Maymont

Maymont is a well-preserved, 100-acre historic estate overlooking the James River that was given to the public by James and Sallie Dooley, who lived there from 1893 to 1925. Today, Maymont is a welcoming community gathering place, with many unique experiences for all to enjoy, including the historic Maymont Mansion, The Robins Nature Center, an arboretum, formal gardens, and habitats for native Virginia wildlife and farm animals. Consistently ranked one of Central Virginia's top attractions by travelers and locals alike, Maymont serves over 700,000 guests annually.

Day 2

Today we will continue our tour in North Carolina. First, we will go to the North Carolina Wildlife Park to observe more than 20 kinds of animals up close and learn about their living habits. Then we will take a car through the Blue Ridge Trail. The Blue Ridge is even more beautiful in autumn! The trail winds along the Blue Ridge Mountains. The hillsides and valleys on both sides are green, yellow, red... The bright colors are refreshing. Finally, we will come to Grandpa Mountain, the highest peak on the eastern cliff of the Blue Ridge Mountains. The beautiful scenery on the mountain is dazzling. The wildlife habitat, swinging bridge, and museum are all unique. It is a great

choice for hiking.

Animal Park at the Conservators Center

The Animal Park at the Conservators Center is a nonprofit zoological park with a mission of educating people, caring for animals, and advocating for species. Located in Burlington, NC, the Animal Park is home to over 70 exotic animals including big cats (lions, tigers, and leopards), gray wolves, lemurs, servals, binturongs, New Guinea singing dogs, jungle cats, and other species rarely seen at zoos. Visitors meet the animals on guided tours that allow views from as close as 5 feet away while they learn about the individual animals' personalities and the species they represent. The Animal Park offers Wild Field Trips, Virtual and In-Person Learning Experiences, Special Tour Offerings, Parties, Private Tours, Events, and so much more!

Morning Transportation: Drive from Animal Park at the Conservators Center to Grandfather Mountain State Park

Afternoon

Blue Ridge Parkway

Spanning the southern and central Appalachians, the Blue Ridge Parkway offers an exceptional glimpse of the regional flora and fauna. It is world-renowned for its biodiversity. The Parkway covers a wide range of habitats along the Appalachian Mountains, and some of these habitats are exceptionally rare. Visitors encounter unsurpassed diversity of climate, vegetation, wildlife and geological features.

Grandfather Mountain State Park

Grandpa Mountain is located in the Blue Ridge Mountains. It is 5,946 feet high and is the highest peak in the eastern cliff of the Blue Ridge Mountains. The mountain is lush with trees, and there is a swing bridge and a museum on the top of the mountain. The swing bridge is the highest bridge in the United States. Here you can visit the museum, hike, have a picnic, enjoy the charming natural scenery, and get close to small animals. It is a good place for hiking.

Day 3

All day

We will set off in the morning sun, today we will go to Mount Mitchell, the highest mountain in eastern North America. Standing on the highest peak of the Appalachian Mountains, you will overlook the magnificent scenery within dozens of miles. Then we will go to the Spectrum Center, which is the home of the NBA Charlotte Hornets and the venue for top concerts and grand events. Follow us to visit the comfortable and luxurious paradise for fans and feel the fanatical NBA atmosphere! Finally, we will go to the South Carolina State House, where you will learn about the history, development, art and culture of South Carolina from all aspects.

Mountain Mitchell State Park

At 6,684 feet, the mountain is the highest point east of the Mississippi River, and an observation deck provides breathtaking mountain views on a clear day. Easy trails at the summit explore the Fraser fir forest, while a vast network of challenging trails — including the Mountains-to-Sea State Trail — extend into adjacent wilderness areas and lead to backpacking opportunities within Pisgah National Forest.

Spectrum Center

Boasting more than 20,000 seats, the Spectrum Center opened its doors in 2005 and is home to the NBA's Charlotte Hornets. The arena hosts more than 150 events a year, ranging from a variety of live entertainment such as professional and amateur sporting competitions to national and international draws such as The Rolling Stones, Taylor Swift and U2.

