# Itinerary

## Day 1: Home – Boston

Hotel: Comfort Inn/Days Inn/ Sleep Inn/Red Roof Inn or equivalent

## Day 2: Boston – New York City Night Tour\*

Hotel: E Hotel Banquet & Conference Center/Palace Hotel/ Ramada Inn/Red Roof Inn/ Comfort Inn/Days Inn or equivalent

The trip will start in the city of Cambridge, MA where we will visit the Harvard University. Later, we will take pictures with the main academic building inside MIT. Another fun will begin as soon as you board the cruise ship and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Boston harbor.

### **Itinerary:**

Cambridge → Harvard University (60 mins) → MIT (15 mins) → Boston City tour → Boston Harbor Cruise (Optional, 60 mins) → Quincy Market (60 mins) → Head New York → New York City Night Tour (Optional)

**Boston City Tour will also pass by:** Old Trinity Cathedral, Hancock Building, Boston Athenaeum, Boston Park, Swan Lake Park, and overlook the Golden Dome of the State House.

**Night tour introduction:** \$25/adult and \$15/child.

**Itinerary: Rockefeller Center (15 mins) → Times Square (30 mins) → An observation point in NJ (15 mins)**

**Rockefeller Center** is described as one of the greatest projects of the Great Depression era, Rockefeller Center was declared a New York City landmark in 1985 and a National Historic Landmark in 1987.

**Times Square** is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighborhood. One of the world's busiest pedestrian areas. And it's very charming at night.

**Great observation point in NJ**, high up on the cliffs overlooking the Hudson River. There, you will enjoy what is considered to be the best night view of the New York City skyline.

### **Harvard University**

One of the most famous institutions of higher learning in the world, Harvard University in Cambridge, MA has been standing since 1636, making it the oldest university in the United States. Tourists come for both history and the architecture.

### **MIT**

The Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Cambridge, Massachusetts is a research university known the world over for its highly selective and intense academics, and MIT alumni include 24 Nobel Prize winners and 22 Rhodes Scholars.

### **Boston Harbor Cruise**

See the famous Boston skyline like never before with a cruise of Boston Harbor. From the peak of the Prudential tower to the quaint North End, this beautiful and historic city is best viewed from the bay!

### **Quincy Market**

Quincy Market in the Faneuil Hall marketplace of downtown Boston is a historic building that still serves as a souvenir marketplace and food court today. The area has expanded to include two other marketplace buildings as well.

### **Old Trinity Cathedral**

Trinity Church is located in Boston's upscale Back Bay neighborhood. It is a parish of the Episcopal Diocese of Massachusetts, and the elaborate and ornate building has become a landmark and icon in downtown Boston.

## **Day 3: New York City**

**Hotel:** E Hotel Banquet & Conference Center/ Red Roof Inn/Days Inn or equivalent

At a first glance, travelling around the entire of New York City seems like the mission impossible; however, our highly organized tour is especially designed for you: by visiting amounts of famous landmarks, you will learn more of the city's unique history, culture, and the core spirit of the New Yorkers!

#### **Itinerary:**

Wall Street (25 mins) → Charging Bull (Taking Photos) → One World Observatory (Optional, 70 mins) → Liberty Cruise (Optional, 60 mins) → Times Square (20 mins) → U.S.S Intrepid (Optional, 90 mins) → Madame Tussauds New York (Optional, 50 mins) → Metropolitan Museum (Optional, 120 mins)

**We will also Pass by:** NYC Trinity Church, the Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, World Trade Center and so on.

### **Wall Street**

This famous street in New York City's Financial District has become synonymous with American financial enterprises. It is also the home of the New York Stock Exchange and has been (or still is) the location of several other exchanges.

### **Charging Bull**

This bronze sculpture that sits at the northern tip of New York's Bowling Green Park is ready to strike! It was commissioned to represent the "strength and power of the American people" after the stock market crashed in 1987.

