Tour introduction

All day

Today, we will depart from New York and first head to Lake George in the Adirondack Mountains. This 51-kilometer stretch of clear water was once praised by Thomas Jefferson, the third president of the United States, as the "most beautiful water" he had ever seen in his life. Looking around, the lake is as blue as a mirror, reflecting the green mountains and the sky and clouds, just like a perfect postcard carefully drawn in the Adirondack Mountains. Every inch of the scenery is breathtaking. Then we will continue north to Montreal, the largest French-speaking city in eastern Canada, the most French cultural characteristics, and known as the "Little Paris of North America."

Itinerary:

New York → Lake George (30 mins) → **Montreal → Old Montreal** (30 mins) → **Montreal French Dinner** (Optional, 90 mins)

Morning Transportation: Drive from New York to Lake George

Travel distance: 348km Travel time: 3Hour30Minute

Afternoon

Lake George

Lake George is located at the southern end of the famed Adirondack Park in Upstate New York. At 32 miles long, up to 2.5 miles wide, and with depths reaching 200 feet, it is considered to be among the clearest and cleanest large lakes in the world. Formed nearly 10,000 years ago by melting glaciers, the Lake's water clarity and scenic beauty have awed residents and visitors alike for centuries. More than 90% of the watershed remains as natural forestland, with nearly half of the forested acreage publicly owned by New York State and constitutionally protected as forever-wild Forest Preserve.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Lake George to Montreal

Travel distance: 263km Travel time: 3Hour

Old Montreal

Old Montreal refers to the Old Port on the north bank of the St. Lawrence River and the surrounding urban area. It is the oldest neighborhood in Montreal. Revealing a strong European flavor, Old Montreal is a must-see attraction for tourists. The churches in the old city and the old stone houses with European characteristics seem to be

telling the changes in people and things that it has seen over the past few hundred years through the change of seasons. The air is filled with cultural atmosphere and petty bourgeoisie sentiment!

Day 2

All day

In the morning, we will depart from Montreal and drive to the Green Lake Resort to enjoy the maple leaves and the beautiful maple leaves in Canada in autumn! Green Lake Resort in late autumn is the best place to enjoy the maple leaves. The colorful buildings in the resort are built according to the mountain. The architectural features are full of European style. With the back of the mountain and the water in front, the colors are bright and unique, making people feel like they are in a fairy tale world. Then we will go to Ottawa, a famous political and commercial city, to visit the palace-style Governor's Mansion. The exterior of the building is gray as the main color, which adds a bit of solemnity and majesty. Then visit the landmark building of Ottawa - Parliament Hill. After the visit, check in to the hotel and rest.

Mont Tremblant

Rideau Hall

The Governor General's Palace, also known as the Rideau Hall, covers an area of 79 acres. It is covered with green grass, red flowers and willows, and is beautiful and open all year round. It is not only a place of honor for honoring outstanding Canadian citizens and receiving world leaders, but also a tourist attraction for tourists from all over the world. Since 1867, the Governor General's Palace has become the place where successive Canadian governors-general work and live.

Parliament Hill

Parliament Hill refers to the area centered on the Parliament Building. It is also the symbol of Ottawa and even the whole of Canada. The maple leaf flag fluttering in the wind on the clock tower and a series of stone-built copper-roofed Gothic buildings standing firmly on the banks of the Ottawa River symbolize the indomitable spirit of the Canadian nation. There is also an observation deck on the Peace Tower, from which you can overlook the panoramic view of Ottawa. Oil lamps will be lit on the tower during the Parliament Building meeting.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Parliament Hill to Belleville, Canada

Lake Muskoka

Muskoka Lake is the largest of a group of scenic lakes in the rocky uplands of southern Ontario located 200 to 240 km north of Toronto and 20 km east of Georgian Bay. The term "Muskoka" may come from the Huron Indian names "musquash" and "ooka" meaning "the place where the large rocks are red" . Miles of boating routes, natural wonders, rich historical heritage and lakeside life attract tourists from all over the world.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Lake Muskoka to Huntsville

Travel distance: 65km Travel time: 1Hour

Huntsville

Located between Arrowhead Provincial Park and Algonquin Provincial Park, Huntsville is the largest community in the Muskoka region and has rightly been dubbed “the adventure capital of Ontario.” This beautiful town is known for access to many nature trails, parks and lakes. Thanks to the terrain and climate, outdoor activities in and around Huntsville are available year-round, ranging from hiking, camping, paddling and bicycling in warmer months to skiing, snowshoeing and snowmobiling in winter.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Huntsville to Algonquin Provincial Park

Travel distance: 42km Travel time: 30Minute

Algonquin Provincial Park

Algonquin Provincial Park was established in 1893. It is the oldest national park in Ontario, Canada. It covers an area of 7,725 square kilometers, with more than 2,500 lakes and vast forests. It is a popular national park and outdoor paradise in Ontario. The park is located about 300 kilometers north of Toronto, about 3 hours by car, with convenient transportation. There are hundreds of campsites in the park, suitable for boating, fishing, hiking, cycling and other outdoor sports. The park is also an important wildlife reserve, where moose, black bears, wolves, various reptiles, amphibians and birds live, and there are thousands of plant species. Every autumn, usually from the end of September to mid-October, Algonquin becomes a maple viewing resort in Canada. The

mountains and plains are dyed with fiery red maple leaves, and the red, yellow and green colors are intertwined and reflected in the clear rivers and lakes. It can be called a very beautiful autumn scenery in Canada.

Day 4

Belleville - Vehicle - Thousand Islands - Vehicle - New York

All day

In the morning, we will depart from the hotel to the Thousand Islands. This fairyland-like water spans the border between Canada and the United States. On the rippling river, 1,864 islands of various shapes are scattered. Board the yacht and shuttle between the islands, passing the most famous and charming scenic spots in the Thousand Islands. Finally, return to New York.

Belleville → Thousand Islands → Canadian Thousand Islands Cruise (Include ticket, 60 mins) → **Return to New York**

Thousand Islands Cruise

The water of Lake Ontario flows out into the St. Lawrence River. There are 1,865 natural islands of various sizes and one artificial island in the St. Lawrence River Bay. It is called the Thousand Islands Lake, also known as the St. Lawrence Islands National Park. The Thousand Islands Lake cruise allows you to appreciate the infinite scenery. You will see various traces left by history on the edge of the island. You can take a cruise to travel among the islands and appreciate the mansions and islands of different sizes and shapes.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive back to New York from Thousand Islands

Travel distance: 524km Travel time: 6Hour
