Welcome to Germany! Today we will take a look at the Berlin Victory column, Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag building and Berlin Cathedral! Following, we will go to the Berlin Wall to explore where the infamous wall once stood. Next we

will take a look at the Old Town Gate and finally visit the Dutch Quarter.

Berlin Victory Column

Welcome to one of Berlin's most famous and popular tourist spot known as The Victory Column! It is another of Berlin's monuments that has reinvented itself through the ages. Once a symbol of Prussian military victory in the 19th century to a favorite tourist hotspot today. The 67m high symbol of victory originally stood in front of the Reichstag in the former Königsplatz and today's Platz der Republik. The 8.3m tall statue on the top of the column represents both Victoria, the Goddess of Victory and Borussia the allegory and Latin name of Prussia.

Brandenburg Gate

Join us as we visit the Brandenburg Gate! It is one of the most iconic sights in Berlin. The Brandenburg Gate is more than just Berlin's only surviving historical city gate; this site came to symbolize Berlin's Cold War division into East and West. Architecturally, the sandstone Brandenburg Gate also represents one of the earliest and most attractive examples of a neo-classical building in Germany.

Reichstag building

The Reichstag was constructed to house the Imperial Diet (German: Reichstag) of the German Empire. It was opened in 1894 and housed the Diet until 1933, when it was severely damaged after being set on fire. After its completion in 1999, it once again became the meeting place of the German parliament: the modern Bundestag.

Berlin Cathedral

The magnificent dome of the Cathedral Church (Berliner Dom) is one of the main landmarks in Berlin's cityscape. The Berlin Cathedral marks the spot of the impressive basilica housing the city's most important Protestant church. With the cathedral's intricate designs, it is a must-see destination that you will easily fall in love with.

Berlin Wall

From August 13th, 1961, to November 9th of 1989, Berlin was divided into East and West. The Berlin Wall remains to this day a unique and emblematic symbol of that period. The East Side Gallery is the longest surviving section of the Berlin Wall. The most famous is the work known as the "Fraternal Kiss", depicting a kiss between Russian leader Leonid Brezhnev and East Germany's SED Party Chairman Erich Honecker.

Potsdam Old Town Gate

Potsdam has three magnificent city gates that represent the symbols of Potsdam's Old City: Brandenburg Gate. Brandenburg Gate is a triumphal arch commemorating the victory in the Seven Years' War. A popular meeting place in the inner city of Potsdam, presenting a typical British neo-Gothic style.

Dutch Quarter

The Dutch Quarter (Holländisches Viertel) is a neighborhood in Potsdam, consisting of 134 red Dutch brick buildings. Almost all of the Dutch brick buildings have been renovated. The Dutch Quarter is a unique site to discover.

Apart from religious services, coronations of Czech kings and queens also took place here. The cathedral is a place of burial of several patron saints, sovereigns, noblemen and archbishops.

Golden Lane

Let's take you to visit colorful and vibrant townhouses! Golden Lane originated after the construction of a new northern wall of the castle. The area of the northern bailey was used for the building of modest dwellings, which are now the last remainder of the small-scale architecture of Prague Castle. Let's take a look at this architectural destination.

Charles Bridge

Charles Bridge is a 14th century stone bridge linking the two sides of Prague. This magnificent structure is one of the city's finest attractions, is the main pedestrian route connecting the Old Town with the Lesser Town and Prague Castle. It is a uniquely designed bridge filled with musicians, painters, vendors and tourists.

Old Town Hall (Prague)

Old Town Hall is the capital of the Czech Republic and one of the most highlighted places to explore. It was established in 1338 as the seat of the Old Town administration. The oldest part of the complex consists of the southern wing. It contains a beautiful Gothic tower with a bay chapel and a unique astronomical clock known as the Orloj. Every hour between 9 am and 11 pm the Orloj has the twelve apostles appear.

Cesky Krumlov

Český Krumlov is worth the visit! It is a city in the South Bohemia region of the Czech Republic. The castle has Gothic, Renaissance, and baroque elements along with a 11-hectare garden and an original 17th-century baroque theater. There are outstanding panoramic views of the old town and the river from the top of its round belltower.

Vienna State Opera

Do you love Opera? Take a look as we drive by The Vienna State Opera. It is an opera house and opera company based in Vienna, Austria. The 1,709-seat Renaissance Revival venue was the first major building on the Vienna Ring Road.

The golden Strauss memorial

The musician Johann Strauss, who is known around the world as the "King of Waltz" is a significant figure for the Austrians. This statue is located in the city park and has become a symbol of Vienna. The statue is located in a white curved arch with an exquisite angel relief carved on it. On the inside of the arch, the golden Strauss is "playing" the violin. The statues are always crowded with tourists who come to pay their respects.