### **One World Observatory**

One World Trade Center is the main building of the rebuilt World Trade Center complex in Lower Manhattan, New York City. It is the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere. There, 102 stories up, find yourself face-to-face with New York's iconic skyline. Maybe you've seen views of the city before, but never quite like this. Walk the three sprawling levels of the Observatory and discover surprises along the way.

### **Liberty Cruise**

Any trip to New York City must include a boat cruise around the Statue of Liberty. This iconic landmark has stood in the city that never sleeps for more than 100 years, as a joint effort between America and France to celebrate the anniversary of America's independence. And the sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a totally different angle, as well as take pictures with Brooklyn Bridge.

### **Times square**

Called "The Crossroads of the World," this major intersection in midtown Manhattan-- where Broadway hits Seventh Avenue-- is a world-famous icon of both New York City and the United States. It has appeared in countless forms of media.

### **USS Intrepid**

This famous military history museum on Manhattan's West Side is inside the now-defunct World War II aircraft carrier, the USS Intrepid. The mission of the Museum is to promote the awareness and understanding of history, science and service through its collections, exhibitions and programming in order to honor the heroes, educate the public and inspire youth. Exhibits include real military aircraft as well as recreations of military life aboard the ship.

### **Madame Tussauds New York**

Madame Tussauds New York in the heart of Times Square is the only place with no ropes or barriers holding you back from your favorite stars. Voted as one of New York's most unique attractions, Madame Tussauds invites you to pose "in a moment in time" with the world's most iconic musicians, A-list stars, sports legends, world leaders and more. With over 85,000 square feet of interactive entertainment, including Ghostbusters: Dimension hyper-reality experience, the world famous wax attraction is bigger and better than ever.

### **Metropolitan Museum**

The Metropolitan Museum of Art is not just the largest art museum in the United States, but also one of the three biggest in the world. Its collection contains more than 2 million works of art. The permanent collection consists of works of art from classical antiquity and ancient Egypt, paintings, and sculptures from nearly all the European masters, and an extensive collection of American and modern art.

## Day 4: Philadelphia – Washington D.C.

Hotel: Days Inn/Quality Inn/Comfort Inn or equivalent

In the morning, we will head to Philadelphia where known as the birthplace of American democracy. At last, we will visit Washington, D.C., Monuments, museums, and Americana characterize this historic city.

### **Itinerary:**

Independence National Historical Park, outside visit Independence Hall, outside visit Liberty Bell (35 mins) → the U.S. Capitol (Outside Visit, 20 mins) → White House (Outside Visit, 20 mins) → Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial (40 mins) → DC Sightseeing Cruise (Optional, 60 mins) → National Air and Space Museum (60 mins)

**We will also pass by:** Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Washington Monument, WWII Memorial and more.

#### **(Winter : apply when DC cruise closed)**

Independence National Historical Park, outside visit Independence Hall, outside visit Liberty Bell (35 mins) → the U.S. Capitol (Outside Visit, 20 mins) → White house (Outside Visit, 20 mins) → Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial (40 mins) → International Spy Museum (Optional, 60 mins) → National Air and Space Museum (60 mins)

**We will also pass by:** Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Washington Monument, WWII Memorial and more.

### **Independence National Historical Park**

This National Historical Park in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania serves as a way of preserving important Revolutionary War sites for future generations. Called "America's most historic square mile," this 55-acre park in the "Old City" district is not to be missed.

### **Independence Hall**

One of Philadelphia's most famous landmarks, Independence Hall in Independence National Historical Park is the location where both the Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution were debated, written, and ratified by the Founding Fathers of the USA.

### **Liberty Bell**

The famously cracked Liberty Bell is a sign of American Independence and spirit. Located at Liberty Bell Center in Philadelphia, PA, this symbol of the American Revolution was crafted in 1752-- more than 250 years ago.

