Trevi Fountain

The Trevi Fountain is another magnificent location to visit on your trip to Italy! It is a fountain in the Trevi district in Rome. A proper throwing of coins into the Trevi fountain for good luck and to return back to Rome is extremely common. In order to do so, you must place the coin in your right hand and toss it over your left shoulder!

Pantheon

The Roman Pantheon is the most preserved and influential building of ancient Rome. Probably one of the most fascinating features of the Pantheon is the Architecture. The structure of the Pantheon is comprised of a series of intersecting arches. The arches rest on eight piers which support eight round-headed arches which run through the drum from its inner to its outer face.

Mouth of Truth

Situated in the portico of Santa Maria in Cosmedin Church, the Mouth of Truth (Bocca della Verità) is a worldwide-famous enormous marble mask said to bite the hand of those who lied. The huge legendary sculpture has a diameter of 1.75 meters and is dedicated to the God of the Sea, represented by a male bearded face with holes for the eyes, nose and mouth.

Palazzo Venezia

The Palazzo Venezia is a palace in Rome that is located between Piazza Venezia and Via del Plebiscito. It is a sober Renaissance building where works of art produced between the early years of Christianity and the Renaissance are exhibited. In the corridors of the palace, you will be able to appreciate different elements, such as Renaissance paintings, polychrome wooden sculptures, rugs, weapons, armor, and terracotta sculptures.

Piazza Venezia

Piazza Venezia or Venice Square is a square in Rome located where four major roads meet. Piazza Venezia is located at the foot of the Capitoline Hill. It owes its name to Palazzo Venezia.

St. Peter's Basilica Church

Take a look at the greatest church in the world at St. Peter's Basilica Church! This is the center and home of the Catholic Church! It was designed by Donato Bramante, Michelangelo, Carlo Maderno, Gian Lorenzo Bernini and many more talented artists. St. Peter's is the most renowned work of Renaissance architecture and the largest church in the world by interior measure. St. Peter's is regarded as one of the holiest Catholic places and has been described as "holding a unique position in the Christian world."

Vatican Museums

Home to some of Italy's most important artworks are the Vatican Museums. From numerous paintings and sculptures to tapestries and classical antiquities, the Vatican Museums (Musei Vaticani) is one of the country's top attractions! with a central plant in the shape of a Greek cross, with five large domes and a particular mixture of ancient and oriental art.

St. Mark's Square

The Basilica of San Marco overlooks one of the most beautiful squares in the world. Next to both the Basilica and the Doge's Palace is where all the most important religious and civil ceremonies have always been held. Piazza San Marco is now considered the city's main symbol and tourist attraction.

Bridge of Sighs

Called the Ponte dei Sospiri by locals, this iconic landmark was built in the year 1600 and connects the Doge's Palace to the historic prison across the canal. Even though it has a dark history where it was once a place to transport prisoners, today it is easily considered one of the most romantic places in Venice.

The Lion of Venice

The Lion of Venice is an ancient bronze winged lion sculpture in the Piazza San Marco of Venice, Italy. It symbolizes the city as well as one of its patron saints, St Mark, after its arrival there in the 12th century. The sculpture surmounts one of two large granite columns in the Square.

Verona Arena (Arena di Verona) is a stunning Roman amphitheater built in the 1st century AD. As with many similar Roman constructions, the arena suffered during the decline and fall of the Empire and was pillaged for masonry during the middle ages. Despite this however, and with a certain amount of restoration, Verona Arena stands in an excellent state of preservation today and still hosts a number of events, operas, and open-air performances.

Juliet's House

Juliet's House is supposed to be the house where Juliet (from Shakespeare famous love story Romeo and Juliet) used to live. In fact, the balcony of the house was the place where both lovers declared their love to each other. Today, the house is one of the major attractions in Verona and receives thousands of tourists every year!

Lake Garda

Lake Garda or Benaco is the largest in Italy! This luminous environment, temperate climate, and flourishing vegetation of mainly olives, lemon groves, palms, cypresses, oleanders, and orange trees and along with the majestic landscapes are the background to the remarkable historical and cultural remains that were spread all around to make this lake the most charming in Italy.

Milan Cathedral

The Cathedral of Milan is one of the greatest symbols of Milan! It is a uniquely and intricately designed church. It is one of the largest cathedrals in Italy and all of Europe. The cathedral is a place of prayer and teachings and is truly a must-see in Milan!

Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II

The street is covered by an arching glass and cast-iron roof, a popular design for 19th-century arcades and the central octagonal space is topped with a glass dome.