South Carolina State House

The South Carolina State Capitol is a Greek Revival-style building that is the meeting place of the South Carolina State Legislature and the office of the South Carolina government. It was also the seat of the Carolina Supreme Court until 1971.

All day

Today we will check in at one of South Carolina's most amazing natural masterpieces, the Angel Oak. This ancient oak tree has been around for centuries, with branches spreading in all directions and a canopy covering the sky. It has survived all kinds of natural disasters and has always stood firm. It is a spiritual symbol of South Carolinians. We will then take a bus to Boone Hall Plantation, where you will set foot on Oak Moss Avenue, visit the original slave cabins, learn about the history of Gullah culture, and admire the colorful plantations. Then we will check in at Charleston Rainbow Street, which has history, culture, and food. There are 13 colorful townhouses on the romantic street, which is beautiful. Going north along Interstate 95, we will come to South of the Border, the border of South Carolina. The huge wide-brimmed hat sign is worth your stop.

Angel Oak

The fairytale-like Angel Oak Tree is located in Charleston, South Carolina, and is considered one of the oldest

living things east of the Mississippi River. The Angel Oak Tree has survived hurricanes, floods, and earthquakes for

1,400 years. Although it has experienced years of wind and rain erosion and disasters, the Angel Oak Tree has not

shown any signs of aging, but has a vibrant atmosphere. Today, it has become a very popular and stunning tourist

attraction.

Boone Hall Plantation & Garden

Boone Hall Plantation was founded in the 18th century and covers a large area with beautiful botanical gardens

and historic buildings. There is an oak avenue in front of the manor gate, with dozens of giant oak trees lined up in

two rows leading directly to the main building of the manor, which is why people believe that the manor is the

prototype of Tara's manor in "Gone with the Wind". We can visit 9 original cabins where slaves lived, each of

which has historical images or information about the manor. Listen to the stories of black people, or listen to

singers describe the daily lives of slaves in songs.

Rainbow Row (Old Town)

Charleston, South Carolina is known for its rich history, picturesque architecture, and colorful streets. One street, in particular, stands out for its rainbow of pastel hues – Rainbow Row. Located in the heart of Charleston's historic district, Rainbow Row has been a beloved landmark for nearly three centuries.

South of the Border has been a Southeast landmark for nearly 70 years, offering a host of fun activities and unique attractions for young people. The Sombrero Observation Tower is 200 feet tall, and its glass elevator allows passengers to enjoy panoramic views of the South of the Border area when they reach the top of the tower. Pedroland Park has a variety of fun rides designed specifically for kids. There is also the largest indoor reptile exhibit in the United States, as well as shopping, dining, camping, and more. Provide you with a clean, safe, and fun environment on your way to and from the Southeast.

Day 5 Emporia - Vehicle - New York

All day

Today we will visit the famous USS Wisconsin. This retired battleship has participated in many battles and made great achievements. Our last stop will be the Chesapeake Bay Bridge, known as "one of the seven engineering wonders of the modern world". And you will be amazed by the spectacular view of the Atlantic Ocean. After the tour, we will return to New York.

USS Wisconsin

Wisconsin played an important role in the Invasion of Lingayen Gulf and the war of Iwo Jima and Okinawa. After Japan surrendered, Wisconsin assists the US occupy Japan, and then participate Operation Magic Carpet, pick up

the US military repatriation.

Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Tunnel

The Chesapeake Bay Bridge is a two-way transoceanic bridge that runs from Norfolk to the Delaware Peninsula, creating a water corridor between the Chesapeake Bay and the Atlantic Ocean. The world's longest bridge-tunnel complex is 4.3 miles (6.9 kilometers) long and is known as "one of the seven engineering wonders of the modern world." Standing on the shore, you can not only see the spectacular view of the Atlantic Bay, the world's busiest

shipping channel, but also enjoy the sunset beauty of the seaside.

Afternoon Transportation: Drive from Norflox to New York

Travel distance: 370mi Travel time: 7Hour