### **the U.S. Capitol**

The famous United States Capitol is the meeting place of the US Congress, and has been for more than 200 years. The building is famous for its elaborate dome and intricately designed, detailed columns.

### **White House**

The world-famous White House in Washington, DC is the official residence of the president of the United States and the place where most of the work is done. The facade of this neoclassical mansion is a global icon.

### **Lincoln Memorial**

This iconic American monument honors the 16th president of the United States. Abraham Lincoln was president during the American Civil War, and is most famous for the Emancipation Proclamation that freed all of the slaves in the US.

### **DC Sightseeing Cruise**

The Potomac River runs along Washington, DC, the capital city of the United States of America. Visitors to this famous locale can opt to see many of the area's most historic landmarks and memorials in a unique way.

### **International Spy Museum**

Dedicated to all things espionage, the International Spy Museum houses exhibits and collections that detail the history of spying. It features many informative films and interactive activities, like Spy in the City, an GPS-based scavenger hunt.

### **National Air and Space Museum**

The Smithsonian's National Air and Space Museum maintains the world's largest and most significant collection of aviation and space artifacts, encompassing all aspects of human flight, as well as related works of art and archival materials. It operates two landmark facilities that, together, welcome more than eight million visitors a year, making it the most visited museum in the country. It also is home to the Center for Earth and Planetary Studies.

## **Day 5: Corning – Niagara Falls**

Hotel: Days Inn/Quality Inn/Sleep Inn or equivalent

We will arrive at one of Fortune Global 500's headquarters, Corning, to visit the Museum of Glass, which is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. After lunch, we are going to see the renowned Niagara Falls. Overlooking American Fall, the Horseshoe Fall and the Bridal Veil Fall, you will be astounded by the deafening roar of the falls. It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful.

### **Itinerary:**

Corning glass museum (Optional, 100 mins) → Niagara Falls State Park → Niagara Falls In-depth tour (Optional, 120 Mins including Old Fort Niagara and Whirlpool State Park)

### **Special notes:**

1. The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and Government regulations on driving hours.

2. If not join the Niagara In-depth Tour, you can stay at the Niagara Falls State Park with longer free time.

### **Corning glass museum**

In western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and, will have chance to know how ancient Egyptian made the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

### **Niagara Falls In-depth tour**

This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark - Old Fort Niagara. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.

### **Niagara Falls Jetboat**

Experience the Niagara River like no other way possible. The exciting boat rides take passengers on a thrilling trip down the Niagara River! This round-trip ride zooms through the Niagara Gorge, and even takes passengers to the famous Whirlpool rapids, all of a custom-built jet boat.

## **Day 6: Niagara Falls – Home**

In the morning, guests will have chance to take famous "Maid of the Mist" boat and face-to-face with the pounding waters. Get soaked with the mist when you are strolling in the State Park. Absolutely, you will like the "Niagara: Legends of Adventure", a dramatic IMAX film to discover the history and culture of the Niagara Falls. Head to the airport in the noon for back home.

### **Itinerary:**

Maid of the mist (Optional, 30 mins) → Adventure IMAX movie (Optional, 30 mins) → Buffalo Airport Drop-off/Boston

**Special notes:** Maid of the Mist will be closed in winter. If time is available, guests will have chance to take the impressive and exciting Niagara Jetboat.

### **US Niagara IMAX Movie**

In 30 minutes, you will witness Niagara Falls incredible stories and history that would otherwise take a lifetime to experience. No Niagara Falls vacation is complete without a visit to see the Niagara Adventure Movie. This movie, tells the history of human interaction with the falls, focusing largely on the "daredevils" who have crossed, boated, and even jumped off them.

### **Maid of the Mist**

It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

### **Niagara Falls Jetboat**

Experience the Niagara River like no other way possible. The exciting boat rides take passengers on a thrilling trip down the Niagara River! This round-trip ride zooms through the Niagara Gorge, and even takes passengers to the famous Whirlpool rapids, all of a custom-built jet boat.
