape, hiking trails, and stamps. Afterwards, we will cross the towering mountains and head to the Ingeborg Mountains in central Switzerland, visit the Tielishi Snow Mountain, take a rotating cable car, and climb the Tielishi Peak, which is 3000 meters high and covered in snow all year round. Afterwards, we will go to the picturesque city of Luzern to admire the lion monument carved on the cliffs to praise the loyalty and bravery of the Swiss people.

Lucerne's world-famous Lion Monument has been consistently impressing its visitors each and every year. The imposing stone lion, however, is more than "just" a monument. It can be seen as a commemoration, a work of art or a memorial. It is a powerful and proud landmark of the city of Lucerne.

All day

Today we will first visit Lake Zurich and take photos by the lake as a souvenir. Then head to the city of Einsiedeln to admire the Rhine River waterfall. The waterfall rapids are spectacular and surging. Afterwards, enter the Black Forest region of Germany and admire the famous mountain lake in the Black Forest region - Titisee, which is the largest natural lake in the Black Forest. This is also the production site of cuckoo clocks, selling interesting clocks everywhere. The tour guide will introduce the manufacturing process of cuckoo clocks to you. Then, you can choose to enjoy a rich pork knuckle lunch and taste a piece of authentic Black Forest cake at the lakeside restaurant at your own expense, making your trip worthwhile!

Rheinfall

The Rhine Falls is a waterfall located in Switzerland and the most powerful waterfall in Europe. The falls are located on the High Rhine on the border between the cantons of Schaffhausen (SH) and Zürich (ZH), between the municipalities of Neuhausen am Rheinfall (SH) and Laufen-Uhwiesen/Dachsen (ZH), next to the town of Schaffhausen in northern Switzerland.
