2 Reykjavik - Golden Circle: Thingvellir National Park - Strokkur Geysir - Gullfoss Waterfall - Kerid Crater (admission incl.)

[Strokkur Geysir] The most active geyser in Iceland that erupts vigorously up to 15 or 20 meters every 4-10 minutes, making it another must visited attraction on the Golden Circle route.

[Gullfoss Waterfall] Also known as the "Golden Falls" as the water spray shining under the bright sun, the Waterfall was formed by flash flood waters flowing through the cracks in the lava layers. It is the largest waterfall in Europe in terms of volume.

[Kerid Crater] An at least 3000-year-old volcanic crater lake filled with brilliant blue water, Kerid dazzles with its dramatic red rock walls and perfect circular form.

[Hallgrímskirkja Church] An iconic landmark of Iceland, famed for its unique design inspired by basalt lava columns, offering breathtaking panoramic city-and-sea views from its tower.

4 Amalienborg Palace - Gefion Fountain - Little Mermaid - Town Hall Square - Nyhavn Harbor - DFDS Cruise Oslo, Norway

[Amalienborg Palace] Constructed in the mid-18th century, Amalienborg Palace has since become the principal residence of the Danish royal family. There is changing of the Royal Guard daily at noon.

[Little Mermaid] Created based on the popular fairy tale of the same name by the famous Danish author Hans Christian Andersen (1805-1875), this bronze sculpture has become Copenhagen's icon and adopted as the tourism authority's logo.

[Nyhavn Harbor] Copenhagen's newly developed entertainment district being transformed from a 17th century waterfront, lining with brightly colored townhouses, bars, cafes and restaurants.

5 Oslo - Vigeland Sculpture Park - Nobel Peace Center - City Hall Square - Munch Museum (admission incl.) - Karlstad, Sweden

[Nobel Peace Center] Located beside City Hall Square, this contemporary museum uses interactive multimedia to showcase the achievements and ideals of past Nobel Peace Prize laureates.

[Munch Museum] This striking new cultural landmark, dedicated to the legendary Norwegian artist Edvard Munch (1863–1944), houses more than 26,000 of his masterpieces - including paintings, sketches, and prints - it is the world's largest collection of Munch's works.

[Karlstad] Scandic Winn Karlstad City or similar

6 Karlstad - Stockholm - Old Town - Royal Palace Square - Drottningholm Palace (optional) - Skansen Open-Air Museum (optional)

[Stockholm Old Town] With history dating from the 13th century, it's the original city centre lined with cobbled lanes, narrow alleys, and mustard- and rust-colored townhouses, and is now a top attraction filled with cafés, restaurants, shops, galleries, and museums.

[Drottningholm Palace] With its castle, perfectly preserved theatre, Chinese pavilion and gardens, the Palace is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the finest example of a northern European royal residence being inspired by the Palace of Versailles.

[Skansen Open-Air Museum] Step into Sweden's past at the world's first open-air museum, where historic farmsteads, workshops, and costumed guides bring five centuries of Swedish life to life.

7 Stockholm City Hall (admission incl.) - Vasa Museum (admission incl.) - Silja Cruise 🚤 Tallinn, Estonia

[Stockholm City Hall] An iconic landmark on the waterfront, famed for its striking red-brick tower, grand ceremonial halls, and as the venue of the annual Nobel Prize banquet.

[Vasa Museum] The most visited maritime museum in Stockholm displaying the only almost fully intact 17th century warship Vasa that sank on her maiden voyage in 1628.

8 Tallinn - Kadriorg Palace - Alexander Nevski Cathedral - Old Town 🚤 Helsinki, Finland

[Kadriorg Palace] A grand Baroque architecture built by Russian emperor Peter the Great in the 17th century as the royal summer residence, currently houses Kadriorg Art Museum exhibiting a collection of Western European and Russian art from the 16th - 20th century.

[Alexander Nevski Cathedral] Built in a typical Russian Revival style; it's Tallinn's largest and grandest orthodox cupola cathedral overlooking the entire Old Town.

[Helsinki] Clarion Hotel Helsinki or similar

9 Helsinki - Temppeliaukio Church (admission incl.) - Market Square - Sibelius Monument - Uspenski Cathedral - Sea Fortress Suomenlinna (optional)

[Temppeliaukio Church] Also known as the Rock Church, this unique landmark is carved into natural bedrock and topped with a copper dome, showcasing a perfect fusion of nature and architecture.

[Uspenski Cathedral] The largest Orthodox church in Western Europe, famed for its golden cupolas and redbrick exterior - an enduring symbol of Russian influence in Finnish history.

[Sea Fortress Suomenlinna] One of the world's largest sea fortresses, built on Helsinki's offshore islands to defend Sweden from Russia. A former military base with a historic dry dock, it became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1991.