Hofburg

The Hofburg is the official residence and workplace of the President of Austria and was formerly the principal imperial palace of the Habsburg dynasty. Located in the center of Vienna, it was built in the 13th century and expanded several times afterwards.

St. Stephen's Cathedral

St. Stephen's Cathedral is the mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna and the seat of the Archbishop of Vienna, Christoph Cardinal Schönborn, OP. The current Romanesque and Gothic form of the cathedral today in the Stephansplatz. It was largely introduced by Duke Rudolf IV (1339–1365) and stands on the ruins of two earlier churches that were previously there. The most important religious church that you must visit in Vienna is St.

Stephen's Cathedral.

Schönbrunn Palace

Schönbrunn Palace is one of Europe's most beautiful Baroque complexes and has been in the possession of the Habsburgs since 1569. The wife of Emperor Ferdinand II, Eleonore von Gonzaga, had a pleasure palace built on the site in 1642 and called the property "Schönbrunn" for the first time. The palace and garden complex created from 1696 onwards following the siege of Vienna was complete redesigned under Maria Theresa after 1743. Today, due to its historical significance, its unique layout and magnificent furnishings, the palace is a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Slovak National Theatre

Let's take a look at a historical theater that was built in 1886 known as the Slovak National Theatre. Ballet, opera, and drama are the theatrical ensembles located here. It is the main theater in Bratislava, where plays and operas are often staged.

Presidential Palace Square

Today we will take you to visit the Maximilian fountain! The fountain was built in 1572 in the Austrian stone workshop of Andreas Lutringer, II. Legend has it that a knight stands toward the face of the townhall and then turns and bows his head in honor of the people that saved the city. It is also stated that he turns in all four directions to show his protection to the city.

Suspension bridge

On the beautiful Danube River in Bratislava lies a double-layered highway bridge that spans both banks and connects the old and new urban areas together. This is the famous local new bridge spot where tourists visit. Compared with various historical monuments, the new bridge is very young and modern, forming a unique landscape of the old city. There is also the "flying saucer" bridge that spans the north and south of the Danube.

Welcome to Budapest's Heroes' Square! It houses one of the city's iconic symbols, the Millennium Memorial, which includes the seven chieftains of the Magyar tribes that founded Hungary and other important heads of state. In between the statues is a large column crowned by Archangel Gabriel.

Matthias Church

It is a historic building with an important history. Two Kings of Hungary were crowned within its walls: Franz Joseph I of Hungary and Elisabeth, and Charles IV of Hungary and Zita of Bourbon-Parma.

Fisherman's Bastion

Fisherman's Bastion in Budapest is easily one of the top Budapest attractions. The present-day lovely lookout towers and decorative fortification of the Fisherman's Bastion was built in the 19th century. It serves as a lookout tower for the best panoramic views in Budapest, Hungary.

It dates back to the 13th century, and at 3.79 ha (9.4 acres) is the largest medieval town square in Europe. The Project for Public Spaces (PPS) lists the square as the best public space in Europe due to its lively street life, and it was a major factor in the inclusion of Kraków as one of the top off-the-beaten-path destinations in the world in 2016.

St. Mayr's Basilica

Let's take a look at Saint Mary's Basilica! It is a Brick Gothic church adjacent to the Main Market Square in Kraków, Poland. It was built in the 14th century and its foundations date back to the early 13th century to serve as one of the best examples of Polish Gothic architecture.

Mermaid of Warsaw

The Mermaid of Warsaw is a symbol of Warsaw! Legend has it that the mermaid was swimming through the sea and the fishermen wanted to capture her. The fishermen got very furious but once the mermaid sang her song the men could no longer be mad or hate her. Along came a rich merchant that captured her for a grand prize. The fishermen helped free the mermaid and the mermaid promised to always protect them and their homes, which is why mermaids are seen all around Warsaw.

Entry restrictions

As of Saturday, June 11, 2022, all COVID-19 entry restrictions to Germany will be provisionally lifted. From this date, entries to Germany will again be permitted for all travel purposes (including tourism and visiting trips). However, persons residing in the People's Republic of China still need an important reason to enter Germany (due to reciprocity) - this does not apply to German citizens residing in the People's Republic of China. For entry into Germany, proof of vaccination, proof of convalescence or proof of testing is no longer required. For areas of variant of concern (currently no states are designated as virus variant areas) further entry restrictions would apply.

Entry regulations

The German government classifies countries with widespread occurrence of SARS-CoV-2 virus variants of concern as so-called areas of variant of concern. The list of areas of variant of concern is available on the website of the Robert Koch-Institute.

Travellers that have stayed in an area of variant of concern within ten days prior to their entry to Germany must observe special regulations. A travel ban applies for these areas. Transport companies may not transport any persons

from these countries to Germany unless exceptions apply. Travellers are required to register before entry, provide a negative PCR-test result and quarantine for 14 days.
